Race 1	Hypnotize Steeplechase Open 4000m	
NOAH JON (E Far	r) Clipped a heel shortly after the start when JUST ISHI (G Walsh) dictated COLONIA inwards when	
not sufficiently cle	ear. G Walsh defended a subsequent breach of Rule 638(1)(d). After hearing submissions the JCA	

found the charge proved. G Walsh had his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on 28/5/17 to the conclusion of racing on 4/6/17 (2 days). Jumped high and awkward at the first jump losing ground.

COLONIA (S Karnicnik) - raced keenly in the early stages. Dictated inwards shortly after the start.

JUST ISHI (G Walsh) - jumped the first fence awkwardly in the straight on the second round dislodging rider G Walsh who was examined by the paramedics and cleared to ride.

LONELY BOY (C Price) - hit the fence passing the 1200m.

CARLOW (C Kennedy) - jumped the fence passing the 1200m slowly. Did not finish

HIS NIBS (S Higgins) - did not finish.

HIGHLY LIKELY (S Fannin) – hit the fence passing the 900 metres.

Race 2Lowe Schollum & Jones Hurdle Mdn 2900mVOLACAPRI (H McNeill) – was slow to begin.

J'WALKE (C Price) - hit fence at the top of the final straight and fell, contacted and inconvenienced ADEQUACY and bringing down FLAGSTAFF. Rider C Price suffered a suspected broken collar bone. J'WALKE incurred laceration to inside of nose.

FLAGSTAFF (C Kennedy) – Hung in the early stages. Brought down by fallen runner near the 400 metres. C Kennedy was examined by the paramedics and cleared to ride.

ADEQUACY (S Karnicnik) – contacted and inconvenienced by fallen runner near the 400 metres.

THE TALISMAN (R Cole) - did not finish.

OUR DEBUTANTE (C Studd) - did not finish. Rider reported the mare unsuited to the heavy going.

CULLISTER (G Walsh) – blundered at the fence by the 2000m did not finish.

Race 3 Jumping Supporters Hurdles Open 2900m

YIPSON (C Kennedy) – blundered at the second fence unbalancing the rider.

GUY FOX (S MacNab) – raced keenly in the early stages so was allowed to roll forward to lead passing the 2000 metres.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (R Coles) - Put in a poor jump near the 1000 metres then drifted out. Did not finish.

THATZ DAVID (G Walsh) – blundered passing the 900 metres then when being corrected shifted in tightening RED MAFIA and JUSTA CHARLIE which was checked.

RED MAFIA (S Phelan) – tightened near the 900 metres.

JUST A CHARLIE (W Gordon) – checked near the 900 metres.

Race 4Wheelers & Duncans Survived Cheltenham Amateur Rtg 65 2100mBAD BOY BROWN (J Lupton) – was slow to begin.

THATZ LOUIE (S Barlow) - raced wide around the first bend.

HEISTHEONE – when questioned rider L Wheeler reported the gelding was unsuited to racing in the heavy going near the rail for the majority of the event but did pick up in the home straight.

Race 5 NZB Insurance Pearl Series Race Mdn 1200

The start of this race was delayed 10 minutes due to the injury to rider L Hemi.

TAVIJAZZ (L Hemi) - was late scratched after rearing when leaving the enclosure, dislodging rider L Hemi who was attended to by ambulance staff and stood down for her remaining rides. Miss Hemi was taken to hospital for observation.

MISS LIZZIE (McNelis) - began awkwardly.

KOKO BELLE (R Goldsbury) - had to be restrained when improving onto heels near the 800 metres.

ATTIMO – rider D Johnson reported the filly was not comfortable in the heavy track conditions.

Race 6 Sandfords Livestock Rtg 65 1400m

This race was rescheduled to commence at 2.40pm

SILVER COURT (D Turner) – jumped outwards at the start bumping YOU'LL DO ME.

YOU'LL DO ME (A Chan) – bumped at the start.

SCUSA (L Allpress) – jumped inwards at the start dictating CANCELLARA on to SMILING MORE

CANCELLARA (R Sharp) – dictated inwards at the start.

Race 7 Seaver Cycles & Masport 1400m

This race was rescheduled to commence at 3.10pm

TOUCH 'N GO (R Goldsbury) – was slow away.

SAVATAG (D Turner) - began awkwardly.

MASTER PATRICK (R Hannam) – jumped inwards at the start dictating DA JIN SHAN inward.

MR DAVINCI (M Tanaka) and THE GROWLER bumped at the start.

SUFFICIENT FUNDS (T Miles) - began awkwardly bumping NORDIC HERO which settled back.

NORDIC HERO (D Johnson) – bumped at the start settling back.

THE GROWLER (A Chan)– bumped at the start. Connections reported that the gelding was unsuited to the heavy track.

MACARIO (C Johnson) - the rider reported that the mare was unsuited to the heavy track.

DANCING AURIOLE (D Bradley) – had to steady approaching the home straight when weakening.

Race 8 Eltham Vet Services 3yo Mdn 1600m

KEEP IT SAVVY (M Tanaka) – underwent a Veterinary inspection prior to the start and was cleared.

TINY TEMPER (R Hannam) - was slow away.

EMPTY GARDEN (D Turner) – was slow away.

EXONERATE (C Johnson) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

KEEP IT SAVVY (M Tanaka) - ran out under pressure bumping with IMRAN over the final stages. M Tanaka was advised to exercise greater care.

IMRAN (A Collett) - bumped over the final stages.

Race 9 Mack Transport/Holdem Contracting Ltd Mdn 1600m

BROTHER ONE (S MacNab) -was awkwardly away bumping COMMANDER. Tightened near the 1250 metres when in restricted room.

LITTLE MAJELLA (D Bradley) - slow away.

BIG BEN (R Hannam) – slow away.
