## **RACE COMMENTS:**

Race 1 CHELTENHAM WITH T LEE & ARA MAIDEN 1200m

MOUNTAIN MISCHIEF (L Allpress) - Slow away (3L)

MASTER PAT (R Hannam) – Slow away

POPCORN (D Turner) - Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1,000 metres

SOIREE (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly with the rider contacting the gates with his foot.

SAINT CROIX (K Cowan) - Had to be restrained off heels passing the 500 metres

**MAGICELLA (J Parkes)** - Briefly inconvenienced inside the final 500 metres when **POPCORN** (D Turner) rolled in under pressure. Rider D Turner was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

### Race 2 B CONNORS FAMILY CLAN 1200m

**SMOKEN' ACE (H Andrew)** - shifted out abruptly at the start tightening **KERMIT** which was dictated outwards and made firm contact with **SWISS ELLE** which was directed out onto **YOU'LL DO ME**.

**LUMINEER (H Tinsley)** – Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres when **WISEMAN'S FAIRY (M Tanaka)** was dictated inwards by **SEA PRINCESS (L Allpress).** After questioning riders it was established that **SEA PRINCESS** lay in despite the rider's efforts to keep it straight. A subsequent veterinary examination of LUMINEER which finished well back did not reveal any abnormalities.

**WISEMAN'S FAIRY (M Tanaka)** – Dictated inwards, having to be restrained passing the 400 metres. Rider M Tanaka advised the mare, in his opinion had been unsuited to today's heavy track.

**ITSA TRU STORY (M Singh)**— Lay out shortly after the start tightening **NOM DE BOSS** which had to be restrained. Ran about under pressure in the home straight. Bumped passing the 100 metres.

TIGER MOSS (K Cowan) – Raced three-wide when near the pace throughout

YOU'LL DO ME (A Chan) – Lay in passing the 100 metres, bumping ITSA TRU STORY and having to be straightened.

### Race 3 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES F&M 1350m

**DANDEEDEE (D Hirini)**— Was slow away (3L)

A GOODDEAL (D Turner) – Jumped outwards at the start dictating LOCH NESS and MY JOLENE over extra ground. Had to be steadied approaching the home turn when MAROTIRI LASS rolled out.

**SUCH A ONE (H Andrew)** – Race wide without cover throughout. Tightened passing the 200 metres.

**LOCH NESS (J Parkes)** – Tightened briefly passing the 500 metres

Shortly after entering the home straight MY JOLENE (S Collett) and SUCH A ONE (H Andrew) were tightened when AMARONE (N Teeluck) shifted in under hard riding. Rider M Teeluck was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion. Stewards took into account slight outward movement from BALLET CHOUX (J Riddell) when assessing the incident.

FORTUNE KEPT (J Fawcett) - Lay out under pressure over the final stages

**MAROTIRI LASS (A Chan)** – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in a nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a slight cut consistent with having made contact with the gates prior to jumping away..

### Race 4 KEN DUNCAN RACING MAIDEN 1350m

**STEALTH GIANT (L Allpress)** – Was examined by the veterinary surgeon at the start and cleared to run after contacting a rail in the enclosure. Raced keenly throughout.

**SHOWING GRACE (H Andrew)** - Jumped outwards at the start dictating **ARTEMIS RISING** which was awkwardly away, settling back

**GIOVANNETTA (K Cowan)** – Tightened shortly after the start. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**KATE THE GREAT (S Weatherley)** – Was held up approaching the 600 metres having to be angled outwards to gain clear running approaching the 400 metres

TAVIJAZZ (D Turner) - Laid out under pressure in the home straight

Race 5 WICKHAM CLAN HWT 1600m

**ONEFORTHEDITCH (C Kennedy)** – Slow away

**NOM DU BEEL (H McNeill)** – Tightened passing the 1,500 metres then raced keenly throughout having to be restrained off heels passing the 1,200 metres

KENYA (N Quinn) - Rider N Quinn was issued with a warning regarding his usage of his whip prior to the 200 metres

HAMILTONIAN (S Phelan) - Had to be angled wide in the home straight to obtain clear running

Race 6 GUDSELL CLAN MAIDEN HWT 1600m

OUR CHUCKY (S Phelan) – Slow away

HER SON (C Price) - Slow away

PUKEAKE SAM (C Kennedy) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages

**LUCQUIDE (M McNelis)** - Was angled in sharply approaching the 600 metres to avoid the heels of **INFOXICATED (J Riddell)** and in doing so dictated **OUR CHUCKY (S Phelan)** inwards. After speaking with riders no further action was considered necessary.

Race 7 THE WHANGAEHU O'LEARYS MAIDEN 1600m

SHIFUYOU (M Singh) - Awkwardly away

AIKATERINE (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the middle stages

**DUNGDADUNG (S MacNab)** – When questioned into the performance, Rider S MacNab stated the gelding did not appreciate today's heavy track
