RACE COMMENTS:

CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES BOOK NOW 1200 Race 1

MISS CATHERINE (A Collett) – Began awkwardly.

KAMIKAZE REBEL (C Lammas) - Briefly contacted passing the 50 metres by IMBLAZE which shifted out under pressure.

IMBLAZE (V Gatu) – Shifted out under pressure making brief contact near the 50 metres.

WINKLE DANCER (T Harris) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance, rider T Harris advised that racing wide had not helped the gelding's chances.

DRAGON RIO (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could offer no tangible excuse.

GREYWACKE (M McNab) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after being eased down over the final 200 metres which found the gelding to have dirt down the trachea in significant quantities.

Race 2 CAPITAL TRACTORS TAURANGA 1600

ADRIATIC PEARL (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DUBAI SHUFFLE (M McNab) – Raced in restricted room leaving the barrier.

ARZAK (D Johnson) – Shifted out making brief contact over the concluding stages.

Race 3 THE FROCKED UP GIRLS 3YO

FULLY CHARGED (T Abel) – Began awkwardly.

ICHIBAN (R Elliot) – Got its head up for a distance when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.

Race 4 GPS-IT PRECISION LAND MAPPING 1200

KENSINGTON (M McNab) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

PERSUASIVE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

MANHATTAN STREET (K McCulloch) – Steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of MR LUIGI which shifted out slightly near the 400 metres.

MR LUIGI (A Collett) – When questioned rider A Collett could offer no tangible excuse, with the gelding undergoing a post-race veterinary examination which could not find any obvious abnormality.

Race 5 ZEST 2100

MOTUMAN (J Nason) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Apprentice rider J Nason was of the opinion that MOTUMAN was feeling the effects of recent racing.

CATARINA (M Du Plessis) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 2000 metres.

Race 6 ORORA KIWI PACKAGING KIWIFRUIT CUP

GENTIL TONTON (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

PUMP UP THE VOLUME (A Collett) – Began awkwardly making contact with LETMEBY.

LETMEBY (A Jones) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

KATIE MCKEEN (A Chan) – Apprentice rider A Chan could offer no tangible excuse for mare's performance. KATIE MCKEEN underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

D Johnson was examined by the Club's doctor following the race rider and stood down from her remaining rides as she was unwell.

Race 7 AONGATETE COOLSTORES LIMITED 1400

EMBRACEABLE YOU (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

MIGHTY ME (S Spratt) – Slow to begin.

BRANSOME (E Farr) – Slow to begin. Apprentice rider **E Farr** admitted a breach in that she used the whip excessively prior to the 200 metres with the Judicial Committee suspending her license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 1 July up to and including racing on 6 July, 2 riding days.

MASTER PLATINUM (K McCulloch) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

Race 8 SEEKA TAURANGA CLASSIC

DANIELA ROSA (T Harris) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DAINTY ROSE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly.

NOMISMA (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

GALAXY MISS (S Weatherley) – Bumped and unbalanced 250 metres when UNDERTHEMOONLIGHT shifted in under pressure.

Race 9 ICON SECURITY SYSTEMS 1400

CRITICS CHOICE (A Schwerin) – Began awkwardly, then was crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

THE SECRET'S OUT (B R Jones) – Crowded shortly after the start when runners on either side shifted ground.

ROAD TRIP (C Lammas) – Steadied off heels when awkwardly placed passing the 1000 metres.
