RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SPEEDWALL NZ LTD 1200	
PARKER'S PIECE (J Nason) – Was slow to begin. Raced wide until near the 600 metres.	

HONEY RIDER (M Coleman) – Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 800 metres when racing keenly.

Race 2 GUINEAS DAY 4TH FEBRUARY 2017 1200

SOVEREIGN PRINCE (T Thornton) – Was slow away, and then hampered by NIKITA which shifted out and away from THELMA with SOVEREIGN PRINCE being steadied losing ground, and NIKITA being steadied. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running until shifting out near the 100 metres.

NIKITA (A Collett) – Had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres when crowded to the inside of THELMA which shifted in when not fully clear. Rider C Lammas was reprimanded and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground. NIKITA then raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.

SUPER ROSIE (M Hills) – Hung out when making the bend near the 900 metres, and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.

MISS DALGHAR (B Hutton) – Commenced to race keenly when being steadied becoming awkwardly placed and making the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres, with MISS DALGHAR then racing wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

DON'T BE CHEEKY (R Elliot) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

THELMA (C Lammas) – Was held up and then when shifting out to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres made contact with MY DAKOTA which became briefly unbalanced. Rider C Lammas was advised to exercise greater care.

MY DAKOTA (C Grylls) – Contacted 200 metres and briefly unbalanced.

Race 3 NEW WORLD TE RAPA 1400

KEEP ON COMING (S Weatherley) – Began a little awkwardly. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres, and when shifting out inconvenienced CARNAVALITO.

VANILLA MOON (C Grylls) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Grylls could offer no tangible excuse. VANILLA MOON underwent a subsequent veterinary examination including endoscopic examination, which found increased mucous in the trachea, and a slower than normal recovery rate. VANILLA MOON lost the right hind plate during the running.

CARNAVALITO (A Sims) – Inconvenienced 200 metres, briefly steadied passing the 50 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

ASTRID (O Bosson) – Lost the near hind plate during the running.

Race 4 LADIES & CO LOUNGE 11TH FEBRUARY 2017 1400

MR LUV (V Gatu) – Was slow to begin.

SAILING (T Thornton) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced 400 metres.

JUSTACANTA (M Coleman) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres inconveniencing SAILING. M Coleman was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 5 WAIKATO RACING SUPPORTING TRUE COLOURS CHARITABLE TRUST 1600

FASHIONABLY (O Bosson) – Blundered jumping away. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

PIERIAN SPRING (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

GREYWACKE (M McNab) – Was held up rounding the final turn. When questioned regarding performance rider M McNab could offer no excuse other than he thought the gelding may have held its breath. GREYWACKE underwent a veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a delayed recovery.

ROCKING GOOD TIME (B Hutton) – Was held up rounding the final turn obtaining clear running near the 300 metres, and then again briefly held up passing the 150 metres.

KEEPER GIRL (M Cameron) – Was crowded to the inside of FASHIONABLY (O Bosson) passing the 200 metres with KEEPER GIRL being briefly steadied. Rider O Bosson was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

Race 6 STYLE COUNSEL 1600

SO BRAZEN (D Johnson) – Was a late scratching at 3.23 pm at the start, on veterinary advice when the mare was observed to have blood in the left nostril.

MAGIC CHAI (O Bosson) – Jumped away awkwardly. Briefly crowded 300 metres.

ROSE SAUVAGE (M Du Plessis) – Jumped away awkwardly.

BLACKMAGICWOMAN (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early to middle stages when being challenged for the lead.

ROSE SAUVAGE (M Du Plessis) – Was held up rounding the final turn.

SNEAKYSID (G Cooksley) – Was held up rounding the final turn shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres with MAGIC CHAI shifting away from that runner briefly crowding THOUGHTFUL.

THOUGHTFUL (T Thornton) – Crowded 300 metres.

SACRE COEUR (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 UNITED CLEANING 2100

HEEZNOT (A Collett) – Jumped away awkwardly, and then was crowded losing ground.

YAMATO NADESHIKO (D Johnson) – Was slow to begin.

GUMBOOTS (H Marzuki) – Blundered jumping away, and raced wide throughout.

VITESSE (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly. Was crowded and hampered passing the 1800 metres between EKAROSA which made the bend awkwardly and shifted out, and LUSTROUS (C Lammas) which lay in when making the bend before being corrected by its rider. Rider C Lammas was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

MISTRAHMA (S Spratt) – Raced in restricted room passing the 1800 metres to the inside of OCEAN BOUND which was taken in by GUMBOOTS.

AMPARO (A Jones) – Over-raced in the early stages.

EKAROSA (S Collett) – Made the bend awkwardly 1800 metres, then raced in restricted room.

CIVIQUE ROSE (S McKay) – Began awkwardly. Was briefly held up passing the 250 metres.

ASTON PARK (M McNab) – Raced keenly in the early stages.
