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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	HAWKE'S BAY HUNT MAIDEN HURDLE (2500)
EDDIE GILBERT (S Fannin) - jumped indifferently throughout	
LION RED (J Sievwright) - made a poor jump at the fence near 1300m and after jumping the next two fences was retired from the race.	

THE ORANGE PONY (H McNeill) – hit the fence near the 600m and lost ground

LANDLORD (J Riddell) - landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence

Race 2 | **STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN HURDLE (2500)**

THE TALISMAN (J Sievwright) - put in a poor jump at the first fence with the rider momentarily losing his right iron. Then jumped indifferently throughout

JEWEL OF THE NAKI (S Karnicnik) - put in poor jump at the second fence and fell. Horse and rider were uninjured

ZED LEPELIN (H McNeill) - hampered as a result of the fall at second fence. Jumped the fence near the 600m poorly. Hit the last fence

FOXVILLE (D Turner) – pulled out prior to jumping the fence near the 600m when the rider considered something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a strain to the right fore tendon

Race 3 | **TE WHANGAI ROMNEYS HAWKE'S BAY HURDLE (3100)**

GUY FOX (S MacNab) – was slow away. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When being taken forward with a round to go dictated **RED MAFIA** over a little extra ground. Shifted out at the fence near the 600m tightening **SEA KING, READY EDDIE** and **JUSTA CHARLIE**

WIGGLE (I Lupton) –slow away

RED MAFIA (G Walsh) - put in a poor jump at the first fence landing awkwardly. Dictated over a little extra ground near the 2200m. Made a poor jump at the second to last fence.

WEE BISKIT (M Cropp) - got its head up making the bend awkwardly near the 800m on the first occasion. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the right hind dorsal cannon

READY EDDIE (H McNeill) - tightened at the fence near the 600m then commenced to give ground

JUSTA CHARLIE (W Gordon) - tightened at the fence near the 600m. Hampered at the fence near the 350m

SHAMAL (C Price) - hampered at fence near the 350m

SEA KING (S Fannin) – tightened at the fence near the 600m. Hung out badly approaching the last fence

Race 4 | **BIRCHLEIGH POLO CLUB AMATEUR 2100**

MIR INK (S Barlow) – broke through the barriers at the start but was quickly restrained. After undergoing a veterinary examination was passed fit to run

CARTAGENA (S Rennie) - was slow away

RUNNY HONEY (D Stanaway) - over-raced for some distance on the first occasion having to be firmly restrained

ALFIE DEE (G Duncan) - made the first corner wide so was taken forward, continued to race three wide throughout. Had to be steadied for a distance when in restricted room near the 100m

BLAZING OPAL (S MacNab) had to be straightened when shifting in under pressure near the 200m

Race 5 | **TARADALE CLUB 2100**

THORN PRINCE (M Singh) – began awkwardly losing ground, then over-raced in the early stages

ZARTAN (D Bradley) –slow away

Race 6

JUST A SWAGGER HAWKE'S BAY HUNT MAIDEN CHASE (4000)

CULLISTER (G Walsh) and **WILBUR** (S Fannin) collided when jumping the first fence

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (H McNeill) – knuckled after jumping the second fence. Pulled out of the race prior to jumping the fence near the 450m

BRAT PACK (E Farr) – raced ungenerously throughout and put in a poor jump at the second of the stand double with a round to go dislodging rider E Farr. E Farr was attended to by paramedics and stood down for her remaining two rides. E Farr was advised that she is required to provide a medical clearance prior to her next ride. **BRAT PACK** jumped the outside fence and was located on the adjacent road. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a small abrasion to the left knee

WEST END (C Studd) - landed awkwardly at the 450m fence with a round to go. Shifted in and bumped **MENDOZA** near the 1000m. Then put in a poor jump at the fence near the 800m and lost ground. Hampered by the fallen runner near the 450m

MENDOZA (S Karnicnik) - bumped near the 800m.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (W Gordon) - lay in rounding the turn in the approaching to the second last fence crowding **CULLISTER** and **WILBUR**

CULLISTER (G Walsh) – crowded near the 450m fence

WILBUR (S Fannin) crowded near the 450m fence

PERRY MASON (A Kuru) - fell at the fence near the 450m. Horse and rider were uninjured

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (R Cole) -hampered by fallen runner falling at fence near the 450m

LONELY BOY (C Price) – Rider briefly lost use of irons after jumping the third fence. Pulled out prior to jumping the fence at the 450m when well back

Race 7

ANIMAL HEALTH DIRECT HAWKE'S BAY STEEPLECHASE (4800)

JUST ISHI (G Walsh) - had to switch ground outwards approaching the first of the double to make the fence

NELLS BELLE (S Fannin) – landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1000m dislodging rider.

FAIR SCRIPT(S Karnicnik) - badly hampered by the riderless horse approaching the fence near the 800m

KINGS DEEP (A Kuru) - badly hampered by the riderless horse approaching the fence near the 800m. Fell at the 450m fence

THE FOX (C Studd) - was hampered by the fallen runner near the fence at the 450m

Race 8

CHELTENHAM & DUBAI WITH T LEE & ARA 1400

EMBRACEABLE YOU (T Miles) – very slow away (4 lengths) then commenced to over-race

OLLIES NOTE(J Riddell) - had to be briefly restrained approaching the home turn

RESURRECT (C Grylls) – lay in under pressure near the 300m inconveniencing **BUSHFIRE** and continued to lay in for the remainder of the race

BUSHFIRE (M Singh) inconvenienced near the 300m

Race 9

BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR OCTOBER 7 1400

EPIC DREAMER (L Allpress) - was slow away. Faulted near the 300m and was not persevered with for the remainder of the race. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality

GERONIMO (A Chan) - was slow away

HURRICANE LUCY (T Johnson) – had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on heels near the 600m

TIME BEARER (Parkes) - finished well back. When questioned rider J Parkes the gelding was unsuited to the tack conditions

When questioned into the disappointing run of **TAVIJAZZ** rider M Tanaka advised the mare may not have handled the track conditions

D Hirini (IN DREAMLAND) - admitted a breach of [Rule 638(3)(b)(ii)] excessive use of whip prior to the 200 metres. Suspended after the close of racing Saturday 8th July up to and including the close of racing Friday July 14th (1 day)

Race 10

BOSTOCK NEW ZEALAND SPRING CARNIVAL TICKETS ON SALE NOW 1400

ALMO STREET (J Riddell) – slow away. Angled outwards off heels near the 200m

ANIMATOR (H Tinsley) - shifted in abruptly near the 350m bumping **SOUND WORKS** prior to being straightened.

ANIMATOR then continued to lay in under pressure again briefly hampering **SOUND WORKS**

Prior to the authorisation of dividends rider D Bradley (**SOUND WORKS**) viewed footage of the home straight but elected not to proceed with an objection against the second placed **ANIMATOR**.

SOUNDWORKS (D Bradley) bumped at the 350m and then hampered again a short distance further

DUKE OF MILLFIELD (M Tanaka) was dictated outwards near the 200m when **ALMO STREET** angled outwards off the heels of **ROYAL RUBY**.

When questioned into the run of **MYRTLE** rider D Turner advised the filly was unsuited by track conditions. Consideration will be given to spelling the filly

When questioned into the run of **RAINBOW SONG** rider C Grylls advised the gelding was unsuited to track conditions but nevertheless disappointing. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality
