PLAZABEEL (T Harris) – Began awkwardly and then raced ungenerously in the early stages.

THE LAST SAMURAI (D Prastiyou) – Made contact leaving the barrier losing ground. Made brief contact with RECOLLECT approaching the 400 metres when looking to obtain clear running with THE LAST SAMURAI then laying in and becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of REDCAYENNE which shifted out.

REDCAYENNE (V Colgan) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

PIERIAN SPRING (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

Race 6 BECOME A MEMBER OF WRC 1600

ATTIRE (A Collett) – Slow to begin.

I'LL STAND BY YOU (T Wenn) – Raced in restricted room approaching the 900 metres to the inside of LEICA LADY (M Du Plessis) which shifted in slightly. Rider M Du Plessis was advised he must exercise greater care. I'LL STAND BY YOU then over-raced for a distance.

LADY FENUALA (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 7 ROB MAY BUILDERS 1400

ALAMER (S Collett) – Began awkwardly shifting out and making brief contact with STRADIVARIUS which had also began awkwardly with ALAMER then shifting in abruptly and crowding LEEDS which was badly hampered losing ground.

LEEDS (S McKay) – Badly hampered leaving the barrier losing ground.

DARCI MAC (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly making contact and was steadied.

ANNABELINDA (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

STRADIVARIUS (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Apprentice rider J Nason was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of a race when circumstances permit him to do so.

SOLMIZATION (Z Nor Azman) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Apprentice Z Nor Azman was questioned regarding his riding tactics in particular why he had not obtained cover in the early stages when there was an opportunity to do so. Z Nor Azman advised that he had ridden the gelding with urgency in the early stages to maintain a position in the first four and had erred in his judgment after becoming trapped wide. His explanation was noted.

Race 8 JAMARK PLUMBING 1400

SACRED GURU (D Johnson) – Was removed from the barrier after becoming fractious to undergo an examination which cleared the gelding fit. When questioned regarding performance rider D Johnson advised that in her opinion SACRED GURU had not been suited by today's step up in distance. A post-race veterinary examination could find no obvious abnormality.

PYTHAGORAS (T Harris) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Shifted out over the concluding stages inconveniencing ANGELINE which was steadied. T Harris was reprimanded and advised he must exercise great care.

QUANTUM (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

ANGELINE (C Johnson) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier losing ground. Inconvenienced over the concluding stages and steadied.

COLLAY (S Collett) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

DANGER DEE (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

Race 9 UNITED CLEANING 2100

HOOF HUSTLER (T Harris) – Slow to begin.

CIVIQUE ROSE (T Thornton) – Steadied leaving the barrier.

TWEEDLEDEE (C Lammas) – Commenced to over-race passing the 1600 metres, and continued to do so through the middle stages.

VALANTE (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SINGLE SHOT (V Gatu) – Shifted out off heels passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running, inconveniencing STREET SMART.

STREET SMART (C Johnson) - Inconvenienced 400 metres.

HOYT AXTON (D Hain) – Rider D Hain was reprimanded by Stewards and reminded of his obligations with regard to whip use on a horse that is out of contention.
