RACE COMMENTS:

 Race 1
 WENTWOOD GRANGE JUVENILE

 SAVELLE (L Innes) – Began awkwardly losing ground, and then commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied near the 800 metres and shifted out when hanging forcing GOLD FEVER to race wide without cover. SAVELLE continued to hang outwards when making the final bend, and could not be ridden to full advantage in the final straight due to its wayward tendencies. Rider L Innes advised the filly had hung badly and proved difficult to ride throughout.

GOLD FEVER (C Lammas) - Raced wide without cover. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

SHEZALLPOWER (S Spratt) – Was crowded and hampered passing the 175 metres to the inside of LAVISH which ducked in and away from GOLD FEVER which had a tendency to lay in under pressure.

Race 2 LANGSFORD – N & G LTD 1200

DRAGON KINGDOM (M Hills) – Was a late scratching at 12.57 pm after rearing and dislodging rider M Hills when parading. M Hills was stood down, and then was cleared to fulfil his remaining engagements.

VIA EST VERITAS (A Schwerin) – Was slow to begin.

MISTER POSTMAN (B R Jones) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

LA CASONA (L Innes) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Lay in under pressure final straight.

INSCRIPTION (V Gatu) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Shied at the crossing when pulling up dislodging rider V Gatu. V Gatu was examined and cleared to fulfil her remaining riding engagements.

DURANGO (S Collett) – Raced wide until working forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 600 metres.

SANTA MONICA (R Elliot) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 375 metres, and soon after made contact with ROSA STELLA which became unbalanced. Shortly after LA CASONA shifted in under pressure crowding ROSA STELLA on to SANTA MONICA which was steadied losing ground. Contributing was outward movement from DURANGO. L Innes was issued with a warning.

ROSA STELLA (J Nason) – Bumped and unbalanced 350 metres. ROSA STELLA was contacted by a riderless horse on pulling up dislodging rider J Nason who was uninjured.

WELLETSDOIT (V Colgan) – Shifted out passing the 350 metres to obtain clear running making contact with INSCRIPTION.

ESSENCE OF COOL (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Shied on pulling up dislodging rider A Jones who was uninjured.

AMBITIOUS GLORY (O Bosson) – Shied away from the riderless ESSENCE OF COOL on pulling up dislodging rider O Bosson who was uninjured.

Race 3 RANDAL JUDD MEMORIAL 1200

KONINGIN (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly. KONINGIN became awkwardly placed on heels near the 450 metres, and then was hampered.

ROCKABYEBABY (R Myers) – Was slow to begin.

SHE BRINGS JOY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly, and then was restrained.

NIKITA (T Thornton) – Raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 900 metres.

O'PRINCESS (A Schwerin) – Made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres, and then raced wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

ADMIRE (S Spratt) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

ORAKEI OVERLORD (K McCulloch) – Was slow to begin.

COTE D'OR (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly, and then was hampered losing ground. Had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 900 metres.

BIG MIKE (E Farr) – Crowded shortly after start, losing ground. Shifted out when becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 850 metres dictating KING'S LANDING over extra ground.

KING'S LANDING (S Collett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MY ALAYNE (R Myers) – Crowded soon after start, losing ground.

TIPICAL (V Colgan) – Raced keenly when being steadied in the early to middle stages.

FEISTY JANE (C Grylls) – Was crowded and hampered passing the 300 metres.

UPANDGO (S Spratt) – Crowded and hampered 300 metres.

L Innes admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount KEELY BE to shift in when not clear of FEISTY JANE which was hampered losing ground, and shifted in on to UPANDGO which was also hampered losing ground. L Innes was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 27 November up to and including racing on 9 December, 4 riding days.

Race 5 SPRAYLINK WEED SPRAYING 1600

DECADES (O Bosson) – Was hampered soon after leaving the barrier by MR BIG which shifted out abruptly.

MR BIG (C Dell) – Raced ungenerously near the 1350 metres when being steadied.

NICOLETTA (D Johnson) – Was hampered passing the 1300 metres by MYSTERY MAN which shifted out abruptly when contacted by PLUTONIUM which lay away from the running rail. Raced wide without cover throughout.

MADAM MONICA (C Lammas) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

Race 6 PORRITT SAND 1600

DUKE STREET (B R Jones) – Was slow to begin.

RED RAVEN (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly.

CENTILLY (D Johnson) – Began awkwardly.

MODEL AYE (O Bosson) – Raced ungenerously when being steadied for a distance approaching the 1400 metres.

ZUMA (K McCulloch) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Forced wide 375 metres.

PUSHTHEBOUNDARIES (V Gatu) – Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 375 metres inconveniencing ZUMA, KEEP UP and NABIAC which were all forced wider on the track. Rider V Gatu was issued with a warning. When questioned into the improved performance trainer L Somervell advised that he believes the mare prefers the left-handed way of going, and had been confident of an improved performance as the mare had worked well leading into today's race.

KEEP UP (V Colgan) – Forced wide 375 metres.

NABIAC (C Grylls) – Forced wide 375 metres.

Race 7 STABLECRAFT 1200

WIMBLEDON (S Collett) – Crowded leaving the barrier, losing ground.

VITESSE (S Weatherley) – Crowded leaving the barrier, losing ground.

CABARET (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

HONKIETONK TIGER (V Gatu) – Was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier. Hung outwards throughout, and raced ungenerously passing the 600 metres. Lost the left front plate during the running.

SCOOTER O'REILLY (C Lammas) – Commenced to over-race when being steadied becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 900 metres making the bend awkwardly forcing STRAIGHT SETS wider on the track. STRAIGHT SETS was then obliged to race wide without cover.

STRAIGHT SETS (T Thornton) Forced wider on the track 900 metres. Was then obliged to race wide without cover.

Race 8 MONOVALE SAND 1600

IVY'S GOLD (H Marzuki) – Made contact with PHOEBE SNOW passing the 1400 metres with IVY'S GOLD becoming briefly unbalanced.

VON TUNZELMAN (L Innes) – Was hampered passing the 1300 metres by CIVIQUE ROSE which ducked out. VON TUNZELMAN was again hampered approaching the 1200 metres by PHOEBE SNOW which shifted out abruptly to avoid heels. VON TUNZELMAN raced wide from near the 700 metres. Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

CIVIQUE ROSE (T Thornton) – Had to be firmly restrained when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of PHOEBE SNOW which was steadied near the 1300 metres with CIVIQUE ROSE over-racing for a distance. Shifted out passing the 200 metres inconveniencing SURE ENOUGH.

PHOEBE SNOW (K McCulloch) – Steadied and shifted out 1300 metres.

SURE ENOUGH (V Colgan) – Inconvenienced 200 metres.
