Race 1	MID-WINTER CHRISTMAS RACEMEETING 24 JUNE MAIDEN (1000m)		
HEAVEN KNOWS (A Collett) – Slow to begin.			
ON POINT (S Wynne) – Slow to begin, raced keenly for a distance in the early stages, held up in the early stages of the home straight obtaining clear running passing the 250 metres. Rider S Wynne reported that the filly was unable to quicken after being held up and in her opinion would take benefit from today's race.			
THREE SHOTS (G Jogoo) – Began awkwardly making contact with BOBTAIL.			
BOBTAIL (A Morgan) – Bumped at the start, raced keenly for a short distance passing the 800 metres, held up early in the home straight and placed in restricted room near the 350 metres having to steady.			
E LEGIDO (R Cuneen) – Began awkwardly.			
TWILIGHT METEOR (L Callaway) – Made contact with HOT FUSS passing the 100 metres.			
HOT FUSS (K Williams) – Made contact with TWILIGHT METEOR passing the 100 metres.

ENZO'S LAD (C Johnson) – Bounded at the start.			
FIVE KINGS (A Collett) – Jumped in the air at the start.			

BONAPARTE (T Jonker) – Jumped away awkwardly, steadied shortly after the start to avoid the heels of DYNAMIC (P Shaikh) which shifted inwards when not fully clear. Apprentice rider P Shaikh was advised to exercise greater care.

FLYTIME (K Williams) – Steadied shortly after the start.

WESLEY HALL (A Morgan) – Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

CANTILENA (S Wynne) – Hampered leaving the barriers when SEAMSTRESS jumped outwards.

SUGGESTIVE LOOX (R Firdhaus) – Slow to begin.

ZAWHIP (C Johnson) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

SEAMSTRESS – Shifted outwards on jumping.Rider K Williams reported that in her opinion the mare would take benefit from today's race.

Race 4 SPEIGHT'S MID ALE MAIDEN (1600m)

HANS MAYAR (J Lowry) – Slow to begin.

PACO RABANNE (L Hemi) – Jumped away awkwardly and then further hampered.

JUST (A Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly crowding LOUVRES onto ROYAL MISTRESS and PACO RABANNE.

LOUVRES (R Firdhaus) – Crowded at the start, raced three wide without cover throughout.

ROYAL MISTRESS (R Cuneen) – Crowded at the start.

ESSDEE (C Johnson) – Hampered and steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of TUI passing the 700 metres.

TUI (R Hannam) – Lay out throughout and gave ground quickly passing the 700 metres.

Race 5 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO R75 BENCHMARK (2000m)

MONTOYA STAR (S Wynne) - Raced keenly in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

CRACKLING ROSIE (R Firdhaus) - Raced in restricted room passing the 1000 metres having to steady.

LADY EM (R Elliot) – Buffeted between runners near the 400 metres.

MASTER KARSTEN (L Hemi) – Awkwardly placed on heels when in restricted room near the 300 metres.

Race 6 GAVELHOUSE.COM R75 BENCHMARK (1400m)

ELFEE (S Wynne) – Slow to begin.

VERNA AUDREY (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

TRAVEL WISE (R Elliot) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LUKE (K Kwo) – Held up rounding the turn passing the 600 metres and did not obtain clear running until shifting outwards across heels near the 350 metres.

DO UNO WHOIAM (L Callaway) – Steadied to avoid the heels of WHAT'S UP ALF (T Moseley) which shifted outwards passing the 400 metres when not clear. Rider **T Moseley** was issued with a warning. Rider L Callaway dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

Race 7 YESBERG INSURANCE SERVICES CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OPEN MILE (1600m)

KINGS PAL (R Hannam) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ELECTRONIC MOTION (R Firdhaus) – Lay out throughout the home straight.

PRETTY GOOD EXCUSE (A Collett) – When questioned regarding performance, trainer A Carston advised that 1600 metres is the mare's preferred distance and that she was aided by leading uncontested today.

NIGHT NURSE (S Wynne) – Poor performance A post race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE R65 BENCHMARK (1600m)

GLOSS (A Morgan) – Blundered leaving the barriers.

MINERVA (R Firdhaus) – Jumped away awkwardly.

RAWMATERIAL (L Hemi) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained passing the 1400 metres.

FUGAWI (T Moseley) – Steadied away from heels near the 1000 metres, raced wide early and middle stages.

TUILANA (C Johnson)- Rider reported the filly was unsuited to the heavy track conditions
