RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AB LIME & FORDES COMPLETE LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (1200M)
BY MAGIC (J Lowry) – Bumped with TAIERI GEM as the start was made. Placed in restricted room passing the 950 metres when RIO TENILLE (S Wynne) lay in on the point of bend. S Wynne was advised to make a greater effort in future to ensure she gives runners to her inside sufficient room. When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider J Lowry could offer no tangible explanation.	
TAIERI GEM (C Barnes) – Bumped with BY MAGIC as the start was made.	
PROMISING (T Moseley) – Raced four wide through the early stages.	
RIO TENILLE (S Wynne) – Raced wide throughout.	
FLY THE FLAG (R Beeharry) – Out paced through the early stages. Trainer S Blair-Edie advised the mare would have one more start over distance before reassessing her racing career.	
Race 2	CP WOOL & SOUTHERNWIDE REAL ESTATE HANDICAP (1200M)
TICKETS ON HER (G Jogoo) – Hampered at the start and lost ground. Momentarily held up rounding the final bend.	

THE BARMAID (C Johnson) – Lay out rounding the bend near the 900 metres and again on the final bend and throughout the run home. Rider C Johnson confirmed that the mare had hung throughout.

DOCTOR EDEN (A Sharpe) – Began awkwardly and shifted out hampering TICKETS ON HER who lost ground. Over-raced when leading through the middle stages.

Race 3 | **TRAVELLERS REST TAVERN & TRANSPORT SERVICES MAIDEN (1600M)**

THE YOUNG PRETENDA (G Jogoo) – Raced wide in the early stages before being sent forward to lead passing the 1100 metres. Lay out throughout the final straight, shifting wider on the track.

HOLY MACKEREL (L Callaway) – Over-raced through the early stages due to the lack of tempo.

MACPAC (T Moseley) – Lay out passing the 75 metres and had to be straightened.

RAISE THE ALARM (A Sharpe) – Slow to begin and tailed the field throughout.

SPLASH OUT (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Lost its off hind racing plate during the running.

Race 4 | **PGG WRIGHTSON & DT KING TRANSPORT HANDICAP (1600M)**

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early stages.

AMUN RA (L Callaway) – Restrained for a short distance near the 1500 metres when over-racing.

A BEAUTIFUL KNIGHT (R Yatim) – Slow to begin.

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) – When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider J Lowry advised he had not been disappointed with the first up run and believed the gelding would gain natural benefit from today's outing.

INDIANA PEARL (K Kalychurun) – Lay in throughout the final straight having to be straightened near the 50 metres.

SHAKTI (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.

SHE ROCKS (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5 | **MCCONACHIE SHEARING LTD WAIRIO PLATE (1400M)**

IRISH EXCUSE (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the middle stages.

TIMY TYLER (J Lowry) – When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider J Lowry advised the gelding had been flat throughout and was disappointing.

TOMM JONES (T Comignaghi) – Lay in rounding the final bend and throughout the run home and could not be ridden to full advantage.

Race 6 | **SPEIGHT'S & NORTHERN SOUTHLAND LIVESTOCK MAIDEN (2130M)**

PAYMENT PENDING (G Jogoo) – Bumped and forced outwards at the start contacting an outside runner and unbalancing its rider resulting in apprentice G Jogoo becoming unseated. G Jogoo although on the ground was then able to restrain the gelding after 100 metres and retire it from the event. Apprentice Jogoo was examined by the St John Ambulance Paramedics and cleared to fulfill his remaining riding engagements today.

BRILLANTE ROSSO (L Callaway) – Gave ground from the 700 metres with rider L Callaway reporting the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

COATNCOLLAR (A Sharpe) – Began awkwardly then bumped with PAYMENT PENDING shortly after the start. Raced wide from the 1200 metres. Lay in under pressure near the 150 metres momentarily inconveniencing PAPINA.

LIMOUSINE (T Moseley) – Shifted out at the start making firm contact with PAYMENT PENDING.

PAPINA (T Comignaghi) – Raced wide entering the first bend. Momentarily inconvenienced near the 150 metres.

Race 7	NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE HANDICAP (2130M)
<p>DOUBLE TAP (R Firdhaus) – Began very awkwardly. Post-race found to be suffering a tendon injury to the right front leg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing next.</p> <p>CENTAVADA (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>KONA (C Barnes) – Raced wide for the majority of the event and gave ground over the concluding stages finishing well back. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Barnes could offer no tangible explanation other than the gelding had hung outwards from the 1000 metres.</p> <p>WESTEND MADAM (S Muniandy) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly for several strides passing the 1950 metres having to be steadied outwards to avoid heels.</p> <p>HIGH FORTY (C Campbell) – Crowded between runners as the start was made losing some ground.</p> <p>TAI HO (S Wynne) – Raced wide through the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 8	PRESTON RUSSELL LAW WAIRIO CUP (2130M)
<p>KEEP THE COURAGE (R Yatim) – Improved wide from the 1200 metres.</p> <p>FULL COUNT (C Johnson) – Over-raced through the early to middle stages and gave ground from the 500 metres.</p> <p>TANIWHA (T Moseley) – Raced keenly for several strides passing the 900 metres. Held up passing the 500 metres and obliged to attempt to improve wide from the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 9	HOMESTEAD VILLA MOTEL & VET SOUTH HANDICAP (1400M)
<p>TWIZEL GURU (J Lowry) – Rider reported the gelding may have held its breath during the running.</p> <p>QUINTASTICS (S Toolooa) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Stewards questioned apprentice rider S Toolooa in the presence of the NZTR Jockey Mentor regarding his ride on the mare particularly through the middle stages when becoming detached from the main body of the field. He explained that after beginning slowly he had applied some pressure to his mount to maintain contact but he agreed with the steward's view that more urgency was needed particularly between the 800 and 400 metres. Stewards took into account Mr TOOLOOA's relative inexperience and advised him he would be expected to show better judgement in the future.</p> <p>STRIKE UP THE BAND (K Mudhoo) – Got its head up on a number occasions in the back straight when racing keenly and being restrained off heels.</p> <p>WEAPON OF CHOICE (A Bohorun) – Made the crossing by the 1200 metres awkwardly and lost momentum. Held up rounding the final bend until inside the 200 metres. Rider reported the gelding had hung in the early stages.</p> <p>ROSSI THE RIFLE (R Yatim) – Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>POLLY'S SISTER (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin. Held up rounding the final bend only gaining clear racing room inside the 200 metres.</p>	
Race 10	NIND DAIRY & MILNES TRANSPORT HANDICAP (1400M)
<p>ROCK SOLID (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>ROBIN CHARLES (C Johnson) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages and had to be firmly restrained off heels at the 800 metres.</p> <p>SIR JACK REMINGTON (T Moseley) – When questioned regarding the apparent improved performance trainer K Tyler advised he had not been overly disappointed by the gelding's recent efforts at Riverton and today's Slow 9 track conditions had suited.</p> <p>BURWOOD (S Wynne) – Slow to begin. Lay in under pressure throughout the run home and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p>	

BACHATA (A Morgan) – Over-raced in the early stages.
