RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	VICTOR & FRANK MATIJASEVICH OPEN HURDLE

THENAMESBOND (W Gordon) – Jumped indifferently throughout.

NGATIRA GOLD (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence, then continued to jump indifferently for the remainder.

THE SHACKLER (A Kuru) – Hit the fence near the 1200 metres. Ran down all three fences in the final straight.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (H McNeill) – Put in poor jumps at the fences near the 1200 metres and 1000 metres.

TOP CHOICE (J Seivwright) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered from cardiac arrhythmia. The connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

Race 2 NEW WORLD MORRINSVILLE MAIDEN HURDLE

THE TALISMAN (J Seivwright) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence, then continued to jump indifferently throughout.

NOTABADROOSTER (W Gordon) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence. Hit the last fence.

ROOF OF RECKONING (M Roustoby) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Became awkwardly placed on the heels of GLOBAL WARRIOR after jumping the fence near the 2000 metres having to be steadied. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

SUFFICE TO SAY (H McNeill) – Hit the fence near the 2000 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

NOMBERO (C Studd) – Dipped on landing after jumping the fence near the 2000 metres.

WHO CAN TELL (S Phelan) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

ADEQUACY (S Karnicnik) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.

Race 3 WAIHOU TAVERN MAIDEN HURDLE

NEWSTEAD (S Phelan) – Misjudged the second fence. When questioned regarding performance rider S Phelan advised that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

OCEAN BOUND (W Gordon) – Began awkwardly.

EYESLUCKY (C Studd) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres. Misjudged the last fence dislodging rider C Studd. C Studd was uninjured. EYESLUCKY required veterinary attention post-race after making contact with the outside fence when riderless.

EL CORBY (E Farr) – Hit the fence near the 1100 metres. Shifted out abruptly approaching the final fence making contact with FAST CATCH which was forced wider.

FAST CATCH (R Cole) – Bumped and forced wider approaching the final fence. Hit the last fence and blundered badly on landing losing ground. Lost the left front plate during the running.

TUTENSE (M Roustoby) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1000 metres. Hit the second to last fence. Inconvenienced near the 75 metres when FAST CATCH (R Cole) shifted ground outwards under pressure. Rider **R Cole** was advised to exercise greater care.

RUB IT IN (A Kuru) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be showing signs of tying-up.

A protest was lodged by the connections of the third placed horse TUTENSE into the second placing of FAST CATCH alleging interference inside the final 100 metres. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 4 GLEN ARMSTRONG BUILDERS 1000

MOONDANCER (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Denied clear racing room passing the 350 metres when attempting to improve into a marginal run. MOONDANCER was then steadied and shifted in to obtain clear running.

HUI HAI STARS (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres inconveniencing WAY TOO EASY which shifted away from that runner.

EENY MEENY MINY MO (T Thornton) – Held up passing the 300 metres when attempting to improve into a marginal run to the inside of SLICE 'N DICE which lay in when placed under pressure. SLICE 'N DICE was then corrected by its rider with EENY MEENY MINY MO obtaining clear running approaching the 250 metres.

WAY TOO EASY (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced 150 metres.

Race 5 STEVE LUNJEVICH CONTRACTING 2200

DEFER (L Calitz) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SO TRUE (L Wheeler) – Slow to begin (5L).

WAI NOT (A Shin) – Slow to begin.

DUKEBOX (M Northcott) – Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 400 metres.

Race 6 KARL DAVIS BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 2200

CARDON BOY (T Wenn) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Inconvenienced 150 metres by WINDY HEIGHT which shifted out.

CRUISEO (Z Nor Azman) – Began awkwardly.

WINDY HEIGHT (S Collett) – Inclined to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight. Shifted out abruptly approaching the 150 metres inconveniencing CARDON BOY.

Race 7 FRANK & ANNIE MATIJASEVICH MEMORIAL OPEN STEEPLECHASE

ZED CASE (S Karnicnik) – Landed poorly after jumping the third fence.

JACK ROMANOV (H McNeill) – Became unbalanced after making contact with ZED CASE when jumping the fifth fence.

ISTIMAGIC (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1300 metres.

NELLS BELLE (S Fannin) – Misjudged the second to last fence.

Race 8 MLAADI LAURICH (YOUNG LAURICH'S) 1400

PINKO MOON (T Newman) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. Placed in restricted room when weakening approaching the 150 metres.

DESMOND DEE (D Turner) – Crowded and hampered shortly after the start to the inside of MASTER GENIE which was crowded by PIERIAN SPRING which was racing to the inside of MAGIC CANNON which was forced in by INTREPID LAD (D Prastiyou) which commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained. Also contributing was outward movement by MOET MOLLY. As a result rider **D Prastiyou** was issued with a warning.

MASTER GENIE (A Collett) – Crowded losing ground shortly after the start.

MOET MOLLY (R Elliot) – Crowded and checked passing the 100 metres by PIERIAN SPRING (E Farr) which shifted out when not sufficiently clear. Also hampered as a result was KEEPITALL. Rider **E Farr** admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with the Judicial Committee suspending Miss Farr's license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 6 July up to and including racing on 14 July, 5 riding days.

KEEPITALL (T Thornton) – Hampered passing the 100 metres.

Race 9 DAVE, FRED & MICHAEL LAURICH 1600

M Du Plessis was stood down by the on course Doctor following the running of race 6, due to the there being no suitable senior rider available to replace Mr Du Plessis on BIG 'N' RICH Stewards granted permission for apprentice J Nason to take the mount.

UNVEILING (E Farr) – Slow to begin.

BELLA BLUE (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

BIG 'N' RICH (J Nason) – Began awkwardly making contact with MENDIP for a distance before being crowded and losing ground.

SPAWN OF ELAIA (R Norvall) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barriers.

HEEZA DREIMER (R Elliot) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

WAR STORY (D Turner) – Shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip approaching the 300 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied.
