Race 7 - PAPER PLUS & TOYWORLD 1580
Connections of SAILING advised that the mare had pulled up lame in the left foreleg and has now been spelled.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Tavistock Syndicate Owners 2YO (1000 metres)
<p>LISDOONVARNA (M Cameron) – Jumped away awkwardly before being further hampered when MALAMBO shifted outwards with LISDOONVARNA losing ground.</p> <p>WALKIN' BY (V Colgan) – Slow away.</p> <p>SOPHIE'S CHOICE (D Johnson) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>SO GLORIOUS (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider O Bosson advised that the colt had been somewhat reluctant to hit out when amongst other runners. SO GLORIOUS underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 2	Fell Engineering (1200 metres)
<p>ALL TRUMPED UP (S Collett) – Slow away. Hampered 700 metres.</p> <p>SLICER (L Innes) – Slow away.</p> <p>TEEGEEVEE (O Bosson) – Hampered when leaving the barriers.</p> <p>ELUSIVE TREASURE (T Thornton) – Shifted inwards shortly after the start making contact with NIPABRANDY which was unbalanced and steadied. Rider T Thornton was advised by Stewards that she must exercise greater care when shifting ground. Forced wide 700 metres.</p> <p>NIPABRANDY (S Spratt) – Steadied when bumped shortly after the start. Crowded and steadied passing 350 metres.</p> <p>COOL BELT (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres to the inside of ELUSIVE TREASURE. COOL BELT became awkwardly placed on the heels of SMART BRONSON (T Harris) which steadied the pace near the 700 metres with COOL BELT then being hampered and shifting out forcing ELUSIVE TREASURE into the line of I SEE RED which was forced wider on the track. FORTALEZA which was following COOL BELT was also hampered. Also steadied as a result were VIKTOR VEGAS, NO WAHALLA, ALL TRUMPED UP and POPPY STAR. Rider T Harris was severely reprimanded and advised that he must not ease the pace to a degree where riders are placed in difficulty.</p> <p>I SEE RED (D Johnson) – Forced wider on the track 700 metres. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>FORTALEZA (C Grylls) – Hampered 700 metres. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 450 metres.</p> <p>VIKTOR VEGAS (M Cameron) – Hampered 700 metres. Shifted out when placed under pressure passing the 350 metres crowding NIPABRANDY which was steadied. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p>NO WAHALLA (S Weatherley) – Hampered 700 metres.</p> <p>POPPY STAR (J Nason) – Hampered and lost ground 700 metres.</p>	
Race 3	Northland Toyota (1400 metres)
<p>TYNE STRIDER (D Danis) – A towel was observed to fall from TYNE STRIDER near the 450 metres. An investigation found the towel to have been used to wipe sweat from the gelding's neck in the barriers with Apprentice D Danis advising that he had attempted to discard the towel prior to the start being effected and was been unaware that it had been caught up in his riding gear. Apprentice D Danis was reprimanded and reminded of his responsibilities.</p> <p>TAHIKI PRIDE (T Wenn) – Had to steady passing the 1000 metres when crowded to the inside of TYNE STRIDER (D Danis) which shifted in when not fully clear. Rider D Danis was reprimanded by Stewards and further advised he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.</p>	

REDCAYENNE (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 4 | **Lion Red (2100 metres)**

E Farr – Fined \$300 by the Judicial Committee after failing to make the contracted weight for LE MOUSSIER. E Farr was replaced by J Nason.

HILARIOUS (S Collet) – Trainers **S & E Clotworthy** were fined \$50 for failing to declare a rider for HILARIOUS by the required time. The training partnership of **S & E Clotworthy** was issued with a warning after presenting HILARIOUS to race in gear which had not been notified (blinkers).

VOLTS (S Weatherley) – Removed from the barriers after being fractious to undergo a veterinary inspection, being passed fit to run.

LONGFORD (T Harris) – Slow away.

LE MOUSSIER (J Nason) – Hung outwards throughout.

NARVICK (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover.

RAAJ (S McKay) – Commenced to race ungenerously near the 1700 metres when being steadied.

VOLTS (S Weatherley) – Crowded passing the 450 metres to the outside of LE MOUSSIER which had lay away from the fence when weakening.

FASTNET FIRE (M Du Plessis) – Held up rounding the final turn and then again passing the 350 metres.

Race 5 | **Waipu Hotel (1400 metres)**

AMOUR LA VIE (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

KOOL CONNECTION (V Colgan) – Slow away. Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when awkwardly placed behind AMOUR LA VIE which shifted ground under pressure and then raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

DALE (A Collett) – Slow to begin when jumping away awkwardly. Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

CHOU CHOU (S Collett) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied passing the 1100 metres.

DAL QUATTRO (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

MINECRAFT (D Prastiyou) – Had to steady away from the heels of EL FORTUNA (D Johnson) which shifted in passing the 900 metres when not fully clear. Rider D Johnson was reprimanded by Stewards.

Race 6 | **Steinlager (1600 metres)**

PARK LANE (J Fawcett) – Underwent a veterinary examination after arriving at the barrier and was cleared fit to start.

KILOWATT (S Weatherley) – Trainer **J McKay** was fined \$50 for failing to declare a rider for KILOWATT by the required time.

CORPORATE RAIDER (G Cooksley) – Slow away.

YOUVEBEENLITUP (M Cameron) – Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider M Cameron advised that the gelding had never travelled comfortably throughout the run. YOUVEBEENLITUP underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 7	Book Your Christmas in July (1200 metres)
<p>ROSA STELLA (V Colgan) – Badly hampered leaving the barriers losing ground. Commenced to race ungenerously in the early stages and made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance. Continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages and again being hampered near the 800 metres and 600 metres when becoming awkwardly placed.</p> <p>ROCETTE LADY (S Collett) – Badly hampered leaving the barriers losing ground. Commenced to over-race in the early stages and then was crowded to the inside of CHECKOUT which had lay in and away from BELLE FASCINO approaching the 1000 metres. As a result ROCETTE LADY was steadied losing ground.</p> <p>SHOW A LEG (A Collett) – Trainer Ms N Tanner was fined \$50 after presenting SHOW A LEG with an incorrect saddle cloth number. Very slow to begin (5L). Trainer Ms N Tanner was advised that a warning would be placed against the mare.</p> <p>ALERIA (L Innes) – Restrained passing the 900 metres and shifted in to obtain cover.</p> <p>LUCKY DREAMER (S McKay) – Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>SENSIBILITY (T Thornton) – The training partnership of K & L Rae & K Williams was fined \$50 after presenting SENSIBILITY to race with incorrect gear. Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>MIACOCA (S Spratt) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.</p>	
Race 8	Cowley's Hire Centre (1200 metres)
<p>BATTLEFIELD (E Farr) – Slow away.</p> <p>SCHIAPARELLI (D Johnson) – Slow away.</p> <p>HOVER (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>ROSE IMPERIAL (V Colgan) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained after becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres.</p> <p>CLASSIC WARRIOR (M Du Plessis) – Commenced to over-race when being restrained approaching the 900 metres and then raced in restricted room to the inside of TESIA which had difficulty making the bend when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of SIMPLY CLASSIC (A Jones) which shifted in slightly. Rider A Jones was advised she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>TESIA (A Collett) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained passing the 900 metres and then raced in restricted room being further steadied. TESIA then continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.</p> <p>TWENTYSIXTWELVE (O Bosson) – Raced wide in the early stages before being restrained to obtain cover.</p> <p>BELLE AMORE (S Weatherley) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>ST REGIS (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p>HOWBOWDAT (S Collett) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight.</p>	
Race 9	Adams Trimmer Insurance (1200 metres)
<p>SHERADREAM (T Wenn) – Began awkwardly making contact with PLAYBOY PRINCE with SHERADREAM losing ground.</p> <p>PLAYBOY PRINCE (BR Jones) – Unbalanced when contacted leaving the barrier.</p>	

A Schwerin - Apprentice Rider A Schwerin admitted a breach of careless riding in that she permitted her mount MAGIC OF THE SUN to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of HONOUR PRINCESS which was forced inwards crowding SPIDER on to CREATIVE GENIUS which was checked near the 1000 metres, with the Judicial Committee suspending her license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 20 May 2017 up to and including racing on 31 May 2017, 5 riding days.

MAGIC OF THE SUN (A Schwerin) - Shifted out when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres making brief contact with SPIDER with MAGIC OF THE SUN then shifting out when struck with the whip approaching the 200 metres, again making contact with SPIDER for a distance. Apprentice A Schwerin was advised to exercise greater care.

HONOUR PRINCESS (G Saejorhor) – Crowded and checked 1000 metres. Apprentice Rider G Saejorhor was questioned as to why he had not attempted to shift his mount inwards to obtain a position closer to the leader near the 900 metres and had remained in a three wide position for the remainder of the bend. G Saejorhor advised that he heard jockeys to his inside calling and he did not think he was sufficiently clear to shift in but after viewing footage agreed with Stewards that he had erred in his actions and would be expected to show better judgment.

SPIDER (T Thornton) – Crowded and hampered 1000 metres. Contacted approaching the 200 metres and briefly unbalanced.

CREATIVE GENIUS (A Collett) – Crowded and badly checked 1000 metres losing ground. CREATIVE GENIUS then raced ungenerously making the 900 metre bend awkwardly.

WOLFF SPIRIT (C Lammas) – Had to steady approaching the 900 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of KILMAC (D Prastiyou) which shifted in when not fully clear. Rider D Prastiyou was advised to exercise greater care.

ALL TORN UP (D Johnson) – Held up early in the final straight and was unable to obtain clear running until inside the final 100 metres.
