GENERAL:

C Lammas did not attend the meeting after suffering a track work injury the previous morning and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

R Myers did not attend the meeting due to illness and is required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TOTALLY VETS PREMIER

LUCYINRIO (J Parkes) – Lost its footing and slipped badly passing the 900 metres losing ground. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any abnormality.

CHARLESTOWN (R Elliot) – Jumped away awkwardly unbalancing its rider and settled back.

GOLD ALLURE (S MacNab) – Slow away.

BALLYBAY (J Riddell) – Commenced to hang outwards from near the 900 metres.

SILVER BUBBLES (R Goldsbury) – Raced three-wide without cover around the first bend until near the 600 metres.

PADDY BOURKE (T Johnson) – Had to be steadied and checked off heels passing the 500 metres.

Immediately following the race Stipendiary Stewards met with all riders from Race 1 regarding concerns around the footing going into the bend passing the 900 metres. An Inspection Committee comprising Stipendiary Stewards, a delegation of senior riders and trainers along with the Course Manager and Club representatives inspected the area of concern with a number of slip marks evident. It was agreed that a further inspection take place following a slicer machine being put through the area identified in an attempted remedy to the relevant section of the track. Following a further meeting of the Inspection Committee the Stipendiary Stewards were unable to be satisfied that the work undertaken had removed concerns over this section of the track abandoning the remainder of racing today at 1.55pm.
