RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NZ BLOODSTOCK TWO-YEAR OLD (1000m)
KNEAZLE (S Collett) – Jumped outwards at the start making contact with COURTE ZARINDI , lay inwards and raced greenly when under pressure near the 350 metres. COURTE ZARINDI (K Kalychurun) – Hampered at the start and got back. AJAY TEE (K Mudhoo) – Lay outwards near the 450 metres when placed under pressure.	
Race 2	SINGAPORE RACING PACKAGES WITH MONDO TRAVEL RATING 65 (1000m)
FADE TO GREY (A Morgan) – Began awkwardly, lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages. KILLA QUESTION (P Shaikh) – Slow to begin, brushed the running rail near the 400 metres. FUN FAIR – When questioned regarding performance, rider S Wynne advised that the mare had been out paced early.	
Race 3	GAVELHOUSE.COM THREE-YEAR-OLD (1200m)
SECRET BELLE (S Collett) – Shifted out abruptly on jumping hampering ZAH CAPTAIN , raced wide throughout.	

ZAH CAPTAIN (A Collett) – Hampered at the start losing ground.	
NAKYAMA (T Jonker) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.	
ZAWHIP (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early and middle stages.	
PROMISING (T Moseley) – Steadied momentarily passing the 550 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.	
Race 4	DAPHNE BANNAN MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1200m)
The start was delayed when the bridle on SCOOBY required attention.	
SCOOBY (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, raced keenly in the early stages.	
SACRED DESIRE (A Collett) – Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.	
Race 5	CANTERBURY EQUINE CLINIC RATING 75 (2000m)
ODI ET AMO (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly and bumped with LORD BENTLEY .	
LORD BENTLEY (S Collett) – Bumped at the start, raced wide at the 900 metres, steadied passing the 350 metres when EVA JENSINE (R Firdhaus) shifted ground outwards. Apprentice rider R Firdhaus was advised to exercise greater care in future when shifting ground.	
EVA JENSINE (R Firdhaus) – Lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.	
Race 6	REMEMBERING ‘PV’ RATING 75 (1400m)
TOETWOTOE (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin, raced wide in the early stages.	
ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (S Collett) – Shifted outwards and bumped with BISOU BISOU near the 350 metres and straightened at the 70 metres.	
BISOU BISOU (A Collett) – Shifted inwards over the concluding stages and bumped with ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE . Rider A Collett viewed Stewards’ footage of the final stages before electing not to proceed with a protest.	
Race 7	NAUTICAL INSURANCE MAIDEN (1600m)
HOU LA LA (C Barnes) – Hampered at the start and settled back.	
ROYAL MISTRESS (A Collett) – Shifted out abruptly on jumping hampering HOU LA LA , raced keenly for a short distance in the early stages.	
Race 8	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE RATING 65 (1600m)
CHIC (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, held up for a distance passing the 700 metres.	
DREAM DIVINE (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly, raced wide from the 900 metres.	
HANS MAYAR (J Lowry) – Raced wide in the early stages.	
O’KIWI (C Johnson) – Over raced in the middle stages.	
PASSAMAQUODDY (S Collett) – Lay inwards under pressure at the 200 metres having to be straightened.
