GENERAL:

Rider L Callaway advised on Friday evening that he would be unable to make the weight for his mounts in races 2 and 3 and was replaced as recorded in the above Summary. **L Callaway** was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MID WINTER CHRISTMAS RACES JUNE 24 PREMIER (1400m)			
HOT DATE (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.				
ELFEE (S Wynne)	- Slow to begin.			

TOETWOTOE (R Cuneen) - Crowded on jumping and lost ground. Rider was unable to offer any tangible excuse for poor performance.

LUKE (K Kwo) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WILLOW (J Lowry) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the mare had travelled comfortably until placed under pressure when it had been quickly beaten and was unable to offer any excuses other than being second up after a brief spell may have been a factor. A post race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate, with the connections advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to racing next.

Race 2

DAVID EMERSON ACCOUNTANT & BUSINESS CONSULTANT PREMIER (2000m)

SON OF ZAC (S Collett) - Very slow to begin when reluctant to jump away losing several lengths. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding for its barrier manners, with co-trainer Mr K Hughes advising it is now his intention to send the gelding for a spell. Improved into a tight run between JIMMY and FIRST OF A KIND near the 800 metres then making contact with FIRST OF A KIND when attempting to continue to improve to the outside of MONTOYA STAR when there was insufficient room to do so with SON OF ZAC and FIRST OF A KIND continuing to come together for a distance. Rider S Collett was advised to exercise greater care. Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight making contact with FIRST OF A KIND when shifting outwards to obtain clear running near the 350 metres.

S Collett - Issued with a warning for her whip use early in the final straight.

JIMMY (T Moseley) - Tended to over race in the middle stages and raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

FIRST OF A KIND (C Barnes) - Bumped with SON OF ZAC on a number of occasions passing the 800 metres, bumped again at the 350 metres.

SHEZATOUCHA (T Comignaghi) - Steadied to avoid the heels of ABLAZE (J Lowry) which shifted inwards near the 350 metres when not fully clear. J Lowry was advised to exercise greater care.

PARANA (A Collett) - Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room near the 50 metres.

Race 3 NZI PREMIER (1600m)

MONTRACHET (R Firdhaus) - Jumped away awkwardly.

AMUN RA (L Hemi) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

NIGHT NURSE (C Johnson) - Held up rounding the final turn before obtaining clear running near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider C Johnson was unable to offer any excuses.

LAAFFAIRE (K Williams) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running throughout the final straight.

Race 4 ANGUS MEATS PREMIER (1200m)

ENZO'S LAD (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

FIVE KINGS (S Collett) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages, inconvenienced near the 100 metres when DYNAMIC shifted outwards away from ENZO'S LAD.

SHAARA (T Comignaghi) - Raced wide throughout.

TICKETS ON HER (G Jogoo) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight.

Race 5BERKLEY STUD CHAMPAGNE STAKES (1200m)

OUR TEDDY BOY (L Hemi) - Jumped away awkwardly.

FINBARR (K Kalychurun) - Jumped away awkwardly.

WITHORN (R Cuneen) - Slow to begin, commenced to over race near the 900 metres then having to be further restricted when LET HER RIP RILEY (C Barnes) shifted inwards when not fully clear. C Barnes was advised to exercise greater care.

DISRUPTION (S Collett) - Raced wide throughout, raced ungenerously when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

VISHNU (T Moseley) - When questioned regarding disappointing performance, rider could offer tangible excuse, advising that the filly had travelled comfortably enough until placed under pressure when it failed to respond. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY PREMIER (1200m)

CINDERELLA (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly making contact with LORD SIBFORD.

LORD SIBFORD (D Turner) - Bumped start.

CANTILENA (S Wynne) - Restrained leaving the barriers to obtain a position with cover. Raced ungenerously when being restrained crossing the junction onto the course proper passing the 800 metres.

AUGUSTACE (T Moseley) - Raced wide throughout.

LITTLE MISS (T Comignaghi) - Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when SUGGESTIVE LOOX shifted inwards.

Race 7 REDWOOD GREAT AUTUMN HANDICAP (2500m)

MOTORBOAT MIKE (T Comignaghi) - Crowded on jumping.

SAINT KITT (L Callaway) - Over raced in the early to middle stages. Bumped 600 metres. Rider was of the opinion that the gelding had got its tongue over the bit during the running which had been detrimental to its performance.

BLOODSTREAM (A Collett) - Shifted outwards to obtain clear running making contact with SAINT KITT near the 600 metres.

SUREASYOUWEREBORN (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final turn shifting outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

MISS THREE STARS (S Wynne) - Inclined to lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.

SHOW MACCOOL (S Collett) - Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding had not been suited by the holding nature of today's track.

Race 8 SPEIGHT'S MID ALE GREAT EASTER STAKES (1400m)

The start was delayed approximately 7 minutes due to FLYING IBIS requiring re-plating behind the barriers.

MEURSAULT (A Collett) - Jumped away awkwardly.

A Collett - Spoken to regarding her whip use prior to the 200 metres.

RINGO (H Tinsley) - Crowded on jumping. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

KOXINGA (T Moseley) - Over raced in the middle stages.

MAYBE MIAMI (S Collett) - Rider dropped whip near the 50 metres.

LATIN ROSE (S Wynne) - Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. A post race veterinary examination revealed a poor rate of recovery and some slight stiffness at walk.

Race 9 NRM PREMIER (1600m)

RAWMATERIAL (L Hemi) - Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping crowding YOURLIPS AR MOVIN onto SUSIE WOLFF.

SUSIE WOLFF (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start losing ground, tended to lay in under pressure in the final straight.

YOURLIPS AR MOVIN (R Cuneen) - Crowded at the start, steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 700 metres, hampered 350 metres.

TWILIGHT REBEL (A Collett) - Raced wide throughout.

PASSAMAQUODDY (K Kalychurun) - Steadied to avoid heels passing the 1000 metres.

PRINCE RANSOM (P Shaikh) - Over raced when disputing the pace in the middle stages, shifted outwards under pressure early in the final straight when not fully clear of RAWMATERIAL which was dictated outwards into the line of QUEEN SERENE which was steadied with YOURLIPS AR MOVIN also being hampered as a result. Apprentice rider **P** Shaikh was issued with a warning.

MINERVA (R Firdhaus) - Held up rounding the final turn and unable to obtain clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

QUEEN SERENE (C Johnson) - Held up entering the final straight, further hampered when having to be steadied to avoid heels near the 350 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider C Johnson advised that the mare had not felt comfortable in today's track conditions.
