RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 2060m

THE OYSTERMAN (H McNeill) - Underwent and passed a veterinary examination after bursting through its gate prior to the start being effected.

NEMESIS (T Harris) – Began awkwardly dictating **VENERATE** outwards.

PUKEAKE SAM (C Kennedy) - Slow away. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 1,700 metres.

HER SON (C Price) – Slow away. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1,400 metres dictating **KINGS KITE** wider on the track.

OUR CHUCKY (S Phelan) - Began awkwardly contacting the gates

OUR JACKSON (I Lupton) - Shortly after entering the home straight shifted in under pressure and bumped **NEMESIS**.

RAISING PENNY (D Turner) - Had to be steadied when racing in restricted room passing the 600 metres and in doing so went back on to **ALL IN GLAMOUR** which had to avoid that runner's heels.

ALL IN GLAMOUR (C Perrett) – Steadied passing the 600 metres.

RING LARRY (S Fannin) – When questioned in to the performance S Fannin had no excuse. A subsequent veterinary inspection was clear.

Race 2

NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES F&M 1200m

GARMENT (D Turner) – Slow away.

MISS BUMBLEBEE (J Nason) – Slow away.

TICKET TO RIDE (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages making the bend awkwardly then after bumping **KEEP DANCING** passing the 800 metres, shifted out into the line of **NUTTEE** which was steadied. Stewards took into account inward movement from **CALLIDORA** when assessing the interference.

NUTTEE (M Tanaka) - Tightened passing the 800 metres when TICKET TO RIDE rolled out.

KEEP DANCING (L Hemi) – lay out under pressure in the home straight

LA CRUZ (C Johnson) – When questioned C Johnson stated the filly had raced greenly throughout

SPOONERS DRY CLEANERS 1200m

MALACANTO (T Allan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Held up passing the 400 metres and was then unable to obtain a narrow run passing the 200 metres so was angled outwards to obtain clear running.

TRANKY DOO (L Hemi) – Dictated wide on the track early in the home straight by YOU'LL DO ME

YOULL DO ME (R Elliot) - Raced keenly in the middle stages

LADY PINOT (C Johnson) – When questioned C Johnson stated the mare had travelled well during the running but was disappointing in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary revealed did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 4

NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES F&M 1360m

LOCH NESS (J Parkes) - Jumped outwards abruptly at the start dictating **PRINCESS RAAJ** onto **SUCH A ONE** who settled back.

PRINCESS RAAJ (R Elliot) – Hung rounding the bend

ALL THE DRAMA (D Bradley) – When questioned D Bradley stated the mare had been flat throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality.

MENDIP (J Riddell) - Shifted out under pressure approaching the 100 metres resulting in **LOCH NESS** which was improving into a run to the outside of **MENDIP** being taken out and bumping with **SEA PRINCESS** for some distance near the finish.

Race 5 G BRISTOL & SONS 1600m

WENTWORTH (G Walsh) – Underwent and passed a veterinary examination prior to the start after a incurring a small laceration to the inside of its mouth and was cleared to start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

HOLLYPOP (J Riddell) – Had to be checked off the heels of WOTAMISSION passing the 1,400 metres.

ADONIS (S Phelan) – checked approaching the 1,400 metres

BELLA'S EDGE (T Harris) - Slow away

BROK BAK (C Price) – Slow away

HIDDEN DUKE (M Cropp) - Had to be restrained when in tight quarters passing the 500 metres

WOTAMISSION (M McNelis) – M McNelis admitted a breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) (careless riding) in that he allowed his mount to shift in approaching the first bend near the 1,400 metres when not clear of **HOLLYPOP** which was steadied abruptly and went back onto **ADONIS** which was checked. After submissions M NcNelis has his licence to ride suspended from the close of racing on Saturday 8 July up to and including the close of racing on Thursday, 20 July (3 days).

Race 6 CHELTENHAM & DUBAI WITH T LEE & ARA 1600m

SOIREE (T Harris) – Slow away. Raced keenly in the middle stages.

MAGIC IVAN (S McKay) – Slow away. Held up for a short distance approaching the 600 metres. Had to be angled inwards early in the home straight to gain clear running passing the 250 metres.

PATRICIA ROSE (J Nason) – Awkwardly away

SHOCK ROCK (H Andrew) – Raced keenly throughout, bumped with **MISTRESS POROTENE** and became unbalanced making the bend passing the 1,400 metres.

CASSINO TO TRIESTE (A Collett) - Raced wide without cover throughout

GET SCHROEDER (C Johnson) – Eased down in the home straight. When questioned into the run C Johnson advised the gelding travelled well into the race but when placed under pressure near the 600 metres failed to respond. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed an atrial fibrillation. Connections were advised that a clearance is required prior to its next start.

Race 7 SPOONER, HOOD & REDPATH LTD 1600m

ITELLYOUONETHING (C Johnson) – Slow away. Could not be ridden out fully over the final stages when in restricted room.

DOWNTON ABBEY (M Tanaka) – When questioned into the performance M Tanaka stated the mare may not have appreciated today's Heavy 10 track.
