RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	AJC Members 1400
TORCHED (M Du Plessis) – Began awkwardly and was buffeted shortly after losing ground.	
MAQUIS (T Thornton) – Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 350 metres.	

SHESALLRAAJ (J Nason) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils and was deemed to have bled after undergoing a veterinary examination. SHESALLRAAJ now faces a two month stand down from track work and a three month stand down from racing with a veterinary clearance also being required prior to trialing or racing next.

WINKLE DANCER (V Colgan) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after travelling well in the early and middle stages the gelding had been unable to quicken in today's testing conditions.

JALAPENO – Following the race the mare collapsed and died due to a possible heart attack or ruptured aorta.

BELANCA (A Jones) – Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious and was declared a late scratching at 12.28pm acting on veterinary advice.

ROYAL REBEL (S Weatherley) – Slow away.

THE CHASER (M Du Plessis) – Raced keenly when being restrained in the early to middle stages.

ATTIRE (A Collett) – Attempted to improve into a marginal run near the 400 metres then having to briefly steady and shift in to obtain clear running.

CURRAHEE LAD (T Wenn) – Apprentice Rider T Wenn was questioned regarding the riding tactics adopted, in particular why she had stayed in a four wide position from the 800 metres to the 400 metres when there was an opportunity to shift in to a two wide position. Apprentice T Wenn explained that she had thought that TORCHED had remained to the inside of CURRAHEE LAD and she was not clear to shift ground. Her explanation was noted by Stewards.

TAMA AKARANA (Z Nor Azman) – Removed from the barriers after becoming fractious and was declared fit to race after undergoing a veterinary advice.

TRUMP THAT (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly with apprentice R Elliot becoming unbalanced with TRUMP THAT losing ground.

DORA MAAR (D Prastiyou) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1800 metres. Rider **D Prastiyou** admitted a breach in that he used his whip excessively with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 15 July 2017 up to and including racing on 22 July 2017, 2 riding days.

BANBURY LAD (BR Jones) – Slow away. Shifted out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running making contact with DELUXE EDITION which became briefly unbalanced. BR Jones was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

DELUXE EDITION (D Danis) – Crowded 400 metres becoming briefly unbalanced.

STOCKTAKE (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages.

THENAMESBOND (G Saejorhor) – Raced wide throughout.

CRAFTYEVA (H Marzuki) – When questioned regarding the performance Apprentice Rider H Marzuki advised that the mare had not been entirely happy comfortable in today's track conditions.

FREEWHEELER (R Scott) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1700 metres and was briefly steadied.

COOL CASSIE (A Sims) – Apprentice Rider **A Sims** was reprimanded regarding her excessive whip use and further advised a warning would be placed on her record.

SAKHEE'S STAR (D Danis) – Apprentice Rider **D Danis** admitted a breach in that he used the whip excessively with the Judicial Committee suspending his license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 15 July 2017 up to and including racing on 22 July 2017, 2 riding days.

DOUCETTE (H Marzuki) – Apprentice Rider H Marzuki was dislodged shortly after the finish and cleared fit by medical staff to fulfill his remaining rides.

AMACHI (D Prastiyoun) – Jumped away awkwardly.

AMASTAR (H Marzuki) – Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SMOOCHY (Z Nor Azman) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

EL DUQUE (M Du Plessis) – Rider M Du Plessis could offer no tangible excuse for the poor performance. Trainer S Marsh advised that the gelding would undergo a full veterinary examination on return to the stable.

UTWO TIME (S Collett) – Knuckled when leaving the barrier.

SINGLE MOMENT (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.

COBBLER JIM (D Hain) – Began awkwardly and was crowded.

LHOTSE (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly making contact and losing ground. Held up early in the final straight. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 50 metres and was briefly steadied.

BUFFALO ELLE (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

ALL OF THE LIGHTS (Z Nor Azman) – Crowded passing the 900 metres to the inside of AIR CENTRE which shifted in and away from BOHO CHIC which lay in when making the bend. As a result ALL OF THE LIGHTS was hampered losing ground.

BOHO CHIC (M Du Plessis) – Rider M Du Plessis dropped his whip passing the 200 metres.

SENASSY (Z Nor Azman) – Began awkwardly and then raced in restricted room shortly after having to steady losing ground.

DOUGIE (H Marzuki) – Slow to begin. Crowded 900 metres.

SHERADREAM (T Wenn) – Slow to begin.

LADY CONRAAD (D Prastiyoun) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier losing ground.

KICKATINALONG (T Thornton) – Crowded soon after leaving the barrier losing ground.

ARMAGUARD (A Collett) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start to the inside of BELLE HOPE (S Weatherley) which shifted in. S Weatherley was reprimanded and advised he must exercise greater care.

SALTED CARMEL (D Danis) – Shifted in when making the bend passing the 900 metres making contact with DOUGIE and with SALTED CARMEL becoming unbalanced. D Danis was advised he must exercise greater care. SALTED CARMEL raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

BELLE HOPE (S Weatherley) – Apprentice Rider S Weatherley advised that the filly had felt reluctant to hit out when amongst other runners.

ASCOMANNI (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

ESPRIT DE CORPS (T Harris) – Slow to begin.

CRITICS CHOICE (A Schwerin) – Slow to begin.

ROAD TRIP (R Elliot) – Slow to begin.

STAN'S TUF TIGER (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin. Commenced to give ground passing the 800 metres and was retired from the race. STAN'S TUF TIGER was attended to by the Course Veterinarian and humanely euthanased.

CHECKOUT (J Riddell) – Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance Rider J Riddell advised that the filly had never travelled well in the early and middle stages but had made ground over the concluding stages.
