GENERAL:

C Lammas was unable to attend today's transferred meeting due to other commitments.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TE AROHA LIQUOR MDN HURDLE

HESALLJAZZ (J Seivwright) – Hampered soon after leaving barriers losing ground.

JEWEL OF THE NAKI (M Cropp) – Raced in restricted room when jumping the first fence landing awkwardly. Put in a poor jump at the second fence losing ground. Retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.

SINO HEIGHTS (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Had a tendency to run its fences down throughout.

BERNALI (G Walsh) – Put in a poor jump at the third fence.

PRIMROSE HILL (W Gordon) – Hit the fence near the 1100 metres landing awkwardly with the rider becoming unbalanced.

LACUSTRE (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1100 metres landing awkwardly.

LEDBURY (S Karnicnik) – Retired from the race prior to the third last fence when well beaten.

DALRIADA (C Price) – Placed in restricted room to the inside of SINO HEIGHTS which lay in prior to jumping the third to last fence with DALRIADA having to shift out across that runner's heels.

Race 2 PIAKO MITSUBISHI MDN HURDLE

ARTERIAL (M Gibbs-Manssen) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground, then jumped indifferently throughout. Commenced to give ground passing the 1200 metres, and was pulled up prior to jumping the third to last fence.

JOVANNI (H McNeill) – Steadied when crowded shortly after leaving the barrier. Hit the fence near the 1100 metres landing awkwardly. Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence.

RUB IT IN (A Kuru) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence

ZEDSATIONAL (C Price) – Made contact with the running rail going off stride when in restricted room to the inside of EL FERNANDO near the 900 metres on the first occasion.

NOMBERO (C Studd) – Made contact with the running rail near the 800 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the second to last fence.

ARTIFACT (M Roustoby) – Hit the second to last fence and blundered on landing losing ground with the rider becoming briefly unbalanced.

WHITE DIAMOND (W Gordon) – Lost the right hind plate during the running.

Race 3 PATRON PADDY'S OPEN HURDLE

D'LLARO (S Fannin) – Put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1100 metres on the second occasion.

EL CORBY (E Farr) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the third to last fence. Ran down the final two fences.

OLD COUNTESS (H McNeill) – Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres, and was pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences.

WHO CAN TELL (S Phelan) – Pulled up near the 1200 metres when well back. When questioned rider S Phelan was unable to offer any reason apart from the gelding would be better suited to a steeplechase role in the future.

Race 4 FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES 2200

MUELED (L Calitz) – Very slow to begin (3L). Commenced to give ground passing the 450 metres shifting wider on the track passing the 400 metres, and was unable to quicken. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

HALLAVABOY (S Wenn) – Briefly crowded leaving the barrier.

RINGLOCK (B Rogerson) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1900 metres shifting back on to ADEQUACY. When questioned into the performance of RINGLOCK rider B Rogerson was unable to offer any reason for the gelding's performance.

ADEQUACY (L Wheeler) - Hampered 1900 metres, and raced ungenerously for a distance.

GOD OF HERBS (B Kennedy) – Commenced to lay out passing the 1800 metres forcing RINGLOCK wider on the track. Continued to hang out for the remainder of the race. GOD OF HERBS then ducked out sharply passing the 300 metres, and after being straightened by its rider continued to shift in crowding SUFFICE TO SAY over the concluding stages. Rider B Kennedy was issued with a warning.

Race 5 TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES OPEN STEEPLECHASE

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (D Turner) – Put in a poor jump at the second fence.

BROK BAK (C Price) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Stumbled badly on landing after jumping the second to last fence, and again at the final fence, shifting in making firm contact with THAT'S HOW IT GOES.

THE KAKAHU EXPRESS (D Turner) – Dipped on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (A Kuru) – Bumped after jumping the final fence becoming briefly unbalanced.

KINGS KITE (W Gordon) – Returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. A post-race veterinary examination found the gelding to be a bleeder and as such is subject to a two month stand down from training, and a three month stand down from racing in New Zealand.

Race 6 TE AROHA TRACTOR & GARDEN MACHINERY 1600

STOLEN NIGHT (J Nason) – Began awkwardly. Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

IMRAN (A Collett) – Began awkwardly. Shifted out abruptly passing the 250 metres, and when being corrected shifted in inconveniencing LEARNING TO FLY.

WAGNER (E Farr) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

Race 7 KNOTTINGLY FARM THE MAIDEN STEEPLE

ISTIMAGIC (C Studd) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had a minor laceration whilst being transported to the races. ISTIMAGIC underwent another veterinary examination when arriving at the barriers and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left hind leg, and was treated by the veterinarian. ISTIMAGIC will require a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

JUSTNAMETHEPRICE (C Price) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Stumbled on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

MENDOZA (M Cropp) – Jumped indifferently in the early stages with rider M Cropp losing the use of his left stirrup iron for a distance after jumping the third fence. Stumbled on landing at the final two fences.

ROOF OF RECKONING (M Roustoby) – Raced wide in the early stages. Stumbled badly on landing after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres on the final occasion dislodging rider M Roustoby who was uninjured.

NGATIRA GOLD (A Kuru) – Stumbled on landing after jumping the second to last fence.

THE TALISMAN (W Gordon) – Put in a poor jump at the second to last fence landing awkwardly.

Race 8 TE AROHA STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME 1600

NORDIC HERO (T Harris) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

PRINCESS RAAJ (A Schwerin) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

VALANTE (B R Jones) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 SIR SLICK WINNERS CIRCLE 1400

EMBRACEABLE YOU (A Collett) - Slow to begin.

PLAYBOY PRINCE (B R Jones) – Slow to begin.

MI PIACI (H Marzuki) - Slow to begin.

RESURRECT (V Colgan) – Lay out shortly after the start dictating ELEGANT LAD out which made contact with the hind quarters of MYRCELLA which then lay in with ELEGANT LAD having to be steadied. Rider V Colgan was reminded that he must ride his mounts out fully to the finish when circumstances permit after narrowly holding second placing after relaxing his ride over the final stages.

ELEGANT LAD (J Nason) – Steadied shortly after the start when in restricted room.

MYRCELLA (T Wenn) – Had to be briefly steadied when in restricted room to the outside of RESURRECT which shifted out when not sufficiently clear near the 1200 metres.

GUMBOOTS (S Weatherley) – Shifted out abruptly under pressure near the 200 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

Race 10 RACING TE AROHA SUPPORTERS CLUB 1200

Trainer A Fuller (SHE'S FLOSSIE) was issued with a warning for presenting SHE'S FLOSSIE without an item of notified gear (side winkers).

BLACK PEARL (A Collett) – Began very awkwardly losing ground and getting its head up in the early stages when racing ungenerously.

COPPER XPRESS (A Schwerin) – Slow to begin.

SHAHANA (T Wenn) - Slow to begin.
