RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WHITE ROBE LODGE HURDLE (2800m)

DELACROIX (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.

REVENGE (S Higgins) – Jumped the fence near the 1900 metres awkwardly and again near the 1100 metres.

THE QUIET MAN (S Karnicnik) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Hit the fence near the 300 metres, losing ground.

Race 2 CENTRAL SOUTHLAND FREIGHT MAIDEN HURDLE (2500m)

PHEASANT (E Farr) – Shifted outwards when jumping the first fence crowding DRUMGOLD outwards into the line of SEEKING REDEMPTION which was hampered. Hit the fence near the 125 metres losing ground.

SEEKING REDEMPTION (H McNeill) – Hampered when jumping the first fence, losing ground.

DRUMGOLD (A Browne) – Crowded when jumping the first fence. Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1800 metres resulting in rider A Browne becoming unbalanced momentarily.

STRIKE UP THE BAND (S Higgins) – Over-raced in the early stages.

GINGERBREAD MAN (C Studd) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Hit the fence near the 1000 metres.

Race 3 AYTO'S DAIRY & RYDER PLUMBING OREPUKI MAIDEN (2147m)

LOOSE GOOSE (K Kalychurun) – Trainer A Dickson was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 616(4) after presenting the gelding without notified gear (blinkers).

PAYMENT PENDING (K Kwo) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 1200 metres.

SHOCK AND AWE (S Wynne) – Over-raced in the early stages and near the 1900 metres got its head up when being restrained.

BRILLANTE ROSSO (L Hemi) – Made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly.

Race 4 RIVERTON SUPERVALUE & MCKENZIE MENSWEAR MAIDEN (1600m)

INDICATE (C Johnson) – Hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Hung outwards for a distance near the 600 metres.

STRATEGUS (A Morgan) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SIR ED (R Yatim) – Over-raced in the early stages and passing the 1000 metres had to be restrained when awkwardly near heels. Shifted inwards under pressure in the early stages of the final straight having to be straightened near the 200 metres. Raced greenly over the final 100 metres.

BEETHOVEN (S Muniandy) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WHERES THE FOREMAN (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ESSDEEE (P Shaikh) – Steadied near the 550 metres when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of THE YOUNG PRETENDA.

RUBY MARIE (K Kalychurun) – Apprentice rider K Kalychurun was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

Race 5 BRUCE THOMAS @ HARCOURTS & RIVERSIDE RENTALS MAIDEN (1200m)

RED MAJOR (C Barnes) – Slow to begin, then lost contact with the field despite the efforts of its rider. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly forcing DOPPELGANGER wider on the track. Rider C Barnes advised the horse had hung throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ROSAEFLORA (T Moseley) – Crowded shortly after the start.

NESTA (C Johnson) – Commenced to over-race in the early to middle stages and near the 600 metres had to be

steadied for a distance when awkwardly near heels. Held up in the early stages of the home straight and when attempting a marginal run to the inside of RIO TENNILLE near the 250 metres, lay inwards forcing FLAVOURING onto NATIONAL ASSET, DOUBLE CHOICE and MORRIE MAC which had to be steadied. Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

GALWAY GARRY (L Callaway) – Commenced to race ungenerously near the 900 metres and continued to do so for a distance. Steadied momentarily near the 50 metres when racing to the inside of PROMISING (R Yatim) which lay inwards under pressure despite the efforts of its rider.

DOPPELGANGER (K Kalychurun) – Hampered when forced wider on the track by RED MAJOR near the 800 metres. Veered outwards passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

RIO TENILLE (S Wynne) – Lay inwards when placed under pressure over the final 200 metres.

FLAVOURING (L Hemi) – Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

MORRIE MAC (S Muniandy) – Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of NATIONAL ASSET passing the 200 metres.

NATIONAL ASSET (E Farr) – Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

DOUBLE CHOICE (T Comignaghi) – Inconvenienced near the 200 metres.

PROMISING (R Yatim) – Lay inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 6 FORDE AUTO SERVICES & RIVERTON PLUMBING MAIDEN (1200m)

ALL BLACK MAGIC (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Hampered near the 1000 metres. Steadied near the 450 metres when improving up on to the heels of AL BE CIVICS. Held up in the early stages of the final straight having to be steadied and angled inwards across heels to obtain clear running. Lay outwards under pressure over the final 100 metres.

PRINCESS JUBILEE (S Muniandy) – Jumped inwards leaving the barrier crowding GINGA GARN. Hampered near the 1000 metres.

GINGA GARN (K Kalychurun) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

FRIDAY NIGHT (R Beeharry) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE COVER GIRL (A Sharpe) – Went amiss approaching the 1000 metres and when being heavily restrained came back on to the trailing VERIFY, PRINCESS JUBILEE, ALL BLACK MAGIC and PAST THYME, all of which were hampered. THE COVER GIRL was immediately attended to by the on-course Veterinary Surgeon and found to have sustained a fractured left pastern, with the mare being humanely euthanased.

VERIFY (G Jogoo) – Steadied near the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of THE COVER GIRL.

PAST THYME (T Moseley) – Hampered near the 1000 metres.

TAP DIS (S Wynne) – Lay inwards in the early stages of the final straight and near the 250 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly near the heels of VERIFY.

IRISH KATIE (R Yatim) – Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres making contact with the running rail prior to being straightened. Apprentice rider R Yatim reported that the mare had held its breath during the running.

Race 7 EUAN SHEARING CONTRACTING GUMMIE'S BUSH HANDICAP (2147m)

HE AIN'T HEAVY (A Bohorun) - Slow to begin.

STARBUCK (R Yatim) – Over-raced in the early stages. Contacted the running rail entering the bend near the 1600 metres.

LADY EM (E Farr) - Raced wide in the early stages.

POINT PROVEN (T Moseley) – Raced wide from the 1200 metres. Lay inwards through the early stages of the final straight with the rider changing whip hands in an attempt to rectify this tendency.

Race 8 COLAC BAY TAVERN SOUTHERN CHAMPION HACK HANDICAP (2147m)

A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT (R Yatim) — Began awkwardly losing ground. Apprentice rider R Yatim reported that the gelding had been inclined to change its leading leg on numerous occasions during the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

THE GORDONIAN (G Jogoo) – Lay inwards under pressure near the 200 metres.

THOUGHT THAT (C Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson reported in his opinion the gelding had not been entirely suited by the prevailing track conditions.

Race 9 AB LIME LONGWOOD HANDICAP (1400m)

COUP DARCI BE (A Morgan) – Slow to begin. Shifted inwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 10 MENNIES MINI DIG & PGG WRIGHTSON HANDICAP (1400m)

LIKEWISE (R Yatim) – Underwent and subsequently passed a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing up and falling in the birdcage. Apprentice rider R Yatim was uninjured in this incident. Crowded shortly after the start. Commenced to weaken from the 600 metres and was not persevered by its rider thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

SHAKTI (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied over the concluding stages when in restricted room between PRINCE RANSOM and ALOTTATOW which shifted outwards under pressure.

ALOTTATOW (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

WEAPON OF CHOICE (K Kalychurun) – Over-raced in the early stages and when negotiating the junction near the 1300 metres shifted outwards hampering IN HER WAKE.

IN HER WAKE (K Mudhoo) – Steadied near the 1300 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of WEAPON OF CHOICE.

PETER PARKER (K Kwo) – Over-raced in the early stages and near the 1200 metres when being restrained, dipped losing ground.

SNIPARINDA (T Comignaghi) – Shifted outwards under pressure near the 150 metres briefly inconveniencing TWIZEL GURU.

TWIZEL GURU (J Lowry) – Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

RISKY FLIGHT (C Barnes) – Rider C Barnes reported that the mare had held its breath during the running.

Race 11 TORRESDALE SUFFOLK STUD THORNBURY HANDICAP (1400m)

AMUN RA (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

MASTER KARSTEN (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (K Williams) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1000 metres when leading.

GALLANT DEFENDER (S Muniandy) – Steadied near the 550 metres when awkwardly placed near the heels of the weakening MELS EVIE. Rider S Muniandy reported the gelding had held its breath during the running.
