## GENERAL:

Rider L Satherley did not attend the meeting after being injured at track work this morning.
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## SUPPLEMENTARY:

<b>THISTLEDONICELY</b> - Co-trainer D Sweeney advised that THISTLEDONICELY which is a likely starter at Whangarei Racing Club, 8 July has had bone chips removed from the left front knee since last racing.  <u>Racing Tauranga - 24 June 2017</u> <b>Race 4 - GPS-IT PRECISION LAND MAPPING 1200</b> <b>MR LUIGI</b> (A Collett) – Trainer P Lock advised Stewards that the gelding had taken some time to recover following its performance in this race, further advising that MR LUIGI had undergone antibiotic treatment and would now be freshened prior to racing next.  <b>Race 5 - ZEST 2100</b> <b>MOTUMAN</b> (J Nason) – Trainer W Carter advised Stewards that the gelding has now been sent for a spell.
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**RACE COMMENTS:**

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>CLARENCE STREET PAK N SAVE 1200</b>
<p><b>ANAHERA LASS</b> (S Spratt) – Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race in the early stages and ran wide when making the bend near the 900 metres forcing SHOWTENAIRE wider on the track.</p> <p><b>SHOWTENAIRE</b> (T Thornton) – Forced wide 900 metres.</p> <p><b>JEWEL OF PATCH</b> (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages, then racing wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>EENYMEENY MINY MO</b> (D Danis) – Made the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>THE BOY WONDER</b> (C Johnson) – Rider C Johnson admitted a breach in that he failed to ride THE BOY WONDER out to the end of the race when there was a reasonable chance of finishing in 4<sup>th</sup> position (finished 5<sup>th</sup>). After considering submissions the Judicial Committee suspended his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 8 July up to and including racing on 15 July, 3 riding days.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>SKYCITY HAMILTON 1600</b>
<p><b>STOKERS ROCK</b> (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DOUCETTE</b> (J Nason) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>JUMPFLEX NZ 2100</b>
<p><b>FRANCIS DRAKE</b> (C Johnson) – Raced keenly when being restrained leaving the straight on the first occasion and continued to do so through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>ROUGH CUT</b> (S Spratt) – Raced keenly when being restrained leaving the straight on the first occasion.</p> <p><b>KING NERO</b> (Z Nor Azman) – Raced wide in the early stages. Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres to the inside of JOCHEN RINDT which lay in when making the bend.</p> <p><b>JOCHEN RINDT</b> (D Danis) – When questioned regarding the performance, apprentice D Danis advised that the gelding had a tendency to hang in throughout the race, and had not responded once placed under pressure from near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination could find no obvious abnormality.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE</b>
<p><b>HIGH CLASS</b> (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>COERCED WITNESS</b> (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>TAVIS STAR</b> (C Lammas) – When questioned regarding the performance, rider C Lammas advised the mare had not been entirely happy in today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>JUMANAH</b> (S Spratt) – Was crowded passing the 450 metres when weakening to the outside of SAFFRON LADY (B R Jones) which was dictated out slightly by LIGHT EM UP which lay out when making the final bend.</p> <p><b>KEEP ON COMING</b> (S Weatherley) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>CRAFTYEVA</b> (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance, rider D Johnson advised that the mare may prefer better track conditions and may be looking for more ground. CRAFTYEVA underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p>	

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>TRUE COLOURS CHILDREN'S HEALTH TRUST 1600</b>
<p><b>RHYTHM 'N' SHOES</b> (D Danis) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>PLAZABEEL</b> (T Harris) – Began awkwardly and then raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>THE LAST SAMURAI</b> (D Prastiyou) – Made contact leaving the barrier losing ground. Made brief contact with RECOLLECT approaching the 400 metres when looking to obtain clear running with THE LAST SAMURAI then laying in and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of REDCAYENNE which shifted out.</p> <p><b>REDCAYENNE</b> (V Colgan) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>PIERIAN SPRING</b> (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BECOME A MEMBER OF WRC 1600</b>
<p><b>ATTIRE</b> (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>I'LL STAND BY YOU</b> (T Wenn) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 900 metres to the inside of LEICA LADY (M Du Plessis) which shifted in slightly. Rider M Du Plessis was advised he must exercise greater care. I'LL STAND BY YOU then over-raced for a distance.</p> <p><b>LADY FENUALA</b> (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>ROB MAY BUILDERS 1400</b>
<p><b>ALAMER</b> (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting out and making brief contact with STRADIVARIUS which had also began awkwardly with ALAMER then shifting in abruptly and crowding LEEDS which was badly hampered losing ground.</p> <p><b>LEEDS</b> (S McKay) – Badly hampered leaving the barrier losing ground.</p> <p><b>DARCI MAC</b> (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly making contact and was steadied.</p> <p><b>ANNABELINDA</b> (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>STRADIVARIUS</b> (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Apprentice rider J Nason was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so.</p> <p><b>SOLMIZATION</b> (Z Nor Azman) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Apprentice Z Nor Azman was questioned regarding his riding tactics in particular why he had not obtained cover in the early stages when there was an opportunity to do so. Z Nor Azman advised that he had ridden the gelding with urgency in the early stages to maintain a position in the first four and had erred in his judgment after becoming trapped wide. His explanation was noted.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>JAMARK PLUMBING 1400</b>
<p><b>SACRED GURU</b> (D Johnson) – Was removed from the barrier after becoming fractious to undergo an examination which cleared the gelding fit. When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised that in her opinion SACRED GURU had not been suited by today's step up in distance. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.</p> <p><b>PYTHAGORAS</b> (T Harris) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Shifted out over the concluding stages inconveniencing ANGELINE which was steadied. T Harris was reprimanded and advised he must exercise great care.</p> <p><b>QUANTUM</b> (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>ANGELINE</b> (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier losing ground. Inconvenienced over the concluding stages and steadied.</p> <p><b>COLLAY</b> (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p>	

**DANGER DEE** (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

**Race 9**

**UNITED CLEANING 2100**

**HOOF HUSTLER** (T Harris) – Slow to begin.

**CIVIQUE ROSE** (T Thornton) – Steadied leaving the barrier.

**TWEEDLEDEE** (C Lammas) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1600 metres, and continued to do so through the middle stages.

**VALANTE** (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

**SINGLE SHOT** (V Gatu) – Shifted out off heels passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running, inconveniencing **STREET SMART**.

**STREET SMART** (C Johnson) – Inconvenienced 400 metres.

**HOYT AXTON** (D Hain) – Rider D Hain was reprimanded by Stewards and reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use on a horse that is out of contention.
