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## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WILDTRIBE CATERING @ TE RAPA RACECOURSE HURDLES</b>
<b>VOLACAPRI</b> (H McNeill) – Slow away.	
<b>ZED LEPPHELIN</b> (G Bourke) – Jumped in the air leaving the barriers losing ground. Jumped indifferently throughout.	
<b>FINNS HALO</b> (C Studd) – Began awkwardly losing ground.	
<b>THE TALISMAN</b> (E Goodinson) – Raced wide for the majority of the race.	

**NOAH JON** (G Walsh) – Raced wide without cover from near the 1600 metres.

**PERRY MASON** (A Kuru) – Ran down the fence near the 350 metres inconveniencing NOTHING TRIVIAL. Jumped the last fence awkwardly.

**NOTHING TRIVIAL** (R Cole) – Inconvenienced after jumping fence near 350 metres.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PORRITT SAND HURDLES</b>
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**DANZA LAD** (S Higgins) – Ran down several fences early in the running when racing keenly. Put in a poor jump near the 1200 metres.

**HUNTERS CREEK** (G Walsh) – Was showing signs of lameness on return to the enclosure. A post-race veterinary examination found damage to the flexor tendon in the right foreleg with a veterinary clearance being required prior to racing next.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>DOUBLE R 2100</b>
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**MARTINIZ SPECIAL** (A Schwerin) – Began awkwardly shifting out and made contact. Raced in restricted room 1800 metres and was steadied.

**MEESKA MOOSKA** (D Johnson) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of BALHAM (M Du Plessis) which shifted in passing the 1800 metres. Rider M Du Plessis was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must be fully clear when shifting ground. As a result MARTINIZ SPECIAL raced in restricted room to the inside of MEESKA MOOSKA for a distance.

**JOCHEN RINDT** (S Spratt) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Spratt advised that the gelding would appreciate further easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have mild lameness of hind limbs with a veterinary clearance being required prior to racing next.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>KEN &amp; ROGER BROWNE MEMORIAL STEEPLECHASE</b>
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**PALEMO** (S Fannin) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to race.

A false start was declared after several runners anticipated the start and cantered a short distance.

**BEVERLEY BECK** (S Higgins) – Made heavy contact with MENDOZA when jumping the second fence and then jumped indifferently for the remainder of the race.

**MENDOZA** (S Karnicnik) – Heavily contacted when jumping the second fence and became unbalanced. Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Returned to the enclosure with blood in the left nostril which was found to be from an abrasion.

**ISTIMAGIC** (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the third fence with rider G Walsh losing the use of his left iron for a distance. ISTIMAGIC then jumped indifferently becoming tailed off and being pulled up passing the 1000 metres.

**MISTER DEEJAY** (C Price) – Put in a poor jump at the seventh fence dislodging rider C Price who was uninjured.

**ZARDETTO** (A Kuru) – When jumping the ninth fence landed on the hind quarters of ZENOCOIN which was badly hampered with ZARDETTO then falling and dislodging rider A Kuru. ZARDETTO underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be lame in the right hind leg, and will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next. Rider **A Kuru** was transferred to hospital for further evaluation.

**ZENOCOIN** (E Farr) – Badly hampered ninth fence.

**DERBY DAN** (H McNeill) – Misjudged the ninth fence and fell dislodging rider H McNeill who was uninjured. Returned to the enclosure with blood in the right nostril which was found to be from an abrasion.

**FAIR SCRIPT** (S Phelan) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

**BRER** (W Gordon) – Hampered shortly after jumping the last fence by a riderless horse.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>PRINT HOUSE 1200</b>
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The start of this race was delayed 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.

**PRECISION MISS** (L Allpress) – Slow to begin then was further hampered. Raced in restricted room approaching the 900 metres and then was hampered when making brief contact with the running rail.

**PERSUASIVE** (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>WAIKATO EQUINE VETERINARY CENTRE STAKES</b>
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**NOT USUAL TRIP** (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded shortly after losing ground.

**AQUILO** (M McNab) – Began awkwardly then was crowded shortly after losing ground. Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 400 metres making contact with the hind quarters of SOPHIE'S CHOICE and then held up, continuing to be held up until near the 100 metres.

**HAUSSMANN** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**SANTUZZA** (L Allpress) – Got its head up and raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 900 metres and continued to do so for a distance.

**SOPHIE'S CHOICE** (K McCulloch) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 400 metres and lay in and become unbalanced when contacted.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>HAMILTON TAXIS – FASTTRACK \$5K 1600</b>
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**STREET SMART** (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

**LADY ROSEANNE** (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly.

**VOLER POUR MOI** (C Grylls) – Slow to begin and then was further hampered.

**SWINGING SKIRTS** (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Inconvenienced 300 metres and then was inclined to lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

**SONOROUS** (T Wenn) – Began awkwardly.

**SHONALI** (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

**SHOCK HORROR** (M Cameron) – Shifted out abruptly leaving the barrier. Made contact passing the 500 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

**IMPULSIVE HABIT** (T Thornton) – Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 900 metres to the inside SONOROUS (T Wenn) and was the steadied. Apprentice Rider T Wenn was advised to exercise greater care. IMPULSIVE HABIT lay out when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres, inconveniencing SWINGING SKIRTS.

**SASANOF'S HERO** (D Johnson) – Was held up for clear running early in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed inside the hind quarters of IMPULSIVE HABIT passing the 250 before obtaining clear running.

**DUKEBOX** (M Tanaka) – Raced three wide without cover.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>NZI 1600</b>
<p><b>M McNab</b> was fined \$200.00 under the Minor Infringement Schedule for failing to make the contracted weight on NO NEED. M McNab was replaced by M Du Plessis.</p> <p><b>SACRED EMPIRE</b> (L Innes) – Slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.</p> <p><b>ADRIATIC PEARL</b> (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Hampered when crowded passing the 1300 metres to the inside of MALIBU MISS which lay in. Held up until approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>MALIBU MISS</b> (L Allpress) – Raced in restricted room early in the final straight before shifting out passing the 150 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p><b>GREENCAST</b> (S Spratt) – Steadied passing the 1100 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of LUCKY FEATHER (M Tanaka) which shifted in when not fully clear. As a result GREENCAST shifted in placing KEELY BE in restricted room for a distance, with KEELY BE then steadying. Rider <b>M Tanaka</b> was reprimanded by Stewards and issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>KEELY BE</b> (M Coleman) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 1100 metres for a distance then steadied.</p> <p><b>PRIZE LAD</b> (S Weatherley) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 250 metres.</p> <p><b>TOMELILLA</b> (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>TOPSOIL &amp; SAND SUPPLIES 1200</b>
<p><b>QUANTUM</b> (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>TELLYAWHAT</b> (A Chan) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Commenced to over-race and made the bend approaching the 900 metres awkwardly running wide, hampering ROC ME and SLEEPING BEAUTY. Shifted out to obtain clear running 200 metres.</p> <p><b>ROC ME</b> (M Tanaka) – Placed in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied. Hampered approaching the 900 metres being forced wider.</p> <p><b>PLAY FOR TIME</b> (M McNab) – Raced keenly when being restrained approaching the 900 metres then making the bend awkwardly. Raced in restricted room approaching the 200 metres to the outside of TELLYAWHAT (A Chan) which shifted out slightly with PLAY FOR TIME then being further crowded by SLEEPING BEAUTY which lay in under pressure. Apprentice rider A Chan was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to have a delayed recovery with an elevated respiratory rate.</p> <p><b>SLEEPING BEAUTY</b> (C Grylls) – Hampered approaching the 900 metres being forced wider.</p> <p><b>COMMAND ROYALE</b> (D Johnson) – Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SOUND WORKS</b> (C Lammas) – Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p><b>MAENOHA</b> (M Hills) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>LEGRAMOR</b> (L Innes) – When questioned regarding performance rider L Innes advised the filly would benefit from today's outing.</p>
