<p>FLORENCE IVY (H Moki) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>RAY'S LEGACY (T Wenn) – Steadied when in restricted room soon after leaving the barrier.</p> <p>LUCKY BOY (V Gatu) – Raced wide without cover. Inconvenienced when weakening passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>SPRING SHOW (M Hills) – Inconvenienced passing the 500 metres by WAGNER (A Collett) which shifted out to obtain clear running.</p> <p>WAGNER (A Collett) Shifted out to obtain clear running 500 metres.</p>

<p>BUFFALO BUCK (C Lammas) – Slow away.</p> <p>MOONDANCER (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>RAPOSA RAPIDA (D Johnson) – Was slow away then had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels shortly after.</p> <p>ELECTRODE (M Cameron) – Commenced to over race when being steadied passing the 700 metres.</p> <p>BARBELLO (D Hain) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p>	

SHEZALLPOWER (S Spratt) – Over reacted when making contact with SHOWTENAIRE (T Thornton) when in restricted room having to be firmly restrained losing ground.

<p>MISHKA (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>OUR MCKAY (D Johnson) – Slow to begin. When questioned into the filly's performance D Johnson advised that after being slow away settled further back than intended and was unsuited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>TUREAUD (D Danis) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>ROYAL TOUCH (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly then was crowded by BEWITCHED (A Jones) despite the efforts of its rider.</p> <p>COLORADO BAY (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded.</p> <p>MAKAKAHO JUNCTION (A Schwerin) – Was steadied passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of BELLA TESTA which shifted in. MAKAKAHO JUNCTION again had to be briefly steadied near the 900 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of ARRIVISTE which shifted in. Riders S Spratt and S Collett were advised to exercise care.</p> <p>BELLA TESTA (S Collett) – Shifted ground 1000 metres.</p> <p>ARRIVISTE (S Spratt) – Shifted ground 900 metres.</p> <p>MISHKA (M McNab) – Had to be firmly restrained when crowded to the inside of LIKE A LIE (S Weatherley) which lay in passing the 400 metres. MISHKA was not persevered with for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>BEWITCHED (A Jones) – Trainer P Brosnan was questioned into the improved performance of the filly and advised that it was better suited to the slow track conditions.</p>

<p>CARIBINA (A Jones) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SOUL SURVIVOR (V Gatu) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SHEZALLRAAJ (M Hills) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>QUAINTRELLE (E Farr) – Commenced to lay out when being steadied in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels and being further restrained passing the 1200 metres losing ground.</p> <p>GATA (M Cameron) – Raced in restricted room passing the 300 metres.</p>	
Race 5	LEGG BROTHERS 1400
<p>KAIDA (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.</p> <p>BIG BEN (R Jones) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>BLUE TWILIGHT (A Collett) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>PATIENCE PREVAILS (R Norvall) – Began awkwardly.</p>	

ZABEELIOUS (S McKay) – Commenced to race ungenerously in the early stages when restrained off heels and continued to do so through the middle stages.

BIG BEN (R Jones) – Had to be firmly restrained when crowded to the inside of BLUE TWILIGHT which had shifted in and away from LAEKEEPER (E Farr) which had improved into a run to the inside of KAIDA which when being corrected shifting back inwards. Contributing was slight outward movement from ZABEELIOUS which was over racing.

IL ROSSO (A Collett) – Slow to begin.

BINGIE (D Danis) – Slow to begin. Over raced in the early and middle stages having to steady when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 800 metres.

SULIMAN (S Collett) – Slow to begin.

BROTHER (T Thornton) – Slow to begin. Commenced to race keenly soon after leaving the barriers, becoming awkwardly placed inside heels passing the 1200 meters when over racing, having to be further restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of EXONERATE (E Farr) shifting out making contact with IMA SMART GUY which was also over racing and when being corrected shifted in making firm contact with SACRE COEUR which became briefly unbalanced.

SACRE COEUR (S Spratt) – Bumped 1200 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

IMA SMART GUY (D Johnson) – Over raced for a distance near the 1200 metres.

AMAZED (L Satherley) – Hampered leaving the barriers.

EXONERATE (E Farr) – Made the 800 metre bend awkwardly hanging out and when corrected improved into a run to the inside of TRUMP THAT (J Nason) and then had to be briefly steadied when TRUMP THAT lay in near the 400 metres.

Race 7	PAPER PLUS & TOYWORLD 1580

EARLY RISER (L Satherley) – Underwent a veterinary examination after becoming restless in its barrier and was cleared fit to race.

SOUL SERENADE – Very slow to begin (3L).

SAILING (T Thornton) – was crowded shortly after leaving the barriers losing ground.

ARTERIAL (R Norvall) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BROOKBARS (S Spratt) – Commenced to race keenly in the early stages becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1200 metres with the saddle then shifting forward placing rider S Spratt in difficulty with BROOKBARS then eased out of the race near the 800 metres.

When questioned into the improved performance of **HOYT AXTON** Trainer P Coutts advised that the gelding had been working well leading into today's race but had changed its training programme which may have contributed to the gelding's improved performance.

TAVANOTHER (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

PRIMROSE HILL (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

BATTLE ROYAL (C Lammas) – Became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **YARDARM** (S Spratt) passing the 1600 metre when that runner lay in. As a result **BATTLE ROYAL** had to be heavily restrained losing ground. S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care in a similar circumstance. **BATTLE ROYAL** commenced to lay inwards passing the 800 metres and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.

YARDARM (S Spratt) – Lay in passing the 1600 metres.

WHERE ARE YOU (D Johnson) – Was buffeted for several strides near the 800 metres when in restricted room to the outside of **LA FOI** which was attempting to shift out to obtain clear running and inside of **BATTLE ROYAL** which commenced to lay inwards. Rider A Collett was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

LA FOI (A Collett) – Shifted ground outwards 800 metres.

LADY FERNER (A Schwerin) – Had to steady when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 400 metres.

Race 9 WAIPA HOME OF CHAMPIONS 2000

BEE TEE JUNIOR (M Du Plessis) – Shifted out shortly after leaving the barrier crowding **ON PAROLE**, **DOUBTLESS PRINCESS** and **ULYSSES** which were all hampered losing ground. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages. Held up for distance passing the 700 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening **ULYSSES**.

ON PAROLE (S Spratt) – Crowded shortly after the start and losing ground.

DOUBTLESS PRINCESS (C Lammas) – Crowded shortly after the start and losing ground.

ULYSSES (T Thornton) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and was not preserved with over the final 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.
