**RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1	Hick Group 1600
<p><b>MADAM WOO</b> (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with ZUMA which was crowded. As a result MADAM WOO knuckled losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>HEKTIK</b> (T Thornton) – Crowded and hampered approaching the 1300 metres to the inside of WOODPECKER HILL (S Weatherley) which shifted in before being corrected by its rider. S Weatherley was issued with a warning. HEKTIK raced in restricted room passing the 1200 metres to the inside of SACRED SHOT (L Innes) which was taken in slightly by ATTIRE (S Spratt) with SACRED SHOT then continuing to move in when steadying, further hampering HEKTIK which was again steadied. Riders <b>S Spratt</b> and <b>L Innes</b> were both severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised they must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Over-raced when pace steadied 900 metres.</p> <p><b>MR BIG</b> (C Dell) - MR BIG, HEKTIK and ZUMA all commenced to over-race when the pace steadied passing the 900 metres. <b>S Weatherley</b> WOODPECKER HILL was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must not ease the tempo of the race in a manner where it puts other riders in difficulty.</p> <p><b>ZUMA</b> (M McNab) – Crowded start. Over-raced when pace steadied 900 metres.</p> <p><b>COMIN'THROUGH</b> (M Cameron) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>I AM BLESSED</b> (S Collett) – Had to be steadied when in restricted room passing the 500 metres to the inside of MR BIG which raced greenly.</p> <p><b>KEEP UP</b> (V Colgan) – Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres to the inside of SACRED SHOT which shifted out slightly.</p> <p><b>SACRED SHOT</b> (L Innes) – Shifted out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>ATTIRE</b> (S Spratt) – Had a tendency to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	Environz 1200
<p><b>RAYMOND PARK</b> (M Vance) – Underwent a veterinary examination prior to leaving the Bird Cage when becoming unsettled and rearing over and was cleared fit to race. Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>L'ESCALIER ROSE</b> (V Colgan) – Late scratched at 2.30pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in its barrier stall. Trainer L Pertab was advised that L'ESCALIER ROSE must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.</p> <p><b>SUN GENES</b> (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied losing ground.</p> <p><b>BLACKMAGICWOMAN</b> (S Weatherley) – Held up early in the final straight and then improved into a marginal run between ST REGIS and COMPROMISE passing the 200 metres with COMPROMISE and ST REGIS then shifting slightly with BLACKMAGICWOMAN then making contact with the hind quarters of COMPROMISE and shifting in hampering ST REGIS.</p> <p><b>ST REGIS</b> (R Elliot) – Hampered 200 metres and then not persevered with over the final 100 metres.</p> <p><b>SEA BLINKA</b> (S Collett) – Could not obtain clear running in the final straight.</p> <p><b>MY GIDDY AUNT</b> (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight until near the 100 metres.</p>	

Race 3	Dunstan Feeds Rising Stars Championship Qualifier 1200
<p><b>ESBEEDEE</b> (O Bosson) – Began awkwardly shifting in making contact with the hind quarters of SUGGESTIONS. As a result ESBEEDEE lost ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>SUGGESTIONS</b> (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with ESBEEDEE with Rider V Colgan becoming briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>QIKCAT</b> (S Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PRECISION MISS</b> (K McCulloch) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied approaching the 1000 metres. Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres to the outside of STARSTRIPE which shifted out under pressure. As a result PRECISION MISS shifted into the line of WHY ME which had to briefly steady.</p> <p><b>WHY ME</b> (C Grylls) – Crowded 250 metres and briefly steadied.</p> <p><b>SALTED CARAMEL</b> (A Jones) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres. Held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.</p> <p><b>SHERPA</b> (M Hills) – Briefly crowded passing the 200 metres when weakening.</p>	
Race 4	Pukekohe Dental 1400
<p><b>ABADDON</b> (C Lammas) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 150 metres.</p> <p><b>KILLARNEY</b> (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly making contact with RUUD NOT TOO. KILLARNEY was obliged to race wide in the early stages before being allowed to work forward passing the 1000 metres to lead and shifted in when not fully clear of RUUD NOT TOO which shifted off that runner’s heels forcing PRINCE OF PASSION to then race three wide. Rider V Colgan was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting in. KILLARNEY shifted out when placed under pressure passing the 250 metres making contact with RUUD NOT TOO becoming briefly unbalanced and when being corrected by its rider shifted in briefly crowding LIGHT SHADOW. When questioned regarding the performance of KILLARNEY Rider V Colgan advised that the gelding had begun better than anticipated and when restrained in the early stages was unable to obtain cover eventually working forward to lead which had not suited the gelding. KILLARNEY underwent a post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormalities.</p> <p><b>PRINCE OF PASSION</b> (K McCulloch) – Forced wide 300 metres and then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.</p> <p><b>ANNABELINDA</b> (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly and then was placed in restricted room shortly after having to be steadied. ANNABELINDA then commenced to over-race when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>BRIGHTON</b> (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>RUUD NOT TOO</b> (D Johnson) – Hampered 1000 metres. Bumped 250 metres.</p> <p><b>LIGHT SHADOW</b> (S McKay) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. Raced in restricted room early in the final straight then briefly crowded 200 metres.</p> <p><b>CAPELLA</b> (O Bosson) – Had a tendency to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Dunstan Feeds Rising Stars Championship Qualifier 1500</b>
<p><b>EIGHT TO RULE</b> (T Thornton) – Late scratched at 4.18pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in its barrier stall.</p> <p><b>CORTADO</b> (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly shifting inwards abruptly.</p> <p><b>PRAIRIE CREEK</b> (R Elliot) – Raced keenly in the early stages and then raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>WAIPIPI LAD</b> (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>CUTTING UP ROUGH</b> (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance of CUTTING UP ROUGH Rider O Bosson advised that the impost of 60 kilograms had not helped but otherwise could not offer any tangible excuses.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Race 4 Life 3YO Salver (2100 metres)</b>
<p><b>TOORAK TOWER</b> (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Shifted out to obtain clear running 500 metres making contact.</p> <p><b>WILIJONMCBRIDE</b> (R Elliot) – Raced in restricted room leaving the straight on the first occasion. Raced wide without cover throughout. Hampered passing the 500 metres and forced wide by TOORAK TOWER (D Johnson) which shifted out to obtain clear running. Rider <b>D Johnson</b> was severely reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on her record with Stewards taking into account the racing manners of WILIJONMCBRIDE which was hanging outwards and tiring at the time.</p> <p><b>REDEEM THE DREAM</b> (L Innes) – Raced in restricted room leaving the straight on the first occasion. Inconvenienced over the concluding stages when LINCOLN BLUE shifted out abruptly approaching the winning post.</p> <p><b>BARCELO</b> (S McKay) – When questioned regarding the performance of BARCELO Apprentice Rider S McKay advised the gelding had failed to see out the distance of today's race.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>Woods 1200</b>
<p><b>HOLLYWOOD LASS</b> (L Innes) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>SERIOUS SATIRE</b> (D Johnson) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>GREAT EXPECTATIONS</b> (K McCulloch) – Raced wide until improving forward to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres. GREAT EXPECTATIONS was crowded and checked passing the 200 metres by LUCKY'S REVENGE which was crowded when dictated out by UNCONQUERED (C Grylls) which shifted out under pressure. Contributing was inward movement from SPIDER. Rider <b>C Grylls</b> admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with his license to ride in races suspended by the Judicial Committee from the conclusion of racing on 14 December up to and including racing on 21 December 2016, 3 days.</p> <p><b>LUCKY'S REVENGE</b> (S McKay) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained off heels passing the 800 metres. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 500 metres. Crowded 200 metres.</p> <p><b>CHADSDALE</b> (M McNab) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight and was denied clear racing room when attempting to shift into a run to the outside of SHOT IN THE DARK passing the 100 metres.</p>
