RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	RAYNER BUILDING 2YO (1200 metres)
IN SEGRETO (H Andrew) – Bounded as the gates opened.	
NUCLEAR FUSION (J Parkes) – Began awkwardly. Had to be restrained off heels passing the 900 metres. Bumped 350 metres.	
STYLE BY DESIGN (L Allpress) – Raced up on to heels having to be heavily restrained when the pace ahead eased passing the 900 metres	

BELTOY (S Collett) – Raced in tight quarters approaching the 350 metres, bumping EVA DAWN and NUCLEAR FUSION. Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

EVA DAWN (M Tanaka) – Bumped 350 metres.

Race 2 | **MANAWATU OFFICE PRODUCTS DEPOT 3YO (1200 metres)**

SMOKEN' ACE (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout.

CAPE DU JEU (T Johnson) – Raced in tight quarters passing the 400 metres bumping with BATABULLET and SAVASAVA.

BATABULLET (M Tanaka) – Bumped 400 metres. When questioned, rider stated the gelding may not have appreciated today's track conditions.

SAVASAVA (J Riddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Bumped 400 metres. Rider advised the colt may prefer a longer distance.

COTES DE BOURG (M Singh) – When questioned into the run, rider M Singh was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited to a longer distance.

Race 3 | **NEW WORLD MARTON HANDICAP (1200 metres)**

KERMIT (A Sharpe) – Saddled slipped early in the race putting the rider at a significant disadvantage, dictating LAST CHANCE wider on the track passing the 800 metres.

AVASTIN (J Parkes) – Attempted to buck shortly after the start losing ground. Trainer S Dougan advised she would make alterations to the mare's gear prior to its next start. S Dougan was advised a further warning has been placed against AVASTIN with regard to its racing manners. Raced three wide without cover.

TIGGER TAHNEE (M Singh) - Jumped out abruptly at the start tightening TALK THE TORQUE, which settled back.

TALK THE TORQUE (D Bradley) – Tightened at start, settled back. Briefly inconvenienced passing the 600 metres.

LAST CHANCE (L Hemi) – Inconvenienced and dictated wider on the track passing the 800 metres.

YIN DRAGON (J Riddell) - Held up early in the home straight having to be angled inwards to gain clear running passing the 200 metres.

CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (S MacNab) – Lay in in the home straight bumping **ITSA TRU STORY** on a number of occasions.

ITSA TRU STORY (H Andrew) – Bumped on a number of occasions in the home straight.

Race 4 | **MARTON BUSINESS HOUSES MAIDEN (1400 metres)**

IN DREAMLAND (M McNelis) – Began awkwardly bumping TURFSHAKER. Prior to the authorisation of dividends, stewards instigated a request for a ruling after apprentice jockey M McNelis indicated he did not receive a fair start in that his right foot was not in its iron when the start was effected. After hearing submissions and viewing footage the JCA declared IN DREAMLAND to be a non-runner.

CRYSTAL ROC – Slow away (6L). A warning has been placed against the barrier manners of CRYSTAL ROC.

TURFSHAKER (J Riddell) – Bumped start.

ANDARTA (S MacNab) – Began awkwardly.

DANCING AURIOLE (S Collett) – Had to be restrained off heels passing the 1100 metres.

SO IT WAS (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 5 | **EVANS HENDERSON WOODBRIDGE BARRISTERS & SOLICITORS HANDICAP (1500 metres)**

HOTSHOT LASS (S Wynne) –Declared a late scratching at 1.43pm after refusing to enter its barrier. Connections were advised that HOTSHOT LASS must barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next race day start.

MASTER THOMAS (R Harris) – Awkwardly away.

ITSAGEM (L Allpress) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

MR DARCEE’S GOLD (D Bradley) – Had to be restrained in tight quarters passing the 300 metres.

Race 6 | **NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE HANDICAP (1400 metres)**

DOLCETTO (S Collett) – Slow away.

BRONSTEEL (H Andrew) – Tightened at the start. H Andrew was shown footage of her ride and advised that she is expected to exercise greater care after angling her mount in near the 800 metres when not clear of DOLCETTO, which had to be steadied and change ground.

GYPSY FAIR (L Allpress) - Buffeted for several strides near the 350 metres when HENI shifted out making the turn simultaneously as LONGCHAMP shifted in.

BANNOCKBURN (M Tanaka) - Dictated wide on the home turn when TAURUS was angled out in search of a run. When questioned into the disappointing run, rider M Tanaka considered something may be amiss. Stewards ordered a veterinary inspection, which was clear.

Race 7 | **BONNY GLEN LANDFILL HANDICAP (2100 metres)**

DRAGON BEAUTY (T Johnson) – Slow away.

PENCURI (T Allan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

JUSTLIKEYASISTER (L Allpress) – When questioned rider advised the mare may not have appreciated today’s track conditions, which she described as holding.

Race 8 | **J&J WALTERS HANDICAP (2100 metres)**

CARNABY (J Parkes) – Jumped outwards abruptly at the start bumping NO EXCUSES, which settled back. Had to be checked when in restricted room approaching the 800 metres.

LOVETOKEEPHIM (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

NO EXCUSES (D Turner) – Gave ground quickly approaching the 800 metres and was not persevered with. Rider was of the opinion the gelding may have choked down. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed an elevated heart rate.

HARD TO BE HUMBLE (M Tanaka) – Went off stride in the going near the 600 metres.

Race 9 | **KELLY & ASSOCIATES HANDICAP (2100 metres)**

RHYMIC DANCER (J Parkes) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection after making contact with starting gates and was cleared to start.

MAX (K Cowan) – Slow away and despite the rider’s urgings was outpaced in the early and middle stages. Held up

early in the home straight having to be angled across heels to gain clear running passing the 300 metres.

YAMATO NADESHIKO (L Allpress) – Slow away. Ran out under pressure final stages.

HAMILTONIAN (M Singh) – Slow away.

T Johnson (DAL SIR TEE) - Was issued with a warning under Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) with regard to his use of the whip in the home straight.
