<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MID-WINTER CHRISTMAS RACEMEETING 24 JUNE MAIDEN (1000m)</b>
<p><b>HEAVEN KNOWS</b> (A Collett) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ON POINT</b> (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for a distance in the early stages, held up in the early stages of the home straight obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres. Rider S Wynne reported that the filly was unable to quicken after being held up and in her opinion would take benefit from today's race.</p> <p><b>THREE SHOTS</b> (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly making contact with BOBTAIL.</p> <p><b>BOBTAIL</b> (A Morgan) – Bumped at the start, raced keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres, held up early in the home straight and placed in restricted room near the 350 metres having to steady.</p> <p><b>ELEGIDO</b> (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TWILIGHT METEOR</b> (L Callaway) – Made contact with HOT FUSS passing the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>HOT FUSS</b> (K Williams) – Made contact with TWILIGHT METEOR passing the 100 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>JOIN THE CLUB MEMBERSHIP NOW AVAILABLE OPEN SPRINT (1200m)</b>
<p><b>ENZO'S LAD</b> (C Johnson) – Bounded at the start.</p> <p><b>FIVE KINGS</b> (A Collett) – Jumped in the air at the start.</p>	

<p><b>BONAPARTE</b> (T Jonker) – Jumped away awkwardly, steadied shortly after the start to avoid the heels of DYNAMIC (P Shaikh) which shifted inwards when not fully clear. Apprentice rider P Shaikh was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p><b>FLYTIME</b> (K Williams) – Steadied shortly after the start.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MEMBER'S REWARDS AT RICCARTON PARK R65 BENCHMARK (1200m)</b>
<p><b>WESLEY HALL</b> (A Morgan) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>CANTILENA</b> (S Wynne) – Hampered leaving the barriers when SEAMSTRESS jumped outwards.</p> <p><b>SUGGESTIVE LOOX</b> (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>ZAWHIP</b> (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SEAMSTRESS</b> – Shifted outwards on jumping. Rider K Williams reported that in her opinion the mare would take benefit from today's race.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>SPEIGHT'S MID ALE MAIDEN (1600m)</b>
<p><b>HANS MAYAR</b> (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>PACO RABANNE</b> (L Hemi) – Jumped away awkwardly and then further hampered.</p> <p><b>JUST</b> (A Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding LOUVRES onto ROYAL MISTRESS and PACO RABANNE.</p> <p><b>LOUVRES</b> (R Firdhaus) – Crowded at the start, raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>ROYAL MISTRESS</b> (R Cuneen) – Crowded at the start.</p> <p><b>ESSDEE</b> (C Johnson) – Hampered and steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of TUI passing the 700 metres.</p> <p><b>TUI</b> (R Hannam) – Lay out throughout and gave ground quickly passing the 700 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CHRISTCHURCH CASINO R75 BENCHMARK (2000m)</b>
<p><b>MONTOYA STAR</b> (S Wynne) – Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>CRACKLING ROSIE</b> (R Firdhaus) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres having to steady.</p> <p><b>LADY EM</b> (R Elliot) – Buffeted between runners near the 400 metres.</p> <p><b>MASTER KARSTEN</b> (L Hemi) – Awkwardly placed on heels when in restricted room near the 300 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>GAVELHOUSE.COM R75 BENCHMARK (1400m)</b>
<p><b>ELFEE</b> (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>VERNA AUDREY</b> (G Jogoo) – Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TRAVEL WISE</b> (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>LUKE</b> (K Kwo) – Held up rounding the turn passing the 600 metres and did not obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 350 metres.</p> <p><b>DO UNO WHOIAM</b> (L Callaway) – Steadied to avoid the heels of WHAT'S UP ALF (T Moseley) which shifted outwards passing the 400 metres when not clear. Rider <b>T Moseley</b> was issued with a warning. Rider L Callaway dropped his whip near the 350 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>YESBERG INSURANCE SERVICES CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OPEN MILE (1600m)</b>

**KINGS PAL** (R Hannam) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**ELECTRONIC MOTION** (R Firdhaus) – Lay out throughout the home straight.

**PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE** (A Collett) – When questioned regarding performance, trainer A Carston advised that 1600 metres is the mare's preferred distance and that she was aided by leading uncontested today.

**NIGHT NURSE** (S Wynne) – Poor performance A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

**RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE R65 BENCHMARK (1600m)**

**GLOSS** (A Morgan) – Blundered leaving the barriers.

**MINERVA** (R Firdhaus) – Jumped away awkwardly.

**RAWMATERIAL** (L Hemi) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1400 metres.

**FUGAWI** (T Moseley) – Steadied away from heels near the 1000 metres, raced wide early and middle stages.

**TUILANA** (C Johnson)- Rider reported the filly was unsuited to the heavy track conditions
