RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	COMMODORE HOTEL & TAGGART EARTHMOVING RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>SAVASON (P Shaikh) – Bounded as the start was effected and lost ground, awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 200 metres having to steady.</p> <p>MYSTIFY ME (D Hirini) – Raced wide throughout. Apprentice rider D Hirini reported that the mare had failed to handle the testing nature of today's track.</p> <p>MINUTES TO MIDNITE (T Jonker) – Unbalanced near the 700 metres when contacted from the inside. Lay outwards in the home straight having to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p> <p>BUSHIDO (G Jogoo) – Attempted a marginal run near the 700 metres having to steady. Apprentice G Jogoo was warned under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p>WESLEY HALL (K Gundowry) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.</p> <p>TOETWOTOE – Rider L Hemi advised that the mare failed to handle the testing nature of today's track.</p>	
Race 2	TWS GROUP TWO-YEAR-OLD (1000m)

LETS GO LILY (D Hirini) – Slow to begin, raced greenly in the early stages when well back in the field.	
DREAMING EASY (S Wahab) – Bumped at the start and raced well back thereafter.	
ZAH WANTED (K Kwo) – Bumped at the start.	
KNEAZLE (D Prastiyou) – Awkwardly placed on heels passing the 700 metres	
UPPERHAND (R Bishop) – Raced fiercely when in the lead, lay outwards in the final straight under pressure having to be straightened passing the 50 metres. The connections were advised that a warning was placed against the gelding's racing manners. The connections advised it was their intention to spell UPPERHAND.	
AJAY TEE (G Jogoo) – Shifted in abruptly near the 150 metres and had to be straightened.	
IRISH EXPRESS (C Johnson) – Shifted ground inwards passing the 150 metres.	
Race 3	NORTH CANTERBURY VETERINARY CLINICS MAIDEN (1200m)
OPIO ROSE (P Shaikh) –Proved difficult to load. The connections were advised that the filly would be loaded first in future and that a warning would be placed against its barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early stages.	
BOBTAIL (L Hemi) – Jumped away awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced.	
BOB'STHEJOB (R Firdhaus) – Blundered at the start and slow away, lay out over the concluding stages and had to be straightened. Rider R Firdhaus advised that the gelding had failed to handle the testing nature of today's track.	
LADY BYRON (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly.	
LADY DAVONE (L Callaway) – Began awkwardly.	
ADVENTURINE (S Wahab) – Gave ground from the 600 metres. A post race veterinary inspection revealed the gelding to be lame in the right hind leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance must be produced prior to racing next.	
Race 4	SONIA & GARRY THOMPSON OPEN HANDICAP (1200m)
IRISH EXCUSE (S Wynne) – Bounded at the start losing ground, held up for a short distance on entering the home straight.	
KILLA QUESTION (A Morgan) – Began awkwardly, over raced for a short distance passing the 800 metres.	
FLYING IBIS (C Johnson) – Hampered between runners shortly after the start.	
Race 5	SMITHS HIRE RATING 75 (1400m)
ELFEE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, held up when attempting a marginal run passing the 450 metres until the 300 metres shifting ground outwards across heels.	
PINZANO (K Kalychurun) – Over raced in the early stages.	
RAWMATERIAL (L Hemi) – Came together and brushed with WAYLAY near the 100 metres	
WAYLAY (J Lowry) – Came together and brushed with RAWMATERIAL near the 100 metres.	
Race 6	GREENWOOD AMBERLEY CUP (1600m)
LORD BENTLEY (R Bishop) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and cleared to race. Began awkwardly shifting out and making contact with PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE.	
WHAT'S UP ALF (L Hemi) – Got its head up when being restrained passing the 1400 metres.	

PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE (T Moseley) – Raced wide throughout. Rider T Moseley advised that in his opinion not being able to lead on its own terms proved detrimental. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

MISS THREE STARS (S Wynne) – Lay inwards passing the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

DO UNO WHOIAM (T Jonker) – Lay out throughout the home straight.

Race 7	OPTIMISE FERTILISERS RATING 75 (1800m)

BELLE BOY (K Kwo) – Slow to begin and restrained to the rear, raced wide throughout, lay inwards under pressure near the 300 metres and made contact with GARFUNKEL.

MILK IT (K Kalychurun) – Steadied and shifted away from heels near the 1200 metres, continued to over race for some distance.

GARFUNKEL (D Hirini) – Raced keenly for a short distance and blundered near the 1000 metres.

PERCEPTIVE – Apprentice rider C Campbell reported that the mare had failed to handle the testing nature of today's track. A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

O'KIWI – Rider C Johnson reported that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's Heavy (11) track conditions.

REDESDALE (K Kwo) – Reared enroute to the barriers dislodging apprentice rider K Kwo. Neither horse nor rider were injured in this incident.

HE AIN'T HEAVY (L Callaway) – Slow to begin.

MASTER KARSTEN (S Wahab) – Slow to begin.

THE MAN (T Moseley) – Began awkwardly.

SHEZATOUCHA (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly, placed in restricted room momentarily passing the 450 metres.

SQUIZZY (K Kalychurun) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

MOBY (C Johnson) Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1200 metres, Steadied when in restricted room passing the 900 metres,

LONDONDERRY AIR (J Lowry) – Held up for a short distance on entering the home straight, lay outwards throughout the final straight.
