RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 INDEPENDENT SECURITY CONSULTANTS HWT (1950 Metres)

DEFER (C Studd) – Began very awkwardly making contact with ROSE SAUVAGE, with rider C Studd becoming unbalanced.

HARBOURBRIDGE (S Phelan) – Crowded leaving the barrier. Crowded and checked passing the 1650.

E Farr SUUFICE TO SAY – Defended a breach of careless riding in that passing the 1650 metres she allowed SUFFICE TO SAY to shift in when not sufficiently clear of LA VAMOS which was dictated into the line of HARBOURBRIDGE who was crowded and checked. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee found the charge proven and suspended E Farr's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 17 April until the conclusion of racing on 25 April, 4 riding days.

FOUR DAY HIGH (T Harris) – Hampered 1650 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of HARBOURBRIDGE which was checked.

NOMBERO (A Roustoby) – Crowded 1650 metres by FOUR DAY HIGH which had been hampered.

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (M McNelis) – Slow to begin.

BARCELONA BABY (G Walsh) — Over-raced early and middle stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. A post-race veterinary examination deemed the mare to have bled. BARCELONA BABY is now subject to a three month stand down from racing in New Zealand and a two month stand down from trackwork. A veterinary certificate is also required prior to racing or trialing next. Trainer S Matthews advised Stewards that the mare will now be retired.

STAGE DIVING (S Fannin) – S Fannin advised the gelding had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

LA VAMOS (R Cole) – R Cole was issued with a warning for using his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres.

Race 2 KAKKALBERRY HWT (1950 Metres)

RYKER (S Phelan) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

S Phelan RYKER - admitted a breach in that he used his whip in an unnecessary manner on a horse that was out of contention with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

NANCHO LASS (C Studd) – Crowded on jumping away.

ROYAL SCEPTRE (A Roustoby) – Crowded on jumping away.

OURS (S Fannin) – Steadied leaving the straight on the first occasion when becoming awkwardly placed.

LACUSTRE (T Harris) – T Harris advised the gelding was not entirely happy in today's track conditions.

I'M ALL EARS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Rider M Gibbs-Manssen was reprimanded after allowing **I'M ALL EARS** to dispute the pace for a distance in the middle stages before asking the gelding to again quicken near the 900 metres when leading before compounding badly inside the final 800 metres.

Race 3 SWEYNESSE 2YO (1230 Metres)

FISCAL FANTASY (M Coleman) - Slow to begin.

O Bosson advised Stewards that he was unwell following this race and subsequently was stood down for the remainder of the day. O Bosson is to provide a medical clearance before riding next.

Race 4 ROTORUA CUP 13 MAY 1230

REMEMBER ROSIE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly, losing ground.

SAPPHIRE SKY (A Collett) - Began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with BRONNY'S LAD.

POKURU FAZZA (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

O'KNOW (M Coleman) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Coleman advised Stewards that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 5 CAMPBELLS INFRASTRUCTURE 3YO (1560 Metres)

SINGLE SPARC (A Collett) - Slow to begin.

YOUVEBEENLITUP (M Cameron) - Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

Race 6 METALCRAFT 1560

FAZED (J Nason) – Crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground. Collapsed when pulling and was humanly euthanased after suffering an internal bleed. Apprentice J Nason sustained a wrist injury and will be seeking further evaluation. Apprentice Nason was advised that he would be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

BLACKJACK MAN (A Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

THELMA (C Grylls) – Could offer no tangible excuses for the performance.

FINNS HALO (S Spratt) – Rider S Spratt was reminded of her obligations with regard to her whip use on a horse that is out of contention.

Race 7 LASER ELECTRICAL ROTORUA 1560

SELOUS (V Colgan) – Rider V Colgan advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

ZAPALI (T Wenn) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CUTTING UP ROUGH (E Farr) – Apprentice E Farr was reminded of her obligations regarding her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

C Grylls - was fined \$100 under the minor infringement schedule for for failing to make the contracted weight on IFFITEL. C Grylls was replaced by L Allpress.

Race 8 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE (1230 Metres)

STOLEN LOVE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly shifting out and hampered BLUE SHADOW which was crowded losing ground.

BLUE SHADOW (M Coleman) – Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. Over-raced through the early stages.

ARRIVISTE (L Allpress) – Rider L Allpress advised that the filly would benefit with the outing in today's testing track conditions.

Race 9 RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA 1400

FOURTOTHEFLOOR (E Farr) – Slow to begin.

CHAMPAGNE TILLY (L Satherley) – Rider L Satherley was reminded of her obligation with regard to her whip use on a runner out of contention.

Race 10 ROTORUA CUP 13 MAY 1400

VALENTINE SECRET was late scratched at 12:53pm due to an error and was reinstated with the permission of the Deputy Chief Executive of New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing at 1:07pm.

VALENTINE SECRET (C Grylls) – Rider C Grylls advised that he eased the mare down after it had failed to handle today's track conditions.

RED DELIGHT (M Coleman) – M Coleman dropped his whip near the 300 metres.
