Trainer L Anderson reported that SALLY LUNN had undergone surgery to remove bone chips from the knees since last racing on 14 October 2016.

SUPPLEMENTARY:

<u>Taumarunui RC - 29 July 2017</u> Race 1 - FORGOTTEN WORLD ADVENTURES HDL (3000 metres) CULLISTER (C Studd) – Trainer G Temperton advised Stewards that she was satisfied with the recovery of the mare, and it is her intention to continue on with its current preparation.
<u>Levin Racing Club - 31 July 2017</u> Race 5 - B.S YOUNG HANDICAP (2100 metres) YAMATO NADESHIKO (L Allpress) – Trainer H Mathews advised Stewards that the mare had recovered well other than finding a minor laceration in its mouth. It is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CLASSIC CUISINE 1200
UTWO TIME (H Marzuki) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	

DETERMINATION (A Collett) – When questioned regarding performance rider A Collett could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 2 | **WAIKATO BRANCH NZ FARRIERS ASSOCIATION 1200**

SAIGNON (A Jones) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

TRANKY DOO (A Collett) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

THISTLEDONICELY (H Marzuki) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

SMOOCHY (J Nason) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

BUFFALO LASS (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly shifting out hampering MO CHARA.

MO CHARA (S Weatherley) – Hampered start. Apprentice Rider S Weatherley could offer no tangible excuse for the mare's performance.

RICH BILLIE MARSH (D Bradley) – When questioned regarding the performance Rider D Bradley advised the mare had not been suited when taken on in the early to middle stages, and had raced keener than normal as a result.

Race 3 | **DAVCO 1200**

KITTYKITTYBANGBANG (A Collett) – Slow away.

BARBARA'S CHOICE (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with MAR TENE. Raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 900 metres. When questioned regarding the performance Rider V Colgan advised the mare had travelled comfortably in the early middle stages but had been unable to quicken when placed under pressure in the final straight due to the existing track conditions.

MAR TENE (M Cameron) – Bumped shortly after start. Was not persevered with over the final 150 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider M Cameron was unable to offer any excuses advising that the mare had travelled well, but had been quickly beaten once placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary inspection found the mare to be lame in the left hind leg with MAR TENE now requiring a veterinary clearance prior to racing next.

Race 4 | **MARKS EWEN AND ASSOCIATES 1600**

ROCKING GOOD TIME (T Harris) – Stumbled leaving the barrier losing ground.

ROYAL REBEL (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Crowded approaching the 600 metres to the inside of DON'T LIE TO ME which lay in when placed under pressure. Became briefly unbalanced when making contact with LA ACHIEVER passing the 300 metres.

LA ACHIEVER (A Jones) – Briefly unbalanced 300 metres when making contact.

SLY DOG STUD (J Riddell) – Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Trainer of LEICA LADY **F Ritchie** was reminded of his obligations in that Blinkers must not be removed until the horse has returned to the stabling area.

Race 5 | **ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP 1400**

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (C Lammas) – Hampered start. Made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres, and raced ungenerously for a short distance losing ground.

MOET MOLLY (M Cameron) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

RASPBERRY SWEET (V Colgan) – Inconvenienced approaching the 500 metres to the inside of ALAMOSEE which was commencing to give ground.

KOOL CONNECTION (M McNab) – Had to briefly steady approaching the 400 metres when improving on to heels.

Race 6

TILEMAX 1400

CLAPATHUNDA (J Nason) – Began awkwardly then placed in restricted room for a short distance. Lost the right hind plate during the running.

NO NEED (T Harris) – Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.

BEYOND REACH (S Weatherley) – Crowded and unbalanced start. Briefly crowded when weakening passing the 400 metres.

LEICA WARRIOR (H Marzuki) – Made contact with LUPELANI passing the 400 metres becoming briefly unbalanced. Was briefly crowded to the outside of COLLAY which shifted out passing the 150 metres, then becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

CAMEAHOTFRIDAY (V Colgan) – Held up for a distance from near the 300 metres.

A Collett (LUPELANI) – Reprimanded for using her whip outside the guidelines prior to the 100 metres and further advised a warning would be placed on her record.

M Cameron (COLLAY) – Reprimanded for using his whip outside the guidelines prior to the 100 metres and further advised a warning would be placed on his record.

Race 7

CAPITAL TRACTORS 2100

SHEEZ THE BOSS (A Jones) – Crowded start and briefly unbalanced. Steadied passing the 1900 metres when briefly crowded to the inside of DOUCETTE (S Spratt) which shifted in when not fully clear. **S Spratt** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised to exercise greater care.

ESKIMO KISS (A Collett) – Began awkwardly.

KINGSGRAVE (T Harris) – T Harris was severely reprimanded and reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his horses out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.
