## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 2060m</b>
<b>THE OYSTERMAN (H McNeill)</b> - Underwent and passed a veterinary examination after bursting through its gate prior to the start being effected.	
<b>NEMESIS (T Harris)</b> – Began awkwardly dictating <b>VENERATE</b> outwards.	

**PUKEAKE SAM (C Kennedy)** - Slow away. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1,700 metres.

**HER SON (C Price)** – Slow away. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1,400 metres dictating **KINGS KITE** wider on the track.

**OUR CHUCKY (S Phelan)** – Began awkwardly contacting the gates

**OUR JACKSON (I Lupton)** - Shortly after entering the home straight shifted in under pressure and bumped **NEMESIS**.

**RAISING PENNY (D Turner)** - Had to be steadied when racing in restricted room passing the 600 metres and in doing so went back on to **ALL IN GLAMOUR** which had to avoid that runner's heels.

**ALL IN GLAMOUR (C Perrett)** – Steadied passing the 600 metres.

**RING LARRY (S Fannin)** – When questioned in to the performance S Fannin had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

**GARMENT (D Turner)** – Slow away.

**MISS BUMBLEBEE (J Nason)** – Slow away.

**TICKET TO RIDE (L Allpress)** – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend awkwardly then after bumping **KEEP DANCING** passing the 800 metres, shifted out into the line of **NUTTEE** which was steadied. Stewards took into account inward movement from **CALLIDORA** when assessing the interference.

**NUTTEE (M Tanaka)** – Tightened passing the 800 metres when **TICKET TO RIDE** rolled out.

**KEEP DANCING (L Hemi)** – lay out under pressure in the home straight

**LA CRUZ (C Johnson)** – When questioned C Johnson stated the filly had raced greenly throughout

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>SPOONERS DRY CLEANERS 1200m</b>

**MALACANTO (T Allan)** – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Held up passing the 400 metres and was then unable to obtain a narrow run passing the 200 metres so was angled outwards to obtain clear running.

**TRANKY DOO (L Hemi)** – Dictated wide on the track early in the home straight by **YOU'LL DO ME**

**YOULL DO ME (R Elliot)** – Raced keenly in the middle stages

**LADY PINOT (C Johnson)** – When questioned C Johnson stated the mare had travelled well during the running but was disappointing in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary revealed did not reveal any abnormality.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES F&amp;M 1360m</b>

**LOCH NESS (J Parkes)** - Jumped outwards abruptly at the start dictating **PRINCESS RAAJ** onto **SUCH A ONE** who settled back.

**PRINCESS RAAJ (R Elliot)** – Hung rounding the bend

**ALL THE DRAMA (D Bradley)** – When questioned D Bradley stated the mare had been flat throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

**MENDIP (J Riddell)** - Shifted out under pressure approaching the 100 metres resulting in **LOCH NESS** which was improving into a run to the outside of **MENDIP** being taken out and bumping with **SEA PRINCESS** for some distance near the finish.

Race 5	G BRISTOL & SONS 1600m
<p><b>WENTWORTH (G Walsh)</b> – Underwent and passed a veterinary examination prior to the start after a incurring a small laceration to the inside of its mouth and was cleared to start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p>	
<p><b>HOLLYPOP (J Riddell)</b> – Had to be checked off the heels of <b>WOTAMMISSION</b> passing the 1,400 metres.</p>	
<p><b>ADONIS (S Phelan)</b> – checked approaching the 1,400 metres</p>	
<p><b>BELLA’S EDGE (T Harris)</b> – Slow away</p>	
<p><b>BROK BAK (C Price)</b> – Slow away</p>	
<p><b>HIDDEN DUKE (M Cropp)</b> - Had to be restrained when in tight quarters passing the 500 metres</p>	
<p><b>WOTAMMISSION (M McNelis)</b> – M McNelis admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) (careless riding) in that he allowed his mount to shift in approaching the first bend near the 1,400 metres when not clear of <b>HOLLYPOP</b> which was steadied abruptly and went back onto <b>ADONIS</b> which was checked. After submissions M McNelis has his licence to ride suspended from the close of racing on Saturday 8 July up to and including the close of racing on Thursday, 20 July (3 days).</p>	
Race 6	CHELTENHAM & DUBAI WITH T LEE & ARA 1600m
<p><b>SOIREE (T Harris)</b> – Slow away. Raced keenly in the middle stages.</p>	
<p><b>MAGIC IVAN (S McKay)</b> – Slow away. Held up for a short distance approaching the 600 metres. Had to be angled inwards early in the home straight to gain clear running passing the 250 metres.</p>	
<p><b>PATRICIA ROSE (J Nason)</b> – Awkwardly away</p>	
<p><b>SHOCK ROCK (H Andrew)</b> – Raced keenly throughout, bumped with <b>MISTRESS POROTENE</b> and became unbalanced making the bend passing the 1,400 metres.</p>	
<p><b>CASSINO TO TRIESTE (A Collett)</b> – Raced wide without cover throughout</p>	
<p><b>GET SCHROEDER (C Johnson)</b> – Eased down in the home straight. When questioned into the run C Johnson advised the gelding travelled well into the race but when placed under pressure near the 600 metres failed to respond. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed an atrial fibrillation. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to its next start.</p>	
Race 7	SPOONER, HOOD & REDPATH LTD 1600m
<p><b>ITELLYOUONETHING (C Johnson)</b> – Slow away. Could not be ridden out fully over the final stages when in restricted room.</p>	
<p><b>DOWNTON ABBEY (M Tanaka)</b> – When questioned into the performance M Tanaka stated the mare may not have appreciated today’s Heavy 10 track.</p>
