	Race 1	JO MCGARTLAND MEMORIAL HURDLES 3000M
	GO GO GONZO ((W Gordon) - When spoken to regarding the performance of the gelding the rider reported that he could

offer no tangible excuse other than carrying top weight on a very testing track.

THE ENERGIZER (D Bothamley) - Poor leap at the fence passing 1100 metres losing some momentum. Held up early in the run home and only gained clear racing room after the second to last fence.

ABSOLUT EXCELENCIA (A Kuru) - Lay in early in the run home and had to be straightened. Put in a very poor leap at the second to last fence losing some momentum. Also put in a poor leap at the last fence landing awkwardly. Returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils with a post-race veterinary examination revealing the gelding to be a bleeder and as a result was stood down from racing for three months.

PHEASANT (S Phelan) - Raced wide for the majority of the race. Hit the hurdle at the 1000 metres very hard.

SPEEDY JAX (H McNeill) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Put in an awkward leap at the third fence.

Race 2 PORT FM MAIDEN 1200M

TUSSOCK (S Wahab) - Keen in the early and middle stages. The rider reported that the gelding had over-raced early and failed to run on when placed under pressure.

OPIO ROSE (P Shaikh) - Raced wide for the majority of the event.

SWISS DREAM (R Firdhaus) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Outpaced in the middle stages despite the efforts of the rider. Improved quickly onto the heels of the tiring RUBYMOON passing the 200 metres and when being steadied clipped a heel and blundered losing momentum. R Firdhaus was shown a replay of this incident for educational purposes.

RUBYMOON (A Collett) - The rider reported that the mare did not handle the testing track conditions today.

OUR ROYAL (R Bishop) - Slow to begin. Shifted inwards off heels abruptly at the 250 metres and had to be straightened.

WHERE ANGELS WALK (C Barnes) – Raced wide throughout.

FLAVOURING - When spoken to regarding the improved performance of the gelding, after being well beaten at its last start, trainer S Cameron advised that the win had come as a surprise to him as well and was an unexpected improved performance.

Race 3 D'CASH DASH 1200M

LOCHAN ORA (K Kwo) - Raced wide for the majority of the event. Lay out throughout the run home.

SIR LINDAUER (R Firdhaus) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

Race 4 ONCEUPONATIME SPRINT 1200M

BORN A ROYAL (K Williams) - Raced wide early stages. Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres momentarily inconveniencing WHY ME.

WHY ME (K Gundowry) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.

SIR JACK REMINGTON (T Moseley) - Trainer K Tyler was issued with a warning under Rule 616 (4) when presenting this runner without the notified blinkers.

FADE TO GREY (S Wynne) - Began very awkwardly losing ground.

FUN FAIR (P Shaikh) - Lay in early in the run home.

PROMISING (A Collett) - Rider dropped her whip passing the 250 metres.

LIVADREAM (S Wahab) - Momentarily hampered near the 250 metres when ENTREE lay outwards.

Race 5 EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES LTD STEEPLECHASE 4280M

IRISH DUDE (S Phelan) - Hesitant leap at the fence near the 1200 metres. A poor leap at the fence by the 900 metres losing momentum. Hampered last fence.

SEEKING REDEMPTION (H McNeill) - Mixed its jumping throughout. Hampered last fence.

MISTER DEEJAY (C Price) - Became awkwardly placed at the 250 metres and had to change ground outwards. Brought down last fence.

DELLEUD (W Gordon) – Faulty leap at the last fence, landed very awkwardly dislodging rider. The trailing MISTER DEEJAY was unable to avoid the fallen runner and was also brought down dislodging its rider. Hampered as a result of this incident were IRISH DUDE and SEEKING REDEMPTION. Neither rider was injured in this incident. DELLEUD was attended to by the on course Veterinarian and was humanly euthanased after fracturing the right hind leg.

Race 6 SHAWEIGH MAIDEN MILE 1600M

GREY GHOST (S Wahab) - Lay in for the majority of the run home when struck with the whip shifted in and had to be straightened on several occasions. When struck with the whip again at the 175 metres shifted in hampering PACO RABANNE and then clipped the heel of NATIONAL ASSET blundering and losing momentum. Rider S Wahab admitted a resultant breach of Rule 638 (1) (d) Careless Riding with the JCA imposing a suspension of his licence from the conclusion of racing today and up to and including 5th August 2017 (3 days).

ROYAL MISTRESS (A Collett) - Rider could offer no tangible excuses for the poor performance of the favoured runner.

LAY OFF (R Firdhaus) - Bounded as the start was made losing considerable ground.

METASEQUOIA (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

OTAGO FLYER (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

Apprentice K Mudhoo reported that he was feeling unwell and was examined by the St John paramedics and stood down for his one remaining ride suffering from dizziness and dehydration. K Mudhoo was advised that he must provide a Medical Clearance prior to riding next.

Race 7 THANK YOU & FAREWELL WARWICK COLES 1600M

KINGS PAL (A Collett) - Wide throughout.

CLARA JANE (S Wynne) - Lay outwards passing the 75 metres and had to be straightened.

MYSTIC POWER (S Weatherley) - Keen early stages. Lay in early in the run home.

SPIDER LILY (K Williams) - Rider reported that the mare had raced greenly when in tight quarters early and only battled fairly over the concluding stages.

BRIDGET TOWN (A Morgan) - Slow to begin.

Race 8 MCINTOSH CATERING HANDICAP 1600M

O'KIWI (S Wynne) - Over-raced in the early stages. Held up early in the run home.

PASSAMAQUODDY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

VERNA AUDREY (S Weatherley) - Momentarily crowded at the 150 metres.

IVANSKAVINSKYSKVAR (T Moseley) - Over-raced in the early stages.

MORGAN BET (K Kwo) - Saddle moved shortly after the start placing the rider at a disadvantage. Rider dropped whip at the 300 metres. Shifted in under pressure passing the 150 metres momentarily crowding VERNA AUDREY.

BACHATA (R Bishop) - Over-raced in the early stages.

YOU ARE AMAZING (K Williams) – Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination. Late scratching on Veterinary advice after being found to be lame on the near fore leg.

DREAM DIVINE (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.

Race 9 PHAR LAP RACEWAY MAIDEN STAYERS 2100M

ESSDEE (P Shaikh) - Shifted in under pressure passing the 100 metres.

MIGHTY MAK (A Collett) - Momentarily crowded passing the 100 metres when ESSDEE (P Shaikh) shifted in under pressure. P Shaikh was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

PAINTED ANGEL (T Moseley) - Got its head up when racing keenly rounding the first bend due to the lack of tempo.

FLY THE FLAG (K Kwo) - Keen early and wide throughout. Rider could offer no tangible excuses for the disappointing performance.

HOU LA LA (J Morris) - Began awkwardly. Got its head up when racing keenly through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

EVENTIDE (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin.
