KINGS DEEP (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence on the second round.

WILBUR (C Kennedy) – Made a poor jump at the second to last fence.

Race 2 PASLODE NEW ZEALAND MAIDEN HURDLE (3000 metres)

THATZ LOUIE (M Cropp) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages then over-raced. Pulled up at the end of the back straight when out of contention.

IT'S A WONDER (W Gordon) – Jumped high at the first two fences. Hit the fence approaching the 1000 metres.

PERRY MASON (A Kuru) – Jumped the fence passing the 800 metres awkwardly.

BROK BAK (C Price) – Hit the second last fence hard.

Race 3 MANAWATU ITM AWAPUNI HURDLES (3000 metres)

SHAMAL (C Price) – Hit the fence near the 600 metres and blundered badly dislodging rider C Price who was attended to by paramedics and cleared to ride.

THATZ DAVID (G Walsh) – Jumped the second fence high. Had to be angled out to gain clear running inside the final 400 metres.

MAX (I Lupton) – Hit the last fence.

JUSTA CHARLIE (W Gordon) – Lost the off front plate during the running.

Race 4 RED STAG TIMBER HANDICAP (1200 metres)

DANNY BOY (M Singh) – Saddled slipped early in the race, placing the rider at a significant disadvantage so was not persevered with in the home straight.

Race 5 NELSON PINE INDUSTRIES HANDICAP (2100 metres)

D Turner (OUR GAZZA) was unable to make the contracted weight (56kg) and was replaced by J Parkes. D Turner admitted a breach of Rule 330(3)(c) and was fined the sum of \$300.

OUR GAZZA (J Parkes) - Awkwardly away. Unsuited to slow pace early so taken forward near 1000 metres

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) – Slow away.

STORMY HABIT (R Goldsbury) – Three wide without cover in the early stages, then allowed to roll forward to lead passing the 1500 metres. Following the race the gelding incurred an injury in the tie-up stalls requiring veterinary attention.

DR WATSON (R Hannam) – Raced keenly in the middle stages when the pace ahead eased.

R Hannam (DR WATSON) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively prior to the 200 metres so was suspended from the conclusion of racing today, 17 June 2017, up to and including Saturday, 24 June 2017 (2 days).

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) – Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 6 LJ HOOKER MANAWATU STEEPLECHASE (4000 metres)

KINGS KITE (W Gordon) – Rider lost the use of both irons after a poor jump at the second fence so was pulled up rounding the first turn.

NELLS BELLE (E Goodinson) – Hit the eighth fence, dislodging rider E Goodinson who was attended to by paramedics

and taken to hospital for observation with a hip injury.

JOKING (S Phelan) – Blundered at the third last fence causing the rider to lose the use of his near side iron for a short distance.

THE BIG OPAL (S Fannin) - Shifted sideways at the start losing ground. Fell at the second of the double on the second occasion. Rider S Fannin was uninjured.

WISE MEN SAY (I Lupton) – Jumped the second last fence awkwardly.

THE OYSTERMAN (H McNeill) – Rider lost whip prior to the 200 metres.

The remainder of the field were directed around the third last fence and not required to jump it, due to the injured rider, E Goodinson being attended to by paramedics.

Race 7 IPL PLYWOOD HANDICAP (1500 metres)

J'WALKE (K Cowan) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay out under pressure in the home straight.

JOBY (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

DUFFERS CREEK (S MacNab) – Raced in tight quarters passing the 600 metres having to be briefly steadied. Held up early in the home straight having to be angled inwards to gain clear running approaching the 200 metres.

OUR BANDIT (L Allpress) – Had to be angled inwards to obtain clear running approaching the 100 metres.

Race 8 WINSTONE WALLBOARDS HANDICAP (1600 metres)

JUST YOU (M Tanaka) – Slow away. Lay in across the heels of ACUTELY GOLD and had to be steadied passing the 400 metres. Raced greenly in the home straight under pressure.

SWISS ANGEL (A Chan) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Had to be angled inwards to gain clear running inside the 400 metres.

DAL SIR TEE (T Johnson) – Awkwardly away bumping OUR DAISY then settling back.

OUR DAISY (C-M Waddell) – Checked approaching the home turn when racing to the outside of VERACIOUS (R Goldsbury), which shifted out and to the inside of LOVETOKEEPHIM (H Andrew) and ACUTELY GOLD (R Hannam). After questioning riders and viewing the video footage available, Stewards could not attribute blame to any one rider when assessing the interference.

LOVETOKEEPHIM (H Andrew) bumped with SWISS ANGEL (A Chan) when attempting to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

DE GAULLE (L Allpress) – Had to be angled outwards early in the home straight to gain clear running approaching the 300 metres.
