RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WINGATUI FUNCTION CENTRE 1600m
AMUN RA (L Callaway) – Had to be momentarily steadied passing the 700 metres when improving onto the heels of a tiring runner.	
FLYING SARDINE (R Yatim) – Was obliged to improve wide from the 500 metres and lay inwards throughout the run home.	
Race 2	DUNEDIN HOLIDAY PARK 1200m
LAY OFF (T Comignaghi) – Slow to begin.	
SQUIZZY (K Kalychurun) – Began awkwardly. Rider lost the use of his rein momentarily over the concluding stages	

resulting in the gelding shifting outwards abruptly. Rider K Kalychurun reported that the gelding had raced greenly throughout.

YES YOU DID (C Barnes) – Got its head up when being restrained near the 900 metres.

VERIFY (G Jogoo) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RIO TENNILLE (C Johnson) – Held up for a short distance passing the 400 metres. Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres and had to be straightened. Bumped with **OLYMPIA** passing the 100 metres and then came together with that runner over the concluding stages.

OLYMPIA (S Wynne) – Shifted outwards under pressure in the early stages of the final straight and had to be straightened. Bumped with **RIO TENNILLE** passing the 100 metres, then came together with that runner over the concluding stages. Rider S Wynne was advised that in future she would be expected to straighten her mounts sooner than she did so on this occasion.

Following the event, C Johnson as the rider of the 2nd placed **RIO TENNILLE** lodged a protest against the 1st placed **OLYMPIA** alleging interference in the final straight. After viewing the video coverage and hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 3	CAREFREE STABLES 1200m

SPECIAL DUKE (D Turner) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Commenced to over-race passing the 800 metres having to be steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of **TAIERI GEM** near the 600 metres. Lay inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres bumping with **FLICKA OF GOLD**.

ROYAL DOLLAR (R Yatim) – Slow to begin.

POLLY'S SISTER (S Toolooa) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

FLICKA OF GOLD (S Muniandy) – Got its head up when being restrained near the 1100 metres. Bumped near the 200 metres.

LIVADREAM (G Jogoo) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TAIERI GEM (C Barnes) – Held up in the early stages of the final straight having to shift outwards near the 200 metres to obtain clear running.

RUBY ROW (T Moseley) – Lay inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres becoming awkwardly positioned to the outside of **TAIERI GEM**.

Race 4	MOSGIEL TAVERN & KADES RESTAURANT 1400m

BACK IN THE DAY (K Kwo) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

GALLANT DEFENDER (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

ACCIDENTAL OFFSIDE (C Johnson) – Over raced in the early and middle stages when leading.

WAYLAY (S Muniandy) – Held up for a short distance passing the 450 metres.

SNIPARINDA (T Comignaghi) – When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice rider T Comignaghi reported that in her opinion the gelding performs better when able to obtain in a leading position however this did not

eventuate. Rider Comignaghi added that the gelding may not have handled the heavy track conditions which she described as testing.

ATAAHUADREAMSRFREE (T Moseley) – Jumped outwards from the barrier hampering **BOUND TO KEEP HER** and **JANE AVRIL**.

BOUND TO KEEP HER (R Cuneen) – Hampered at the start losing ground.

JANE AVRIL (G Jogoo) – Crowded leaving the barrier. Over-raced for a distance passing the 900 metres.

SO GALLANT (C Campbell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NEAT AZA PIN (L Hemi) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADY DAVONE (L Callaway) – Shifted outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 6	RACE A TAVISTOCK FILLY WITH GO RACING & S.MARSH 2200m

FRANCONI (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.

POINT PROVEN (K Kalychurun) – Raced wide in the early stages until obtaining a leading position near the 1300 metres.

SHANTAV (C Johnson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Johnson reported that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle the heavy track conditions.

THE ENERGIZER (R Yatim) – Improved wide from the 900 metres. Lay inwards under pressure near the 300 metres and had to be straightened.

DARCI INN (T Comignaghi) – Shifted outwards under pressure passing the 200 metres bumping with **SATIN GURU**.

SATIN GURU (J Lowry) – Bumped passing the 200 metres.

BULLITT (D Turner) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Turner advised that in his opinion the gelding had failed to handle the heavy track conditions.

Race 7	RAY & ALISON KEAN OF SOUTHERN WIDE REAL ESTATE 1600m

DOCKET (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

DREAM DIVINE (T Moseley) – Slow to begin.

MISS TUSCAN (K Kalychurun) – Slow to begin.

MADAME LIBRE (S Wynne) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BURWOOD (S Muniandy) – When questioned regarding the performance rider S Muniandy reported that the mare had travelled well during the running however when placed under pressure had failed to respond to his urgings. Rider Muniandy added that in his opinion the mare may not have been entirely suited by the heavy track conditions. Rider S Muniandy was issued with a warning pursuant to Rule 648(5) after he weighed in 0.6 kgs overweight.

Race 8	IT'S LADIES DAY NEXT WEEKEND AT WINGATUI! 1600m

QUINTASTICS (A Sharpe) – Slow to begin. Shifted inwards under pressure over the final 100 metres.

IVANSKAVINSKYSKVAR (K Kalychurun) – Crowded leaving the barrier between CENTAVADA and STRIKE UP THE BAND which began awkwardly and shifted inwards. Rider K Kalychurun expressed disappointment with the performance stating that the gelding may not have handled the heavy track conditions.

STRIKE UP THE BAND (R Firdhaus) – Began awkwardly.

CENTAVADA (S Toolooa) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

LORD SIBFORD (D Turner) – Shifted inwards under pressure passing the 200 metres placing PERCEPTIVE in restricted room. Rider D Turner was advised that in future he would be expected to straighten his mounts sooner than he did on this occasion.

PERCEPTIVE (C Campbell) – Placed in restricted room for a short distance passing the 200 metres when racing to the inside of LORD SIBFORD, having to shifting outwards across that runner's heels to obtain clear running.
