Race 2 AJC Members 2100

MR NIK (R Elliot) – Trainer B Foote advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding, further adding that it has now been sent for a spell.

Race 8 West Brook - Great NZ Wines 1600

TARANTINO (M Du Plessis) – Trainer N Tiley advised Stewards that the gelding would be undergoing a dynamic scope examination in the coming days with any abnormality being reported to Stewards. Following this examination TARATINO will be sent for a brief spell.

Waikato Racing Club - 10 June 2017

Race 3 Balance Agri-Nutrients 1400

MAENOHA (A Collett) – Trainer R Priscott advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the filly, adding that it is his intention to make gear changes and continue on with its current preparation.

Race 5 DLF Seeds NZ 2100

SHOCK HORROR (M Cameron) – Trainer A Forsman advised Stewards that the gelding has been sent for a spell.

Race 6 McMillan Equine Feeds 1200

CITY BOY (A Collett) – Trainer R Collett advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

AMASTAR (D Johnson) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards that the filly had taken some time to recovery from its performance in this race. It is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION 3YO

VINSANITY (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly. Lay out making the bend and as a result raced wide without cover.

REILLY CENTRAL (M Cameron) – Over-raced when the pace steadied near the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider M Cameron could offer no tangible excuse. REILLY CENTRAL underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

COTES DE BOURG (A Collett) – Shifted out approaching the winning post.

M Cameron (REILLY CENTRAL) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

Race 2 NEW WORLD WHAKATANE 2YO

SUPER HUNTER (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to race fiercely when being restrained passing the 1000 metres with the saddle shifting forward placing rider M Du Plessis at a disadvantage. SUPER HUNTER then shifted out off heels forcing LA MIA STELLA wide on the track.

DANGERMAN (Z Nor Azman) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

LADYNADEL (C Grylls) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight having to shift ground outwards approaching the 200 metres.

MALAMBO (R Elliot) – Briefly held up passing the 400 metres before shifting out to obtain clear running.

Race 3 NZI/SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS LTD 1200

LA ACHIEVER (M Du Plessis) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Slow to begin.

OUR GIRL MADI (D Johnson) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages. Rider D Johnson advised the filly had never travelled comfortably in the early and middle stages, had failed to respond when placed under pressure and was not persevered with in the final straight. OUR GIRL MADI underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4 GOLDEN GRAIN/H R FISKEN & SONS LTD 2200

OUTSIDER (T Harris) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced passing the 1600 metres when the pace steadied, shifting out forcing HERE TO STAY wider on the track. Held up passing the 500 metres.

ARTERIAL (R Norvall) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced passing the 1600 metres when the pace steadied.

HERE TO STAY (A Collett) - Forced wider near the 1600 metres for a distance.

Race 5 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600

BELLA BLUE (A Collett) – Slow to begin.

SOUL SISTA (M McNab) – Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab could offer no tangible excuse.

GANGSTERS LASS (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

INTO THE MYSTIC (M Du Plessis) – Was held up until passing the 300 metres.

Race 6 KOPE TURF BAR SPRINT

EPROUVEZ (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Commenced to lay out when being steadied in the early stages making the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider S Collett advised that in her opinion the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

TAVIGARDE (E Farr) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start having to be steadied. Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 250 metres.

SLEEPING BEAUTY (C Grylls) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.

Race 7 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1400

KEEPITALL (A Collett) – Very slow to begin.

PAVLICHENKO (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly.

RISING ROSE (T Harris) – Slow to begin.

STOLEN NIGHT (S Collett) – Made contact with MY SMILEY O'REILLY shortly after leaving the barrier, and then commenced to race ungenerously for a distance, again making contact with MY SMILEY O'REILLY near the 1350 metres with both runners becoming unbalanced.

MY SMILEY O'REILLY (A Jones) – Contacted soon after leaving the barriers, and again near the 1350 metres becoming unbalanced.

MONTSERRAT (M Du Plessis) – Lay out approaching the bend near the 900 metres forcing KANE and UNUSUAL ACHIEVER wider.

Race 8 TEAM WEALLEANS 1600

JEALOUS BOY (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly, and then failed to keep in contact with the body of the field throughout the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer M Brosnan was advised that the gelding would be expected to be more competitive at its next start.

RECOLLECT (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

KEEPER GIRL (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.
