WINKLE DANCER (T Harris) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance, rider T Harris advised that racing wide had not helped the gelding's chances.

DRAGON RIO (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse.

GREYWACKE (M McNab) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after being eased down over the final 200 metres which found the gelding to have dirt down the trachea in significant quantities.
