## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>LEE &amp; LAURIE WILDE MAIDEN 1000</b>
<b>LET HER RIP RILEY</b> (L Hemi) - Got its head up and being steadied to take a trail in the early stages.	
<b>BOB'STHEJOB</b> (D Hirini) - Raced wide throughout.	
<b>BELTOY</b> (L Allpress) - When spoken to regarding performance rider advised the filly would take natural benefit from today's race and would be competitive when dropping back to a 2 year old only race.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>BURKHART FISHERIES RATING 85</b>
<b>ELLERSTINA</b> (T Moseley) - Bounded at the start losing ground. Made the bend at the 600 metres awkwardly.	
<b>HOMELAND</b> (G Jogoo) - Was slow through the early stages.	
<b>TIEBREAKER</b> (P Shaikh) - Crowded and had to be restrained when SABER (R Hannam) crossed to the lead. R Hannam was advised to exercise greater care.	
<b>CARAMAC</b> (D Hirini) - Raced wide throughout.	

<b>CELTIC CROSS</b> (R Firdhaus) - Raced wide throughout and lay inwards passing the 50 metres and had to be straightened.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MORE FM MAIDEN</b>
<b>HIGHBROOK</b> (R Hannam) - Raced keenly early stages.	
<b>NABIAC</b> (L Allpress) - Wide throughout.	
<b>EION</b> (D Hirini) - Commenced to race keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres. Denied a marginal run passing the 250 metres and was then held up for clear racing room until inside the final 100 metres.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>DOMINION SALT RATING 65</b>
<b>FUNNY</b> (D Turner) - Began awkwardly losing ground as a result.	
<b>NOWHERE MAN</b> (C Johnson) - Raced very keenly through the early stages and was obliged to improve wide from the 800 metres.	
<b>CHIC</b> (S MacNab) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres and had to be restrained off the heels of MOTHER SUPERIOR passing the 800 metres. Apprentice rider S MacNab was spoken to advisedly in regard to her whip use outside the 200 metres.	
<b>BRUEGEL</b> (L Hemi) - Held up rounding the bend passing the 400 metres only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250.	
<b>STRAIGHT SETS</b> (L Allpress) - Lay out over the final 200 metres and had to be straightened passing the 75 metres.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>WOODBOURNE TAVERN RATING 75</b>
<b>THE REAL DEAL</b> (R Hannam) - Proved difficult to load into the gates delaying the start.	
<b>HOT DATE</b> (C Johnson) - Slow to begin then raced keenly in early stages and had to be steadied off heels passing the 1100 metres.	
<b>BISOU BISOU</b> (S MacNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages and then had to improve very wide passing the 400 metres. Stewards spoke to rider S MacNab in the presence of her employer Mr K Myers with regard to her ride on BISOU BISOU. Miss MacNab advised that she had been left wide without cover and elected to restrain her mount to obtain cover as she believed that would be in the best interests of the mare. When asked why she had not improved her position passing the 800 metres when an opportunity existed Miss MacNab advised that she wished to keep in cover and follow another runner into the race but no one improved until the home turn and then when she made her move her mount was forced very wide when inside runners also shifted out to make their runs. Stewards noted Miss MacNab’s explanation.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MARLBOROUGH EXPRESS MAIDEN</b>
<b>SHARP ELLE</b> (T Moseley) - Began awkwardly.	
<b>MACTAVISH</b> (D Hirini) - Shifted out at the start hampering ENEFESS (P Shaikh) which lost ground. Forced over extra ground racing around the first bend and was then obliged to improve forward before obtaining cover at the 1100 metres.	
<b>ENEFESS</b> (P Shaikh) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Had to be steadied off heels of the runner in front when passing the 900 metres when the pace slowed slightly.	
<b>I’M HORACE</b> (R Hannam) - Momentarily unbalanced passing the 300 metres.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>PETER YEALANDS WINES CUP PRELUDE</b>
<b>SUZERAIN</b> (R Hannam) - Slow to begin.	
<b>SHOW MACCOOL</b> (D Turner) - Improved wide from the 1200 metres to sit outside the leader passing the 800 metres. Lay out passing the 300 metres making contact with ZHANIM (L Allpress).	
<b>ZENTANGLE</b> (S MacNab) - Crowded and placed in restricted room for a short distance when SHOW MACCOOL (D Turner) shifted in passing the 650 metres. D Turner was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).	

**Race 8****SPEIGHTS RATING**

**MISSTEEFLYING** (R Firdhaus) - Shifted out hampering WAZUZU (D Hirini) which lost ground.

**WAZUZU** (D Hirini) - Hampered start lost ground.

**CASEY MARIE** (R Hannam) - Began awkwardly.

**LINDIS PASS** (L Callaway) - Was slow to begin.

**STAR OF GREENBEEL** (C Johnson) - Raced keenly when leading through the early to middle stages.

**LINDIS PASS** (L Callaway) - Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1500 metres when racing keenly.

**PALACIO** (L Allpress) - Held up rounding the final bend. Placed in restricted room passing the 300 metres when MISSTEEFLYING (R Firdhaus) who was laying in shifted in momentarily.
