RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MARKS EWEN & ASSOCIATES 2000
EYES OF BOTH (S Weatherley) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting out abruptly forcing BATTLE ROYAL out on to CHEEX with both those runners being hampered. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.	
BATTLE ROYAL (D Danis) – Hampered start.	
CHEEX (C Grylls) – Hampered start.	

ROSE SAUVAGE (A Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly then was further hampered when BIZZWINKLE jumped away awkwardly shifting out abruptly.

THE OTHER HALF (K Cowan) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

LADY FERNER (T Thornton) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

NOMBERO (M Du Plessis) – Shifted out near the 250 metres making contact with FOUR DAY HIGH.

Race 2	DON GRIFFITHS TRENCHING LTD 1200

BUFFIT (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Trainer P Mirabelli advised Stewards that the gelding was showing signs of lameness in its left foreleg following the race.

MALAMBO (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin. Was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

VEINE D'OR (C Lammas) – Blundered leaving the barrier. Lay out making the final bend, and had to be steadied when placed in restricted room between PACIFIC COAST which had shifted ground outwards, and MALAMBO which lay in.

MONGOLIAN BEAUTY (M Cameron) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PACIFIC COAST (O Bosson) – Shifted out early in the final straight when attempting to find clear running before being held up for a distance until near the 175 metres.

GRIFFIN (M McNab) – Was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure inside the final 150 metres. Trainers S Autridge and J Richards were issued a warning for presenting GRIFFIN to race without the notified gear (tongue tie).

THE BOY WONDER (C Grylls) – Had to steady near the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GRIFFIN (M McNab) which lay out when placed under pressure. M McNab was advised to exercise care.

ZABEELIOUS (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

BLUE SHADOW (M Coleman) – Jumped away awkwardly.

MY SMILEY O'REILLY (T Thornton) – Jumped away awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

DARCI'S DAUGHTER (D Danis) – Jumped away awkwardly.

VERDANT (D Johnson) – Lay out and raced greenly rounding the bend.

FLASH GRIS (J Nason) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 800 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After being examined by the course veterinarian FLASH GRIS was confirmed as a bleeder, and as this is now the second occasion in which the gelding has bled it is now ineligible for any further racing in New Zealand.

MAGIC CANNON (C Lammas) – Raced wide throughout.

SHELLEZ ACE (A Jones) – Rider A Jones advised Stewards that in her opinion the filly would be better suited to more rain affected footing.

<p>REMEMBER ROSIE (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>DETACH (S Collett) – Shifted out shortly after leaving the barrier forcing HEAVENLY GOLD, CLAYDON and OLYMPIC wider on the track.</p> <p>PINKO MOON (V Gatu) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LEICA WARRIOR (T Thornton) – Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly shifting out forcing PINKO MOON over extra ground.</p> <p>OLYMPIC (C Grylls) – Held up until inside the final 100 metres.</p> <p>IT’S ALL MAGIC (M Cameron) – When questioned regarding the performance rider M Cameron could offer no excuse.</p>	
Race 5	THE BOLTHOLDER LIMITED 1400
<p>DEEJAY MAC (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ROUGH CONDUCT (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Bumped near the 1000 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced.</p> <p>BARLEANER (M Du Plessis) – Raced keenly in the early stages shifting in near the 1000 metres making contact with the hind quarters of ROUGH CONDUCT which became momentarily unbalanced.</p>	
Race 6	MATAMATA GLASS & JOINERY 1400
<p>IMELDAS GIRL (A Collett) – Reared as the gates opened losing ground.</p> <p>SECRET DREAMS (L Satherley) – Shifted in abruptly when racing greenly approaching the 1200 metres inconveniencing SWISSILICIOUS.</p> <p>SWISSILICIOUS (V Gatu) – Inconvenienced approaching the 1200 metres.</p>	
Race 7	AA AUTO SERVICE & REPAIR MATAMATA 1400
<p>FAWN (M Cameron) – Slow to begin, and then blundered shortly after.</p> <p>O’KNOW (O Bosson) – Slow to begin. Shifted out near the 300 metres making slight contact with ICING ON THE CAKE.</p> <p>RASPBERRY SWEET (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages before having to be firmly restrained when awkwardly placed on heels near the 1000 metres, then continued to over-race having to shift out abruptly near the 900 metres. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly running wide. Improved on to heels having to steady just short of the finish.</p> <p>ICING ON THE CAKE (B R Jones) – Over-raced in the early stages, having to be firmly restrained off heels near the 950 metres dropping back on to PROVISION which had to be firmly restrained.</p> <p>PROVISION (A Collett) – Over-raced in the middle stages. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 950 metres.</p> <p>SILK (A Jones) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages having to be firmly restrained when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres, and shifted out hampering AMOUR LA VIE. Was steadied when placed in restricted room to the outside of RASPBERRY SWEET which shifted out abruptly to avoid heels when over-racing near the 900 metres.</p>	

AMOUR LA VIE (M Coleman) – Hampered near the 1000 metres.

HELLO SAILOR (S Weatherley) – Hung outwards throughout.

THE SECRET'S OUT (D Johnson) – Blundered leaving the barrier.

SO TRUE (K Cowan) – Slow to begin.

VOLEUSE (K McCulloch) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BELLA BLUE (A Collett) – Raced keenly in the middle stages when racing in restricted room passing the 800 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight making contact with VOLEUSE near the 200 metres.

Race 9	CHALLENGE MATAMATA 1600

READY TO ROCK (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin.

EL HEALO (R Norvall) – Slow to begin.

FLASH AS (M Hills) – Jumped away awkwardly.

HALLAVABOY (D Danis) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

LEARNING TO FLY (O Bosson) – Rider O Bosson advised Stewards that the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

Race 10	MATAMATA GLASS & JOINERY 2000

FOUR DEGREES (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly.

NEWTON (O Bosson) – Jumped away awkwardly shifting out placing EKAROSA in restricted room with that runner losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Rider O Bosson advised that the gelding had raced keenly and got its tongue over the bit during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

CURIOUS (K Cowan) – Raced wide for the majority of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

EKAROSA (S Collett) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start losing ground.

DANIECE (T Thornton) – Inconvenienced when weakening approaching the 400 metres.

MARSHAL (M Hills) – Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 250 metres.

IN A MINUTE (E Farr) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.
