Race 2 - Prodrive Golf Wellington 2YO (1200 Metres)

SMOKIN' OAK (S Collett) – Trainer J Bary advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of SMOKIN' OAK. The gelding has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SSANGYONG 2100

LONG HARBOUR (E Farr) – Began awkwardly and shifted outwards making firm contact with ARITE GURU. Lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

I'M ALL EARS (S Karnicnik) – Crowded shortly after the start having to steady.

JACK ROMANOV (E Goodinson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JOKING (C Kennedy) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages.

TE WAEWAE BAY (H McNeill) – Raced wide until near the 1200 metres.

ARITE GURU (C Studd) – Bumped on jumping away. Raced wide without cover from the 1000 metres. Shifted in abruptly passing the 400 metres making firm contact with LONGFORD.

NOTABADROOSTER (S Phelan) – Lost the off hind plate during the running.

Rider C Kennedy (JOKING) – Admitted a breach under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used the whip excessively on JOKING prior to the 200 metres, and was fined the sum of \$400.

Race 2 NRM 1200

Trainer K Fawcett was fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Rule for late declaration of rider for TATTYBOGLER.

TICKET TO RIDE (A Collett) – After becoming fractious in its barrier stall TICKET TO RIDE was declared a late scratching at 12.07 pm on veterinary advice with the connections being advised that the mare must barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

IRISH MISSILE (K McCulloch) - Slow to begin.

REPO SUN (M Du Plessis) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied.

SILVER CLOUD (D Johnson) – Lay in under pressure despite the efforts of its rider placing LOVERS LANE in restricted room which then lay out becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SILVER CLOUD having to be steadied near the 300 metres. Rider O Bosson viewed the Stewards video footage and elected not to proceed with a protest. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

LOVERS LANE (O Bosson) – Placed in restricted room near the 300 metres then lay out becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied.

MISTY REIN (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MISSISSIPPI (G Saejorhor) – Rider G Saejorhor dropped his whip passing the 100 metres.

Race 3 WWW.PUKEKOHEPARK.CO.NZ

PHILOSOPHICAL (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MAHIRAH (D Prastiyou) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

BRAAVOS (C Lammas) – Over-raced in the early stages. Shifted in abruptly making firm contact with SECRET BELLE passing the 350 metres.

DR GREENGRASS (S Weatherley) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

INNAMINCKA (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Bumped 400 metres.

SMILING MORE (M Cameron) – Commenced to lay in under pressure passing the 400 metres making contact with INNAMINCKA.

MAQUIS (T Thornton) – Held up until near the 200 metres having to shift out to obtain clear running.

SECRET BELLE (M Du Plessis) – Bumped 350 metres becoming briefly unbalanced. Lost the off fore plate during the running.

Race 4 LINDAUER LADIES DAY 21ST JUNE

HARBOURBRIDGE (S Higgins) – Began awkwardly.

PEACE PALACE (S Karnicnik) – Slow to begin.

FLAGSTAFF (C Kennedy) and BRAT PACK buffeted for several strides when in restricted room to the inside of LA VAMOS which shifted in and WHOPPER'S which shifted out and away from OUTSIDER near the 1100 metres resulting in BRAT PACK and FLAGSTAFF losing ground.

BRAT PACK (E Farr) – Buffeted for several strides near the 1100 metres losing ground.

WHOPPER'S (A Kuru) – Had to steady passing the 800 metres when awkwardly placed inside heels.

PYTHAGORAS (T Harris) – Shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Race 5 HAUNUI FARM 1400

TIME ALONE (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TAVANOTHER (L Satherley) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running.

TARANTINO (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly and shifted out abruptly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

UNBREAKABLE (T Thornton) – Raced three wide without cover.

MASTERCARD (K McCulloch) – Held up early in the final straight, and when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 450 meters made firm contact with YOUR GRACE. Rider K McCulloch was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. Shifted away from L'ESCALIER ROSE passing the 300 metres further hampering YOUR GRACE.

YOUR GRACE M Cameron) – Contacted and unbalanced 450 metres. Hampered 300 metres.

POKER FACE (M McNab) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out across heels passing the 200 metres.

VINORULES (L Innes) – Lost the off fore plate during the running.

Race 6 FASTTRACK INSURANCE 1400

SMOKE HOUSE BAY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly getting its head up and shifting out abruptly taking no further part in the race. Trainer S Autridge was advised the mare would be required to barrier trial prior to racing next.

NINA ARORA (A Collett) – Began awkwardly. Got its head up when being steadied passing the 1200 metres and raced ungenerously for a distance, making the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly. Was briefly held up passing the 400 metres having to shift in to obtain clear running.

MELODY CELEBRE (K McCulloch) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BROKEN HEART (M McNab) – Commenced to over-race in the early stages shifting out making contact with CORPORATE MISSILE with that runner having to be steadied near the 1200 metres.

CORPORATE MISSILE (C Lammas) – Hampered having to be steadied 1200 metres.

COSTA BRAVO (M Coleman) – Over-raced for a distance passing the 900 metres. Was held up early in the final straight having to shift out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

CHAMBON (M Cameron) – When questioned into the disappointing performance rider M Cameron advised the filly may prefer to be ridden further back than on this occasion and on a more rain affected track.

Race 7 HAPPY 65TH BIRTHDAY MALCOLM WRIGLEY

HE'S CAVALIER (R Scott) – Began awkwardly, and was hampered shortly after having to be steadied.

JUMANAH (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MATO GROSSO (K Marzuki) – Shifted in approaching the 1000 metres when not clear of BRILLEAUX which had to be checked having to shift in hampering DRAGON DANCER. Also affected was CONRWIN. Rider K Marzuki admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing today, up to and including racing on 24 May, 5 riding days.

BRILLEAUX (T Wenn) – Checked near the 1000 metres, and continued to race ungenerously for a distance.

DRAGON DANCER (D Prastiyou) – Hampered near the 1000 metres, and continued to race ungenerously for a distance. Stable representative Mr A Peard advised Stewards that the gelding had bled, and as such will be subjected to a three month stand down from racing, and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing again. Mr Peard also advised that the gelding was unlikely to be persevered with as a racing proposition.

CONRWIN (A Schwerin) – Hampered 1000 metres.

KENSINGTON (M McNab) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 8 MOUNT SHOP 1400

BANBURY LAD (M McNab) - Slow to begin, and then was further hampered when PIAZZETTA shifted in.

PIAZZETTA (M Coleman) – Began awkwardly, and shifted in making contact with BANBURY LAD.

I'LLAV BUBBLES (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

RUBY ARMANI (M Du Plessis) - Began awkwardly after being restless in its barrier. Got its head up when being steadied near the 900 metres. Shifted away from CINEMATIC passing the 200 metres making brief contact with BLUE WAGON.

CINEMATIC (A Collett) – Inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 LONE STAR PUKEKOHE 1600

HIGH CLASS (A Collett) - Slow to begin.

SPRITZ (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

IDAHO'S CHOICE (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover.

SPROCKET (M Cameron) – When questioned into the performance of SPROCKET rider M Cameron advised the gelding may take some improvement out of the run. SPROCKET underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
