GENERAL:

Due to the Manawatu Racing Clubs meeting being rescheduled riders C Johnson and S McKay were unable to fulfil their engagements at this meeting, with replacements as listed in the summary above.

At the request of TAB Control, the race start time for Race 8 was altered to 3.51pm.

SUPPLEMENTARY:**RACE COMMENTS:****Race 1** | **HOKONUI HONDA & WHITE ROBE LODGE MAIDEN 2000**

ITEMIZE (J Lowry) – blundered leaving the barriers. Over-raced in the early stages and made the bend near the 1400 metres awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

MAC MURDOCH (D Bothamley) – hung inwards over the final 400 metres and had to be straightened on several occasions when placed under pressure.

NESTA (S Wahab) – steadied momentarily entering the first bend when placed in restricted room to the inside of **SMOKEM UP** (S Wynne) which shifted inwards. Rider S Wynne was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

PAYMENT PENDING (G Jogoo) – raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

GAZZA THE GURU (R Cuneen) – held up rounding the final bend and again near the 100 metres, having to be steadied when awkwardly near the heels of **MAC MURDOCH**.

HOLY MACKEREL (E Farr) – held up rounding the final bend until near the 250 metres.

HERBIE (C Barnes) – slow to begin.

DISCUSSING FLAGS (T Moseley) – hung inwards throughout the final straight and had to be steadied for a short distance passing the 200 metres when laying inwards across the heels of **ITEMIZE**.

MAYDAY (K Kalychurun) – got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

Race 2 | **HERIOT HOTEL & GORE SEPTIC TANK CLEANERS MAIDEN 1200**

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes due to several runners proving difficult to load.

KRUGER RAND (G Jogoo) – made heavy contact with **THE LIKELY LAD** near the 350 metres when attempting a marginal run to the inside of **GO APACHE** which lay inwards under pressure.

COURT JESTER (E Farr) – slow to begin and attempted to buck in the early stages losing considerable ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no clinical abnormalities. Trainer S Price was advised that **COURT JESTER** must trial to the Stewards satisfaction on one occasion prior to racing next. S Price advised Stewards that the gelding would now be retired as a racing proposition from her stable.

PLOWSHARE (R Cuneen) – steadied for a short distance near the 450 metres when improving up on to the heels of **MORRIE MAC**. Held up passing the 200 metres and had to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

THE LIKELY LAD (T Moseley) – hung inwards when rounding the bend near the 800 metres placing **GO APACHE** in restricted room. Bumped near the 250 metres.

BLACK LIZZIE (C Barnes) – raced three wide without cover throughout.

GO APACHE (K Williams) – crowded when placed in restricted room near the 800 metres. Lay inwards under pressure through the early and middle stages of the final straight.

Following the running of this event the track conditions were upgraded to Dead (4).

Race 3 | **AB LIME & EWAN ALLAN HONDA MAIDEN 1200**

LIMOUSINE (K Selvan) – slow to begin.

THE STYLE (S Wynne) – lay inwards under pressure through the early stages of the final straight.

TAP DIS (E Farr) – raced wide without cover in the early stages and made the bend near the 700 metres awkwardly. Lay inwards throughout the final straight and had to be straightened when placed under pressure near the 150 metres.

Race 4 | **BLATCH RACING & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN 1335**

HE'S MI BROTHER (P Shaikh) – lay outwards under pressure near the 150 metres and had to be straightened.

CAPER CALEB (K Mudhoo) – began very awkwardly losing ground. Steadied near the 200 metres when becoming awkwardly placed to the outside of STRATEGUS which shifted outwards and away from ANGEL.

COATNCOLLAR (G Jogoo) – crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

RED HOT PIRATE (R Cuneen) – crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

THE COVER GIRL (E Farr) – steadied near the 1200 metres when racing to the inside of HE'S MI BROTHER which shifted inwards.

ANGEL (S Wahab) – steadied near the 1200 metres when racing to the inside of THE COVER GIRL which in turn was forced inwards by HE'S MI BROTHER (P Shaikh). Apprentice rider **P Shaikh** was issued with a warning and advised that in future he is to ensure that he is the required distance clear of other runners when shifting ground

STRATEGUS (K Williams) – raced three wide without cover throughout.

DELIGHTFUL TAP (K Kalychurun) – when questioned regarding the performance rider K Kalychurun advised that in his opinion the filly would prefer more rain affected going. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no clinical abnormalities.

FLY THE FLAG (R Yatim) – hung outwards rounding the final bend.

Race 5 | **ROAD TRANSPORT LOGISTICS & STUART TIMBER HANDICAP 1335**

ALITRON (S Wynne) – over-raced in the early stages.

THEM OR US (S Muniandy) – over-raced throughout. Held up rounding the final bend.

GRETA VALLEY (K Williams) – held up passing the 200 metres, having to shift inwards across heels to obtain clear running.

THAT'S NOT THE GO (R Cuneen) – When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice rider R Cuneen advised that the mare had failed to respond when asked for an effort near the 600 metres and had proved disappointing. R Cuneen further added that in his opinion the mare may not have been entirely suited to today's prevailing track conditions.

THE BELIEVER (E Farr) – held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

KASUNDI (K Mudhoo) – raced three wide without cover throughout.

BRAHMA QUEEN (R Yatim) – shifted inwards and contacted the running rail approaching the 600 metres.

CARMENIZE (S Wahab) – reared as the start was effected, making heavy contact with the barrier partition losing several lengths. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare's barrier record.

Race 6

AON INSURANCE BROKERS & TAPANUI FOUR SQUARE HANDICAP 2000

THE QUIET MAN (S Muniandy) – crowded leaving the barrier when THE HEAT IS ON shifted outwards. Steadied when crowded over the concluding stages when racing between ROSHEEN (G Jogoo) which lay outwards under pressure and SHANTAV. Apprentice rider **G Jogoo** was advised to exercise greater care and that in future he is expected to straighten his mounts sooner than he did so on this occasion.

BABILLONI (C Barnes) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Inconvenienced shortly after the start.

THE GORE HARPOON (T Moseley) – lay outwards when negotiating the bend near the 1400 metres. Raced three wide without cover over the final 1400 metres.

CONSOLIDATE (S Wynne) – over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

LADY LINDAUER (K Mudhoo) – crowded leaving the barrier. Held up briefly passing the 200 metres and had to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running.

LETTHETHUNDERROLL (K Kalychurun) – improved wide from the 900 metres.

Race 7

DYNES TRANSPORT LTD TAPANUI CUP 2000

KEEP THE COURAGE (S Wahab) – slow to begin.

GUNNA FLY (T Moseley) – began awkwardly.

LANDALES GOLD (S Muniandy) – forced over extra ground over the concluding stages.

TAKE FIRE (K Mudhoo) – raced wide without cover through the early stages.

LA NOUVELLE VAGUE (R Cuneen) – shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages forcing LANDALES GOLD wider on the track. Apprentice rider **R Cuneen** was reminded of his obligations to ensure in future he straightens his mounts sooner than he did so on this occasion.

VICTORYSHALLBEMINE (K Kalychurun) – steadied near the 1400 metres when improving up on to the heels of PETER PARKER. Improved wide from the 700 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider K Kalychurun advised the mare had been left flat-footed from the 800 metres and when placed under pressure had failed to quicken, proving disappointing.

Race 8

FORREST LODGE HOTEL/MLT HANDICAP 2000

HE AIN'T HEAVY (D Bothamley) - Steadied and had to take evasive action passing the 750 metres to avoid the fallen POINT PROVEN.

THE ENERGIZER (K Kalychurun) – raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

SERVE DE AUNT (J Lowry) – raced wide without cover in the early stages.

POINT PROVEN (R Black) – over-raced in the early and middle stages. An investigation was opened and adjourned after POINT PROVEN fell passing the 750 metres. Rider R Black was immediately attended to by the on-course St John Paramedics being pronounced deceased at the scene. POINT PROVEN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed minor lacerations above the near-side fetlock. **MISSCATTLECREEK** (T Moseley) was unable avoid the fallen horse and rider being brought down as a consequence. Rider T Moseley was attended to by the on-course St John Paramedics and cleared of injury. A post-race veterinary examination of **MISSCATTLECREEK** revealed the mare to have sustained a fractured off-fore knee, necessitating the mare to be humanely euthanized by the on-course veterinary surgeon.

DOUBLE PANDA (C Barnes) – slow to begin. Steadied and had to take evasive action passing the 750 metres to avoid the fallen POINT PROVEN.

WILD WINGS (E Farr) – crowded leaving the barrier. Steadied and had to take evasive action passing the 750 metres to avoid the fallen POINT PROVEN.

ZAH CHAMP (S Wahab) – improved wide from the 600 metres.

NO NO NO YES (S Wynne) – raced wide in the early and middle stages.

MISSCATTLECREEK (T Moseley) – fell when brought down passing the 750 metres when unable to avoid the fallen POINT PROVEN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to have sustained a fractured off-fore knee, necessitating the mare to be humanely euthanized by the on-course veterinary surgeon.

Following the running of this race Stewards along with Club Officials and Riders were unanimous in the decision that the remainder of the meeting be abandoned.
