<u>Wanganui Jockey Club - 27 July 2017</u> Race 3 - WANGANUI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION OPEN HURDLE 3000m KINGS DEEP (S Phelan) – Trainer P Nelson advised Stewards that the gelding underwent blood tests following its performance in this race which did not reveal any abnormality and that it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.
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RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	COCKTAIL FUNCTION FT GREG MILES 18TH AUGUST 1100
<p>COMPADRE (M McNab) – Dislodged rider M McNab leaving the parade enclosure and galloped a distance. After being recaptured COMPADRE underwent a veterinary examination and was declared fit to race. Trainer L Collins was advised a warning would be placed on the gelding.</p> <p>DE KONING (L Satherley) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>SHORT FUSE (J Parkes) – Held up approaching the 400 metres. Improved into a marginal run approaching the 300 metres to the inside of MALAMBO who shifting in slightly with SHORT FUSE then steadying and shifting to the outside of MALAMBO to obtain clear running forcing SOCIALLY EXCITED wider on the track.</p> <p>Prior to the authorization of dividends the connections of the 2nd placed horse SHORT FUSE wished to observe Stewards footage alleging interference by the 1st placed horse MALAMBO electing not to proceed with a protest.</p>	
Race 2	LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES 2100
<p>ROUGH CUT (H Marzuki) – Slow to begin. Apprentice rider H Marzuki was advised that he must ride his horses out fully to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.</p> <p>STOKERS ROCK (S Spratt) – Dictated wider passing the 1600 metres by HE'S DAN which shifted out off heels with STOKERS ROCK then racing wide without cover until improving forward to sit outside the leader approaching the 1200 metres.</p> <p>KIPKEINO (A Jones) – Raced wide without cover from near the 1400 metres. Crowded and checked passing the 50 metres between IN A MINUTE which shifted in slightly under pressure and LIGHT EM UP which shifted out when improving on to the heels of HE'S DAN which had shifted out slightly under pressure.</p> <p>BEE TEE JUNIOR (T Harris) – Held up rounding the final turn shifting out to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>S Spratt (STOKERS ROCK) – Reprimanded regarding her use of the whip prior to the final 100 metres, being further advised that a warning would be placed on her record.</p> <p>J Nason (HE'S DAN) – Reprimanded regarding his use of the whip prior to the final 100 metres, being further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.</p>	
Race 3	PATHWAYS THE IMMIGRATION SPECIALISTS 1400
<p>BIG DREAMER (H Marzuki) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MERITAGGIO (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>REDEFINE (J Parkes) – Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding the performance rider J Parkes advised the gelding had travelled keenly in the early and middle stages and was unable to obtain cover which had been detrimental to the gelding's chances.</p> <p>ZORRALI (T Wenn) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Inconvenienced approaching the 150 metres to the inside of BIG DREAMER (H Marzuki) which shifted in under pressure. Rider H Marzuki was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care.</p> <p>ALAMER (M Coleman) – Got its head up when being steadied approaching the 1100 metres, and continued to race ungenerously through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>KITAYA (A Collett) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied when improving on to heels approaching the 200 metres, and then continued to be held up for a distance.</p>	

WOLFF SPIRIT (A Jones) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres.

H Marzuki (BIG DREAMER) – Reprimanded by Stewards for shaking hands prior to weighing-in.

Race 4 | **BECOME A MEMBER OF THE WAIKATO RACING CLUB 1200**

I PACO (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be further restrained off heels approaching the 900 metres.

WAY IN (M Cameron) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

NAADIRR (L Innes) – Commenced to lay in abruptly passing the 350 metres with DANGER DEE (B R Jones) then shifting out crowding NAADIRR which was hampered. Notwithstanding the racing manners of NAADIRR rider **B R Jones** was advised he must be fully clear when shifting ground, and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record. NAADIRR continued to hang for the remainder of the race. NAADIRR faltered shortly after passing the winning post and was quickly attend to by the veterinarians. After been found to have fractured the left fore fetlock NAADIRR was humanely euthanased.

EEPA NEEMA (J Parkes) – Inconvenienced 150 metres to the inside of ALVINS DREAM (T Harris) which shifted in. T Harris was advised that he must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

ALVINS DREAM (T Harris) – Shifted in approaching the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

Race 5 | **DISTINCTION HAMILTON HOTEL 1200**

BRILLIANT SHINE (V Colgan) – Commenced to race fiercely passing the 1000 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of VOLPE VELOCE (J Parkes) which shifted in when not fully clear with BRILLIANT SHINE then forcing IL CAVALLO wider on the track. Notwithstanding the racing manners of BRILLIANT SHINE rider **J Parkes** was issued with a warning and advised he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground. BRILLIANT SHINE then continuing to race fiercely for a distance. Bumped and unbalanced passing the 375 metres by BIGGIN HILL (A Collett) which shifted out. A Collett was reprimanded and advised she must exercise greater care.

IL CAVALLO (M Coleman) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Forced wide 900 metres, and then over-raced middle stages.

SILVERDALE (M McNab) – Co-trainer S Autridge reported that the gelding had bled when returning to the tie-up stalls which was confirmed after undergoing a veterinary examination. SILVERDALE is now ineligible to race in New Zealand as it is the gelding's second such occurrence.

Race 6 | **GARY'S 50TH BIRTHDAY 1600**

REILLY CENTRAL (H Marzuki) – Slow to begin.

AVANT (M Coleman) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

SILVER SASANOF (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.

TAAZMAN (B R Jones) – Raced in restricted room passing the 700 metres when improving to the outside of NO LOITERING which shifted out slightly when over racing with TAAZMAN then having to steady.

KANE (S McKay) – Became awkwardly placed inside heels for a distance passing the 400 metres then shifted in to obtain clear running.

NO LOITERING (J Fawcett) – Held up for clear running until improving into a run passing the 250 metres.

Race 7	LODGE REAL ESTATE 1600
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ALI BABA (B R Jones) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

POKER FACE (V Colgan) – Slow to begin.

LORD SNOW (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.

PRODIGAL SON (J Parkes) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Inconvenienced 50 metres.

QUANTUM (H Marzuki) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Had difficulty obtaining clear running until inside the final 200 metres. Crowded and checked over the concluding stages when **MASTERCARD** (M McNab) shifted in when not sufficiently clear. Rider **M McNab** admitted a resultant breach of careless riding with his licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing today up to and including 18 August. (5 riding days)

MASTERCARD (M McNab) – Commenced to race keenly and shifted out off heels passing the 1000 metres making contact with **SACRED SIREN** which was forced wider on the track. Shifted in abruptly under pressure over the final 50 metres inconveniencing **PRODIGAL SON** and then crowding and checking **QUANTUM**.

HIGH CLASS (A Collett) – Hampered passing the 100 metres to the inside of **THE KIPLING GIRL** which became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **WAIPIPI LAD** (S Spratt) which shifted in under pressure. Rider S Spratt was advised that she must exercise greater care. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Collett was of the opinion that the mare would prefer more rain affected footing.

Race 8	CUP DAY PACKAGES 16TH DEC ON SALE 2100
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NOTHING TRIVIAL (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly.

MASTER POET (B R Jones) – Slow to begin.

KOKANEE GOLD (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer J McGrath advised that the win had not been expected.

FREEWHEELER (C Dell) – Rider C Dell reported that the gelding had hung throughout.

CIVIQUE ROSE (S Spratt) – Crowded and steadied approaching the 400 metres when racing in restricted room to the outside of **FREEWHEELER** which was taken out slightly by **BEAUFIGHTER** which shifted ground when placed under pressure. H Marzuki was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.
