<b>Race 4 Pukekohe Dental 1400</b>
Trainer R James advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of KILLARNEY following its performance in this race, adding the gelding would now be sent for a spell.
<b>Race 5 Dunstan Feeds Rising Stars Championship Qualifier 1500</b>
Trainer R Manning advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of CUTTING UP ROUGH following its performance in this race, it is now his intention to freshen the gelding prior to racing next.
<b>Race 6 Race 4 Life 3YO Salver (2100 metres)</b>
Trainer P Mckay advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of BARCELO following its performance in this race, it is now his intention to drop the gelding back in distance and continue on with its current preparation.

Trainer G Rogerson advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of WILLIJONMCBRIDE following its performance in this race and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation

#### RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FASHION IN THE FIELDS 25 FEB 2000</b>
<b>DARCI DENIRO</b> (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly.	
<b>SHONALI</b> (S Spratt) – Was slow to begin.	
<b>JUMEIRAH</b> (M Du Plessis) – Was slow to begin.	
<b>HAPPINESS IS</b> (B R Jones) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained near the 1800 metres shifting out and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SMILING ART which shifted in slightly. Was not persevered with from the 1200 metres finishing a distant last. When questioned rider B R Jones was unable to offer any reason for the mare's performance. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer L Laing advised the Stewards that the mare was heavily in season, and also they would be removing the blinkers for its next start.	
<b>SAVASON</b> (R Elliot) – Shifted in near the 1800 metres making contact with NARVICK.	
<b>SHOCKING LUCK</b> (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover until shifting in passing the 1400 metres.	
<b>KEEN TO KEEPER</b> (T Thornton) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MATAMATA BREEDERS' STAKES DAY 25 FEB 1600</b>
<b>SOLEADO</b> (T Thornton) – Was slow to begin. Was held up approaching the 200 metres and when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with MASTER OF SPEED, and then was again briefly held up shortly after.	
<b>WOODEN RED</b> (M Hills) – Raced in restricted room shortly after jumping away.	
<b>ROYAL REBEL</b> (D Prastiyou) – Began awkwardly. Inconvenienced 75 metres. ROYAL REBEL underwent a post-race veterinary examination, including endoscope examination, which could find no clinical abnormality.	
<b>KANE</b> (C Grylls) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages, and then hung out approaching the 800 metres running wide. KANE was then obliged to race wide without cover for the remainder of the race.	
<b>REDDITO</b> (B R Jones) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
<b>SHEZTOMUCH</b> (D Danis) – Was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres.	
<b>SHACKELTONS EDGE</b> (A Collett) – Was held up near the 100 metres shifting out abruptly to obtain clear running inconveniencing ROYAL REBEL.	
<b>KUIA</b> (M Cameron) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MATAMATA VETERINARY SERVICES 1200</b>
<b>SOLOMON</b> (S Weatherley) – Was a late scratching at 3.18 pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers.	

**SENSIBILITY** (K McCulloch) – Knuckled on jumping away with rider K McCulloch becoming unbalanced and losing the use of her right stirrup iron for a short distance. As a result REGAL DANCER was hampered. Hampered 350 metres.

**REGAL DANCER** (L Innes) – Hampered and forced wider shortly after the start. Raced wide through the early stages making the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres, and continued to race wide for the remainder of the race.

**THOUGHTFUL** (T Thornton) – Was slow to begin.

**TUSCARORA** (M McNab) – Shifted out abruptly shortly after jumping away making contact with ELUSIVE TREASURE with rider M McNab becoming briefly unbalanced. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, including endoscopic examination, which could find no clinical abnormality.

**ELUSIVE TREASURE** (M Coleman) – Hampered on jumping away with rider M Coleman becoming unbalanced. Shifted out off the heels of REGAL DANCER to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres crowding the weakening CAPISTRANO PEARL out on to SENSIBILITY which was hampered. Rider M Coleman was issued with a warning.

**CAPISTRANO PEARL** (L Satherley) – Crowded losing ground 350 metres.

**FORGED** (M Du Plessis) – Over-raced in the early stages, making the 800 metre bend awkwardly, and continued to lay out around the bend into the final straight.

**Race 4** | **STIHL SHOP MATAMATA 1200**

**IMOGENSMILES** (V Gatu) – Was slow to begin.

**SHE'STOOHOTTOTROT** (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly shifting out crowding EXHIBITION on to DANGER DEE. As a result EXHIBITION lost ground. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**EXHIBITION** (M McNab) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

**ZIP ZAP** (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly before coming together with DANGER DEE shortly after.

**DANGER DEE** (S McKay) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages, then had to be firmly restrained for a distance near the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on heels. Steadied when crowded passing the 150 metres.

**ELETTRA** (C Grylls) – Got its head up when being steadied, then over-raced for a distance passing the 800 metres.

**SAVE THE STARS** (C Lammas) – Was held up near the 350 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running taking FLYING TRAPEZE wider on the track.

**MILLY MOO** (T Thornton) – Was held up for clear running until passing the 200 metres.

**FLYING TRAPEZE** (L Innes) – Lay in when being ridden out passing the 150 metres crowding DANGER DEE which had to be steadied when under pressure. Rider L Innes was issued with a warning.

**Race 5** | **COMAG LIMITED 1200**

**LATER ON** (V Colgan) – Was slow to begin.

**DREAMS OF PARIS** (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages, making the 800 metre bend awkwardly.

**SHARP PROPOSITION** (C Grylls) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages, and made the 800 metre bend awkwardly running wide.

**KIWI KASHBAO** (S Collett) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

**SPEEWAH** (S McKay) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

**COME DANCE WITH ME** (A Collett) – Commenced to race ungenerously passing the 800 metres shifting out making contact with LASTING FRIENDSHIP.

**LASTING FRIENDSHIP** (M Coleman) – Hampered 800 metres.

**SCARLET PRINCESS** (C Lammas) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of YEARN losing ground near the 400 metres.

**Race 6** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE**

**NOVELTY** (A Schwerin) – Was slow to begin. Had to be firmly restrained near the 350 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening KAHAROA ROSE until shifting out passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

**VITESSE** (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied, losing ground. Lay out rounding the bend passing the 800 metres crowding REAL SAVVY which had to be steadied. Was held up passing the 400 metres, and had difficulty obtaining clear running for the remainder of the race.

**GALLOPING GERTE** (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

**REAL SAVVY** (S Weatherley) – Crowded 800 metres.

**MISS ELEGANTE** (A Jones) – Was held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of the tiring KAHAROA ROSE.

**KAHAROA ROSE** (D Prastiyou) – Raced handy but was quickly under pressure passing the 400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**Race 7** | **CARRFIELDS LIVESTOCK MATAMATA 1400**

**SONOVASAIN** (S Collett) – Was slow to begin.

**COTE D'OR** (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when racing ungenerously.

**DELTA DE LAGO** (C Grylls) – Crowded at the start, losing ground.

**UP 'N' ROLLING** (S McKay) – Crowded start.

**PANELLA** (A Jones) – Crowded and unbalanced at the start.

**SWISSILICIOUS** (V Gatu) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**AKAMON** (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 500 metres having to be firmly restrained.

**SHARP ELLE** (S Spratt) – Had to be steadied for a short distance passing the 200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of KEEP THE MOMENT having to shift out to obtain clear running.

**Race 8** | **NOBLE AND LEE CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1400**

The start of this race was delayed due to MACAKIZI requiring farrier attention.

**DONTBESHY** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SECRET LIAISON** (A Collett) – Knuckled shortly after the start.

**ORAISTE** (A Jones) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1100 metres, and when becoming awkwardly placed on heels shifted out abruptly hampering CHARLES ROAD which then shifted out hampering MISS HOROTIU. ORAISTE continued to over-race for a distance.

**CHARLES ROAD** (C Grylls) – Badly hampered 1000 metres.

**MISS HOROTIU** (M Coleman) – Badly hampered 1000 metres.

**MACAKIZI** (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

**GOING GANG BUSTERS** (S Weatherley) – Lay out under pressure early in the final straight. Passing the 100 metres shifted in making contact with LE PETITE ROUGE.

**GOODIEGOODY** (K McCulloch) – Was held up for the majority of the final straight.

**Race 9** | **BELL AND GRAHAM LAWYERS 1600**

**PRIVATE HERO** (L Innes) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

**BLUE WAGON** (O Bosson) – Knuckled shortly after the start.

**NEALA** (M Hills) – Had to be firmly restrained near the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BLUE WAGON. When questioned into the performance of the favourite NEALA rider M Hills could offer no reason.

**CURIOUS** (B Hutton) – Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres.

**SACRED SIREN** (M Du Plessis) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**Race 10** | **MATAMATA TYRE SERVICES**

**ETONIAN** (J Jago) – Was slow to begin. Commenced to over-race in the early stages before shifting out forcing MASTER POET wider passing the 900 metres, and then was allowed to improve forward.

**MASTER POET** (B R Jones) – Began awkwardly. Forced over extra ground 900 metres

**RODMAR** (S McKay) – Began awkwardly. RODMAR had to be steadied when crowded to the outside of DIVINE DUKE which improved into a marginal run to the outside of TRIGGER becoming awkwardly placed on that runners heels having to be steadied near the 350 metres. Contributing was inward movement from ETONIAN.

**DIVINE DUKE** (S Weatherley) – Had to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on heels near the 350 metres.

**PIAZZA** (C Grylls) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when racing ungenerously. Was briefly held up until passing the 200 metres.
