RACE COMMENTS:

REBECCA BLACK TRUST DINNER 20 APRIL MAIDEN (1400m) Race 1

DUFFY (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.

MADAME LIBRE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Stewards questioned S Wynne regarding her riding tactics adopted aboard MADAME LIBRE, more specifically in the early stages when the mare was restrained when there was opportunity to race in a more forward position. Rider S Wynne explained that after beginning well she had elected to restrain MADAME LIBRE as she had anticipated being caught wide without cover. S Wynne added that she then attempted to follow the FIRE LILY but was unable to do so when that runner crossed adjacent to the running rail and had got back further than anticipated. S Wynne's explanation was noted by Stewards. A post-race veterinary inspection of MADAME LIBRE failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

DAYTONA (L Callaway) – Hampered leaving the barrier.

SAMMI LOU (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1000 metres.

NAME OF THE STARS (E Farr) – Contacted by JUST (A Collett) passing the 700 metres which was shifting out to obtain clear running with NAME OF THE STARS becoming unbalanced. Rider **A Collett** was advised she must exercise greater care when shifting ground and further advised that a warning would be placed on her record. NAME OF THE STARS lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

WESLEY HALL (A Morgan) – Lay out when placed under pressure early in the home straight. Apprentice rider A Morgan was reminded of her obligations regarding whip use prior to the 200 metres.

JUST (A Collett) – Rider **A Collett** admitted a charge in that she used her whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.00.

Race 2 AVON CITY FORD RATING 75 (1400m)

TOMM JONES (K Mudhoo) – The training partnership of J & K Parsons was fined \$100.00 under the minor infringement schedule for failing to declare a rider by the required time.

LAAFFAIRE (T Comignaghi) – After being restless in the barrier began awkwardly and lost ground (5L). Trainer J Hay was advised that a warning had been placed against the mare's barrier manners.

DISTURBANCE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

RED KING (K Kwo) – Made contact with the running rail near the 1100 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance.

JOHNNY JONES (C Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages to middle stages.

MONTRACHET (R Firdhaus) - Raced wide throughout.

SHOOT TO KILL (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 500 metres.

Race 3 NZB SOUTH ISLAND SALE APRIL 21 RATING 75 (1800m)

SON OF ZAC (C Barnes) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance Rider C Barnes advised that the gelding had not been entirely suited by today's track conditions.

MONTOYA STAR (S Wynne) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages due to the slow pace.

PHEASANT (E Farr) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 600 metres.

SPEEDY JAX (T Jonker) – Over raced in the early and middle stages due to the slow pace.

SHE ROCKS (G Jogoo) – Over raced in the early and middle stages due to the slow pace.

VANTAA (K Williams) – Rider K Williams advised that the gelding had struggled in today's track conditions.

Race 4 HORNBY WORKING MEN'S CLUB FOUNDERS CUP (2000m)

SUREASYOUWEREBORN (T Moseley) – Over-raced when being restrained off the heels of FLAG THE GROOM (K Williams) for a distance in the early stages. Rider **K Williams** was reminded by Stewards that she must not ease the pace to an extent where it places riders in difficulty.

SAINT KITT (L Callaway) – Raced keenly in the middle stages with the saddle shifting forward passing the 1200 metres placing Rider L Callaway at a disadvantage.

Race 5 TELTRAC COMMUNICATIONS RATING 65 (1200m)

ZIPPIN (L Hemi) – Dislodged rider L Hemi en route to the barriers and galloped for a short distance before being recaptured. ZIPPIN then underwent a veterinary inspection being cleared to race. Rider L Hemi was uninjured.

RUBY ROW (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced. Rider C Barnes advised that the mare had not been entirely happy in today's track conditions.

MAUI MISS (C Johnson) – Shifted out leaving the barriers.

CANTILENA (S Wynne) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

FUN FAIR (A Morgan) - Held up passing the 400 metres shifting out to obtain clear running.

KEARNEY (R Firdhaus) – Awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres.

Race 6 PGG WRIGHTSON SEEDS OPEN HANDICAP (1000m)

JAZZMAN (A Morgan) – Began awkwardly. Made brief contact with EL BEE DARCI passing the 70 metres. Apprentice rider **A Morgan** admitted a charge in that she used her whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$250.00.

COUP DARCI BE (P Shaikh) – Began awkwardly. Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 550 metres.

EL BEE DARCI (K Williams) – Made brief contact with JAZZMAN passing the 70 metres.

Race 7 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK AIRFREIGHT STAKES (1600m)

SHIRLEY MAUDE (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly getting its head up with rider R Cuneen becoming unbalanced and the filly losing ground.

PER FORM (K Williams) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and was not preserved with in the final straight. PER FORM underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which could find no obvious abnormalities.

GRAND SOLEIL (S Wynne) – Returned to the birdcage with blood present in the left nostril. GRAND SOLEIL underwent a subsequent veterinary inspection including an endoscopic examination which found the blood to be consistent with a laceration to the inside of the nostril.

Race 8 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO EASTER CUP (1600m)

BLOODSTREAM (A Collett) – Slow to begin. Held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres.

SON OF MAHER (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly.

MY CHINO (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

BOOTS 'N' ALL (K Williams) – Placed in restricted room passing the 1500 metres to the inside of MY CHINO (C Johnson) which lay in and away from ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA (T Moseley) which shifted in, with BOOTS 'N' ALL then being steadied, losing ground. Riders T Moseley and C Johnson were advised to exercise care when riding in similar circumstances.

SIR SINGO (G Jogoo) – Crowded start. Raced keenly for a short distance passing the 1000 metres.

TOMMY TUCKER (J Lowry) – Held up for a distance entering the final straight and shifted inwards to obtain clear running.

Race 9 LITTLE BROWN JUG RATING 65 (1600m)

FUNNY (R Firdhaus) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

KONA (C Barnes) – Made contact with BLUE PRINT leaving the barrier becoming unbalanced and shifting outwards hampering O'KIWI. Raced keenly in the early stages.

BLUE PRINT (A Collett) – Began awkwardly making contact with KONA on a number of occasions. Held up early in the home straight and when shifting out to obtain clear running made contact with SUSIE WOLFF which was shifting in slightly, with SUSIE WOLFF becoming briefly unbalanced. Rider A Collett was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance.

SUSIE WOLFF (S Wynne) – Contacted 300 metres and briefly unbalanced.

OLIGARCH (T Jonker) – Slow to begin.

PRINCE RANSOM (A Morgan) – Hampered start.

O'KIWI (C Johnson) – Hampered start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

ELVERA (K Williams) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

JIMMY (L Callaway) - Got its head up when racing ungenerously passing the 1000 metres.

BLUE POOL BLUR (G Jogoo) - Raced wide throughout.

FUGAWI (T Moseley) – Rider T Moseley was reprimanded by Stewards for the manner in which he used the whip in the final straight.
