A Kuru and H McNeill did not attend the meeting due to injury and their respective replacements are listed above.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1200M

The race was delayed approximately seven minutes due to DANCE FOR MONEY escaping from behind the barrier.

DANCE FOR MONEY (R Goldsbury) - Dislodged rider R Goldsbury behind the barrier and galloped a short distance prior to being recaptured. DANCE FOR MONEY underwent a veterinary inspection and was cleared to start. DANCE FOR MONEY lay in near the 800 metres momentarily hampering MUTECHI.

ENTICING (D Turner) – Slow away.

HE'S A FREAK (M McNab) — Tightened shortly after start. Held up in tight quarters passing the 500 metres and bumped with PLATINUM VOLOS when attempting to obtain a run. Rider M McNab reported the gelding raced greenly throughout and in his opinion would improve with experience.

DARCINSKY PRINCESS (L Allpress) – Tightened shortly after start then over-raced early.

ALLURE (L Hemi) – Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

MUTECHI (C Johnson) – Shifted in shortly after the start hampering HE'S A FREAK. C Johnson was advised to exercise greater care. C Johnson reported MUTECHI raced greenly throughout.

AUTHENTIC CHARM (R Hannam) – Over-raced into the first turn.

Race 2 FAULDINGS SOUND 1200M

KATE THE GREAT (S Weatherley) – Awkwardly away, then raced greenly in the home straight when under pressure.

STEALTH GIANT (A Chan) – Awkwardly away, then raced greenly throughout.

STAR QUALITY (M Tanaka) – Was slow away and had to be restrained when in tight quarters passing the 800 metres.

JUSTA SMALL RANSOM (L Allpress) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MISTRESS POROTENE (M McNab) – Had to be straightened when shifting in under pressure near the 250 metres resulting in KATE THE GREAT shifting away from that runner.

TRIFLE - A Collett was shown footage of her ride and reminded of her obligation regarding the use of the whip in the home straight.

Race 3 JOLT COFFEE HOUSE HWT 2050M

MACKLEMORE (S Karnicnik) – Saddle slipped early in the race placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder. MACKLEMORE lost the lead bag passing the 800 metres.

LONELY BOY (C Price) – Reared at the start settling back.

WIGGLE (W Gordon) - Was slow away.

THE SHACKLER (S Phelan) - Shifted out abruptly shortly after the start bumping JONQUIL, then bumped with SEA KING passing the 500 metres.

JONQUIL (I Lupton) - shifted out over the final stages dictating EVA JENSINE outwards.

EVA JENSINE (S Fannin) – Had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres when **LONELY BOY (C Price)** shifted out when not clear. C Price was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).

NOM DU BEEL (G Walsh) - was attended to post-race after returning to the tie-ups in a distressed state. The gelding was attended to by the veterinary surgeon who noted a poor recovery rate.

Race 4 G BRISTOL & SONS 2050M

SALVINIA (S Weatherley) – Raced three-wide without cover rounding the first turn, being allowed to roll forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 1,000 metres. Rider S Weatherley reported that the mare had been unsuited to today's Slow 8 track conditions.

WHOSHOTMYMATE (D Bradley) – Slow away and then raced ungenerously when wide without cover in the early stages.

TOBY'S CHOICE (H Andrew) – Raced greenly and hung throughout. Had to be restrained when in tight quarters approaching the 900 metres.

ROC 'N' IT (R Hannam) – raced three-wide without cover from the 1,000 metres.

TENSILE (J Riddell) – was inclined to shift ground outwards under hard riding in the home straight and over the final stages made contact with **WHOSHOTMYMATE** (D Bradley) and forced that runner over extra ground. After questioning riders, J Riddell was shown footage of his ride and issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d).

Race 5 LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES 1600M

MAY WE ALL (L Allpress) – Slow away.

RHYTHMIC DANCER (R Hannam) - Slow away.

WORD SAVVY (R Goldsbury) – Awkwardly away and then raced ungenerously when being restrained near the lead in the early stages.

ROCK RULZ (S Weatherley) – Raced ungenerously making the bend awkwardly passing the 1,400 metres dictating RHYTHMIC DANCER wider on the course. When questioned in to the run of ROCK RULZ which was not persevered with over the final stages, rider S Weatherley said the gelding travelled comfortably until near the 600 metres, but failed to respond when placed under pressure. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

FOGARTY FEGEN (J Parkes) – Held up passing the 600 metres and then raced in tight quarters, gaining clear running passing the 400 metres.

Race 6 RIDING FOR THE DISABLED BY PRESIDENT RAY STEVENS 1600M

BAD BOY BROWN (S Karnicnik) - Slow away.

J'WALKE (C Price) - Slow away.

MAGIC WONDER (M McNelis) – Three-wide without cover throughout.

HIGH IN DEMAND (C Perrett) – Slow away resulting in rider C Perrett losing the use of an iron for a short distance.

CARNABY (G Walsh) - Tightened at the start and got back.

CUZZIE CHARLIE (S Phelan) – Bumped with J'WALKE early in the home straight. CUZZIE CHARLIE was inclined to shift ground under pressure over the final stages and shifted in, bumping MAGIC WONDER near the finish.

S Fannin the rider of STRAIGHT JACKET was reminded of his obligation with regard to his use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

GLENGOYNE (C Studd) - When questioned into the disappointing run of GLENGOYNE rider C Studd was of the opinion the gelding was not suited to the going which he described as holding near the rail.

Race 7 CARPET MAINTENANCE & CLEANING 1350M

PRETTY RECKLESS (M Tanaka) and **SEA STAR** (L Allpress) -Tightened at the start and got back due to movement from runners either side.

PRETTY RECKLESS (M Tanaka) – After the start the filly commenced to over-race and near the 800 metre bend was checked when WOTAMISSION failed to make the corner correctly and lay in dictating TAKE THE TRICK inwards into

the line of PRETTY RECKLESS which was checked. Also hampered was BEAU JEU.

LITTLE MAJELLA (D Bradley) - Slow away.

TINY TOT (M Singh) - Shifted in abruptly at the start hampering THATS AMORE.

KINI MARIE (D Hirini) - Had to be steadied abruptly near the 700m when improving rapidly on to the heels of KEEP IT SAVVY which simultaneously shifted ground outward.

SARDEEN (A Collett) – Faded in the home straight. When questioned rider A Collett could provide no excuse and a subsequent veterinary inspection showed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer A Fieldes advised the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing and would now go for a spell.

BEAU JEU (J Parkes) – Lugged out in the home straight and could not be ridden to advantage. J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding would be suited to the addition of blinkers.

Race 8 WESTMERE BULK SPREADING LTD 1200M

D Turner was stood down by paramedics and was unable to fulfill his engagement on **THISTIGERDIDIT** after becoming dehydrated following his ride in Race 2 and was replaced by D Bradley.

SAPPHIRE SKY (A Collett) - Slow away.

TIGER MOSS (M McNelis) – Raced wide throughout.

KENYA (A Chan) – Was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.

AVASTIN (J Parkes) – Had to be restrained passing the 900 metres when in tight quarters.

ALAMCFERSON (M Tanaka) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.
