RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PANKHURST SAWMILLING / MARQUEE & PARTY HIRE HANDICAP (1600M)
CIVIC RECEPTION (K Kalychurun) – When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner rider K Kalychurun advised the gelding had travelled well during the running however failed to respond to his urgings when placed under pressure and was disappointing. Mr Kalychurun further added he would be recommending gear changes prior to CIVIC RECEPTION racing next.	
DOCKET (G Jogoo) – Raced keenly in the early stages.	
SHAKTI (S Toolooa) – Slow to begin.	
Race 2	BRENDON SHEARING CONTRACTING / VIBES HAIR DESSIGN MAIDEN (1200M)
ALL BLACK MAGIC (L Callaway) – Bounded at the start losing ground. Raced wide from the 800 metres.	
NAPOLEON DYNAMITE (K Kalychurun) – Raced keenly in the early stages.	
DRUMSTORM (K Kwo) – Raced keenly in the early stages when leading.	
RIO TENNILLE (R Beeharry) - Had to be steadied off heels near the 800metres and again near the 600 metres when racing	

keenly.	
Race 3	J J LTD 27TH GREAT WESTERN HURDLE (2500M)
<p>DELACROIX (H McNeill) – Brought down by a fallen runner at the fence near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>REVENGE (S Higgins) – Raced wide from the 1900 metres before assuming the lead passing the 1200 metres. Put in poor leaps at the last two fences.</p> <p>WIGGLE (S Fannin) – Put in a poor leap at the fence near the 1100 metres. Hampered by fallen runners near the 950 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Fannin reported that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle the Heavy 11 track conditions.</p> <p>ADDITUP (S Phelan) – Put in an awkward leap at the first fence losing some ground.</p> <p>AKAL (S Karnicnik) – Made a poor leap at the fence near the 1000 metres and fell dislodging rider S Karnicnik with the trailing DELACROIX unable to avoid the fallen runner also being brought down and dislodging rider H McNeill. Riders S Karnicnik and H McNeill were both examined by St John Ambulance Paramedics and cleared of any injury. AKAL and DELACROIX were both examined by the on-course veterinarian and cleared of any injury.</p>	
Race 4	COASTAL LANDSCAPING / BARNES WILD BLUFF OYSTERS MAIDEN (2147M)
<p>BEETHOVEN (J Lowry) – Made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track. When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner apprentice rider J Lowry could offer no tangible explanation however added that in his opinion the gelding would benefit from the addition of blinkers.</p> <p>MORRIE MAC (A Bohorun) – Crowded at the start and lost ground. Lay in when struck with the whip passing the 250 metres and had to be straightened.</p> <p>BLACK LIZZIE (A Comignaghi) – Stumbled on jumping away and then when recovering shifted out abruptly crowding MORRIE MAC who lost ground.</p> <p>FLY THE FLAG (R Beeharry) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay in passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 5	DT KINGS TRANSPORT LTD 111TH GREAT WESTERN STEEPLECHASE (3900M)
<p>CRASH BANDICOOT (S Fannin) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>GARGAMEL (S Phelan) – Put in a poor leap at the fence by the 1400 metres unbalancing its rider momentarily.</p> <p>KINA WIN (S Higgins) – Jumped the sod wall high on the first occasion. Put in a poor leap at the fence by the 1400 metres.</p> <p>REGALO REAAL (W Gordon) – Mixed its jumping throughout. Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence at the 650 metres unbalancing its rider who momentarily lost the use of his outside iron. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered a left fore tendon injury with the connections advised a veterinary clearance was required prior to REGALO REAAL racing next.</p>	
Race 6	RIVERTON BUTCHERY / NA & MA EVANS & BALANCE HANDICAP (2147M)
<p>GAZZA THE GURU (T Moseley) – When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner rider T Moseley reported the gelding was unsuited by the testing nature of the Heavy 11 track conditions encountered today.</p> <p>BLUES BREAKER (R Yatim) – Stumbled passing the 650 metres momentarily unbalancing the rider losing ground. Stewards questioned apprentice rider R Yatim in regards to his ride particularly through the early and middle stages when establishing a lengthy break on the field. Apprentice Yatim advised that his instructions had been that as the gelding is one paced he was to be handy and keep his momentum going at a steady tempo and then place the gelding under pressure again at the 600 metres. After beginning well he was surprised at how large a lead he had established early without applying any pressure to BLUES BREAKER. Apprentice Yatim added that he believed the gelding was travelling comfortably however when placed under pressure at the 600 metres as instructed, his mount had stumbled and lost momentum. Apprentice Yatim further added that in his opinion the gelding had kept the same pace to the line when battling on to run fifth. After hearing from both apprentice Yatim and trainer Mr K Tyler the Stewards opened and adjourned an investigation to give the matter further consideration.</p>	

FRANCONI (G Jogoo) – Held up momentarily passing the 150 metres and had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear racing room.

Race 7	STEVEN SHEARING CONTRACTING / RIVERTON PHARMACY MAIDEN (1400M)

LITTLE BOSSING (K Kwo) – Began awkwardly and was forced wider on the track passing the 1200 metres when STRATEGUS shifted out abruptly at this point dictating GUN LAW out on to LITTLE BOSSING. Raced greenly through the early stages and wide throughout. Passing the 300 metres the rider dropped his rein when going for another hold with the gelding shifting in abruptly and hampering CHICA RAPIDA.

BY MAGIC (T Comignaghi) – Inconvenienced passing the 200 metres when tiring.

MIDNITE KAOS (L Callaway) – Slow to begin. Lay in throughout the run home and passing the 200 metres shifted in inconveniencing the tiring BY MAGIC.

STRATEGUS (A Sharpe) – Stumbled and shifted ground outwards abruptly passing the 1200 metres.

CHICA RAPIDA (J Lowry) – Hampered at the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the seemingly improved performance trainer K Tyler advised that the mare had been working well in the lead up and had benefitted from an experienced rider today.

SIR JACK REMINGTON (T Moseley) – Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 1300 metres.

ROCK SOLID (K Kalychurun) – Bounded at the start and was slow to begin.

CAN YOU HEAR ME (S Toolooa) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 1300 metres resulting in SIR JACK REMINGTON clipping a heel and blundering.

WILD JACK (A Bohorun) – When questioned regarding the seemingly improved performance trainer S Blair-Edie advised the gelding was unsuited by the track conditions encountered at its previous start at Ascot Park however had taken natural improvement from that outing.
