RACE COMMENTS:

MR DAVINCI (G Walsh) – Slow to begin then raced greenly throughout.

CHOCOLATE FISH (D Jensen) – Began awkwardly.

MARE FROM WEBER (E Goodinson) – Broke down in near foreleg approaching the 600 metres and was humanely euthanized by veterinary staff.

MASTER COURTSMAN (S Karnicnik) – Briefly inconvenienced by MARE FROM WEBER passing 600 metres.

CULLISTER (H Andrew) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

ANGELICA ROX – Stewards questioned rider S McKay into the disappointing performance of **ANGELICA ROX** S McKay was of the opinion the mare did not appreciate the existing track conditions. A subsequent veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

BANG (M Singh) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Race 3 RETURN 2 EARTH HWT 1600M

EDDIE GILBERT (N Quinn) – Awkwardly away. Had to be steadied passing the 800 metres, held up for some distance nearing the 400 metres prior to being angled wide in the home straight to improve. When questioned into the run N Quinn advised that after missing the start he had got further back than intended and was unable to improve when required rounding the home turn. N Quinn added the gelding may not have appreciated the addition of a tongue tie.

MY ISABELLA (T Harris) – Slow away. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres. When questioned rider T Harris advised the mare had not appreciated todays track conditions. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

LANDLORD (I Lupton) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

Race 4 STELLA ARTOIS MDN 1600M

HEZA DUKE (Z Nor Azman) – Slow away.

LECTIO DIVINIA (R Goldsbury) – Slow away. Lay inwards in the home straight under pressure having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

OLD COUNTESS (T Miles) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

PRETTY RECKLESS (S McKay) – Raced three wide on the pace throughout.

DUNGDADUNG – When questioned rider D Hirini stated that the gelding did not appreciate today's track conditions. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.

ALL IN GLAMOUR (E Farr) – Held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres.

MASTER PATRICK (H Andrew) – Held up for some distance approaching the 600 metres, then had to be angled outwards around a tiring runner passing the 500 metres.

Race 5 PLATINUM HOMES MDN 1100M

HI YO MISS CHOUX (D Hirini) – Began awkwardly bumping KEEP DANCING settling back. Raced keenly in the early stages.

KEEP DANCING (H Andrew) – Bumped at start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

PARISIENNE LASS (J Nason) – Awkward at start.

RUBY LOVE (S McKay) – Bumped at the start.

KOKO BELLE (R Goldsbury) – Held up for some distance approaching the 400 metres.

MAUNA KEA (A Chan) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 6 NZ BLOODSTOCK PEARL SERIES 1200 M

MISS BUMBLEBEE (J Nason) – Jumped outwards abruptly at the start bumping ROYAL EMPRESS which settled back.

ARRIVISTE (R Goldsbury) – Awkwardly away.

ROYAL EMPRESS (A Chan) – Bumped at start settling back. Ran in under pressure in the home straight briefly inconveniencing ANDARTA passing the 100 metres. Rider Chan was shown footage of his ride in the presence of the Riding Master N Harris and advised to exercise greater care.

ANDARTA (S Weatherley) – briefly inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

Race 7 POWERWORX OPUNAKE CUP JULY 22nd 1400M

CHONNEY (K Cowan) – Jumped inwards at the start bumping YOU'LL DO ME which was dictated on to EN SUITE which was tightened.

EN SUITE (S MacNab) – Tightened at the start.

YOU'LL DO ME (A Chan) – Bumped and dictated inwards at the start. When questioned into the performance rider A Chan advised that the gelding did not appreciate today's heavy 10 track conditions.
