## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CATERING SOUTH CANTERBURY SPRING 1200M
<b>WILKIE GEORGE</b> (H Andrew) – Began awkwardly losing ground.  <b>DRAPPIER</b> (L Callaway) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.  <b>WHERE ANGELS WALK</b> (C Barnes) – Brought down by a fallen runner at the winning post. Neither horse nor rider was injured in this incident.  <b>ADVENT</b> (D Danis) – Was held up for the majority of the run home and when being restrained off the heels of SACRED DESIRE at the winning post, clipped a heel and fell with the trailing WHERE ANGELS WALK also being brought down. Rider	

D Danis was transported to hospital for treatment. ADVENT underwent a veterinary inspection and was cleared of any injury.

**EDEN ROSE** (R Bishop) – Momentarily unbalanced passing the 400 metres when making contact with TUSOCK who was attempting to improve outwards at that point.

<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ONCEUPONATIME R75 DASH 1200M</b>
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**MAL D'MOUR** (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout. Rider reported failed to handle the testing nature of today's track.

**STROLLING VAGABOND** (C Barnes) – When asked to comment on the performance of the favourite, the rider reported that in her opinion the mare had struggled in today's testing conditions after a six week break. However, she also added that STROLLING VAGABOND will take natural benefit from today's run.

**FLICKA OF GOLD** (R Firdhaus) – Lay out passing the 200 metres and shifted outwards to avoid the heels of NAKYAMA. Lay inwards in the shadows of the post when struck with the whip and had to be straightened.

**PINZANO** (S Wynne) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was declared a late scratching after being kicked at the starting area.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>THE SAIL &amp; ANCHOR BAR &amp; CAFE R65 1200M</b>
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**BACK IN THE DAY** (K Kwo) – Bounded at the start losing some ground.

**FLASH SUGGESTION** (C Campbell) – Lay out throughout the run home and had to be straightened on several occasions. Stewards questioned apprentice C Campbell in the presence of his employer Mr S Anderton in regards to his apparent lack of vigour in the last 50 metres. Mr Campbell advised that the gelding had hung outwards throughout the run home and shied away from the rail. He also added that the gelding again lay out passing the 50 metres and he was obliged to stop riding and straighten his mount. He added FLASH SUGGESTION resented being placed in restricted room when NOWHERE MAN also shifted in at this point. After viewing replays and considering evidence tendered by both Mr Campbell and Mr Anderton, Stewards advised apprentice Campbell that the matter would not be taken any further on this occasion but he was advised he must ensure he rides his mount to the finish when circumstances permit.

**SWITCHED ON** (S Wynne) – Rider reported that the mare had failed to handle today's testing track conditions.

**BUSHIDO** (C Johnson) – Raced wide throughout.

**TOETWOTOE** (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Tailed the field through the early and middle stages despite the efforts of its rider.

**NOWHERE MAN** (K Gundowry) – Began awkwardly and lost ground.

**ROCK SOLID** (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly and got back as a result.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>CENTRAL SI OWNERS &amp; TRAINERS MILE 1600M</b>
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**VERNA AUDREY** (H Andrew) – Raced keenly for several strides passing the 1100 metres and had to be restrained.

**FINAL SHINKO** (C Johnson) – Rider reported that he had a nice run throughout but failed to let down in the run home when placed under pressure and had been disappointing.

**HILARIOUS** (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly and lost ground. Rider reported failed to handle testing track.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>GOLDPINE TIMARU R75 1600M</b>
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**THE GORDONIAN** (K Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages.

**LORD SIBFORD** (A Collett) – Rider reported failed to handle today's testing track conditions.

**MYSTIC POWER** (H Andrew) – Rider reminded of her obligations under the excessive use of whip rule.

**PAT IN BRACKETS** (T Jonker) – Began to race keenly passing the 1400 metres and improved quickly onto the heels of I'M HORRACE clipping a heel and blundering momentarily. Continued to race keenly through the middle stages.

<b>SIR LINDAUER</b> (R Firdhaus) – Lay out on the final bend when under pressure and gave ground from this point finishing a distant last.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>PORT FM MAIDEN MILE 1600M</b>
<p><b>GREY GHOST</b> (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>NATIONAL ASSET</b> (R Bishop) – Trainer S Cameron was issued with a warning under Rule 616(4) when presenting his runner without the notified blinkers.</p> <p><b>VAPO</b> (S Wynne) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.</p> <p><b>SEVEN DIALS</b> (H Bennet) – Dislodged rider going to barrier, rider unharmed. Gave ground quickly from the 500 metres with the rider reporting that the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed no abnormalities.</p> <p><b>JANE AVRIL</b> (C Johnson) – Held up for a short distance rounding the final bend. Rider questioned in regards to the poor performance, advised that the filly had only battled over the concluding stages and in his opinion had not appreciated today's testing track conditions.</p> <p><b>LOOPY</b> (A Morgan) – Began awkwardly and got back as a result.</p> <p><b>MISS SPECIAL</b> (J Morris) – Made the bend awkwardly by the 1300 metres when racing greenly.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>LASER ELECTRICAL TIMARU R85 2100M</b>
<p><b>DELACROIX</b> (C Johnson) – Crowded in the shadows of the post when PRECIOUS PERCY lay inwards under pressure.</p> <p><b>ASTROTURF</b> (H Andrew) – Lay in momentarily passing the 1900 metres and had to be straightened. Raced wide in the early stages. Rider admitted to the breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that she used her whip excessively prior to the 200 metres with the JCA imposing a suspension of her licence from the conclusion of racing 31<sup>st</sup> July up to and including 9<sup>th</sup> August 2017 (3 days).</p> <p><b>SHANTAV</b> (A Collett) – Improved wide from the 900 metres.</p> <p><b>PRECIOUS PERCY</b> (J Morris) – Crowded momentarily passing the 1900 metres when ASTROTURF who was laying in, shifted in. Raced wide from the 1200 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>RACE IMAGES MAIDEN STAYERS 2100M</b>
<p><b>FLAG DUTY</b> (C Barnes) – Under pressure throughout the running and was not persevered with over the final 600 metres eventually finishing a distant last. Trainer reported that the gelding will be now sent for a spell.</p> <p><b>JUSTRUSH</b> (S Wynne) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced early stages.</p> <p><b>BLACK EYED SUSAN</b> (K Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>EYES WIDE SHUT</b> (J Morris) - Raced wide throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>D'CASH &amp; EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES R65 2100M</b>
<p><b>BULLITT</b> (L Callaway) – Rider reported the gelding was not suited by the muddling pace of today's race.</p> <p><b>SKEEN</b> (T Moseley) – Made the first bend awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MOBY</b> (S Wynne) – Raced keenly into the first bend due to the lack of tempo and had to be restrained off heels passing the 1700 metres. Rider reported gelding did not handle today's track conditions.</p> <p><b>SOUTHERN AURORA</b> (T Jonker) – Raced keenly into the first bend and got its head up when being restrained when the pace of the race eased.</p> <p><b>SHEZATOUCHA</b> (T Comignaghi) – Crowded and momentarily steadied racing to the inside of MORGAN BET who was taken</p>	

inwards by **LOCALLY SAUCED** (C Johnson) who shifted in racing into the first bend. C Johnson was warned to exercise greater care.

**DREAM DIVINE** (C Campbell) – Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 1000 metres.

**SWEET TIME** (P Shaikh) – Slow to begin.

**ZANOTTI** (K Williams) – Raced wide for the majority of the event.
