RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 SPORTS CENTRAL BREW HOUSE 1400M

JOHNNY JONES (C Johnson) - Got its head up when being steadied passing the 950 metres and racing keenly for a short distance. When spoken to regarding the performance of favoured runner **JOHNNY JONES** the rider reported that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions and that combined with the top weight had led to a disappointing performance. Stewards requested a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Race 2 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES 1200M

FUN FAIR (P Shaikh) - Was slow to begin. Momentarily raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres when **PROMISING** (H Bennett) lay in momentarily.

SUGGESTIVE LOOX (R Firdhaus) - Was slow to begin. Out-paced in middle stages despite efforts of rider.

POPP 'N LINDAUER (S Wahab) - Had to steady momentarily passing the 1100 metres when **FADE TO GREY** (A Morgan) who was improving forward shifted in. A Morgan was advised to exercise greater care.

CHECKOUTTHEMISSES (K Kalychurun) - Wide throughout.

OUR MADONNA (R Beeharry) - Crowded and had to steady passing the 1000 metres when **FADE TO GREY** (A Morgan) who was improving forward continued to shift inwards. A Morgan was warned under Rule 638(1)(d) careless riding. Saddle shifted forward passing the 800 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event.

FADE TO GREY (A Morgan) - Hung outwards rounding the home bend.

PROMISING (H Bennett) - Raced wide throughout and lay inwards in the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

Race 3 OAMARU LIQUORLAND 2200M

PAYMENT PENDING (K Kwo) - Raced wide throughout.

SHEEZOFF (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

FLY THE FLAG (C Johnson) - Raced keenly for a short distance when being steadied passing the 2100 metres.

HOLY MACKEREL (L Callaway) - Made the first bend awkwardly.

HOU LA LA (R Bishop) - Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1400 metres.

KERRYTOWN PRINCESS (D Hirini) – Raced wide throughout.

SATIN FLAG (C Barnes) - Rider C Barnes could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Race 4 EASY MADE MARMALADE 2200M

CLEM (R Bishop) – Began awkwardly making firm contact with **DARCI INN** (G Jogoo).

ODI ET AMO (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 1000 metres when improving forward.

WHO DARE WINS (A Collett) - Wide throughout. Rider reported that being trapped wide throughout had been detrimental to the favoured runner today.

SKEEN (C Johnson) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. Rider reported the gelding had raced keenly through the middle stages and this had led to today's disappointing performance.

PRECIOUS PERCY (K Kalychurun) - Raced wide throughout.

MORGAN BET (K Kwo) - Raced keenly through the middle stages and had to be steadied momentarily when crowded for room passing the 1200 metres.

DARCI INN (G Jogoo) - When spoken to regarding the performance the rider reported that the gelding had hung through the middle stages but other than that could offer no tangible excuses.

Race 5 DR KANO'S FANTASTIC FLIGHT 1200M

WILKIE GEORGE (H Andrew) - Slow to begin. Then raced wide for the majority of the event.

DRAPPIER (A Collett) - Began awkwardly. Had to be steadied off the heels of **SEVEN DIALS** passing the 800 metres when racing keenly for a short distance.

CRISPIN (C Campbell) - Crowded shortly after the start and had to be restrained when **GOLDEN TUI** (P Shaikh) who was laying in shifted in. P Shaikh was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

DAMANAKA (R Firdhaus) – Wide throughout.

VAPO (C Johnson) - Keen through the early to middle stages.

Race 6

NORTHSTAR HOTEL AND RESTAURANT 1600M

PAINTED ANGEL (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

JANE AVRIL (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

MAKS LEGEND (A Collett) – Wide early. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

LITTLE BOSSING (L Callaway) - Wide throughout.

Race 7

UNDER AND OUT DRILLING 1600M

LONE SURVIVOR (D Hirini) – Was slow to begin.

STANDREWS MASONIC (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

TENFOLD (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly through the early to middle stages.

ROYAL MISTRESS (A Collett) – Held up rounding the final bend and until early in the run home.

GREY GHOST (S Wahab) – Rider issued a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) excessive use of the whip.

Race 8

OAMARU SCAFFOLDING 1600M

BACHATA (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly and got its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

DREAM DEVINE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Held up early in the run home and had to shift ground outwards to find clear racing room.

KARAYAH (H Andrew) - Skied its head on a number of occasions when racing keenly through the early to middle stages and raced wide throughout.

IVANSKAVINSKYSKVA (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide throughout.

BULLITT (S Toolooa) - When spoken to regarding the performance the rider reported that the gelding had a nice trip throughout but only had battled over the concluding stages but added in his opinion BULLITT would take natural benefit from its first up run in a month.

WEAPON OF CHOICE (K Kwo) - Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room passing the 250 metres.
