RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ECOLAB MAIDEN 2100M
VENERATE (T Johnson) – Refused to leave the barrier on jumping away losing all chance. Connections were advised the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of Stewards. Trainer H Wilson advised that he would make adjustments to the gelding's gear prior to its next start.	
Race 2	CHILLCO MAIDEN 1200M
CHRISTINE ANN (S MacNab) – Slow away. MAGICELLA (S McKay) – Raced ungenerously passing the 800 metres making the bend awkwardly. Hung throughout. Connections advised the mare would spell. PRETTY LIPPY (D Turner) – Hung throughout.	
Race 3	NORWOODS FARM MACHINERY MAIDEN 1600M

CARAJEAN (T Johnson) – Slow away.

LONGBEACH LUCY (R Myers) – Tightened at the start and got back.

MRS ME (A Chan) – Shifted out abruptly at the start dictating DEEDEE’S BELT outwards into the line of LONGBEACH LUCY which was tightened and got back.

DEEDEE’S BELT (L Allpress) – Dictated outwards at the start by MRS ME.

Race 4 UHLENBERG HAULAGE MAIDEN 1400M

PATRICIA ROSE (L Hemi) – Began awkwardly.

AVE MARIA (R Myers) – Slow away.

DIEHARD (S Weatherley) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight.

SEASTAR (L Allpress) – Lay out under pressure in the home straight and made contact with DIEHARD near the 150 metres.

Prior to the authorisation of dividends **S Weatherley** (DIEHARD) placed 2nd lodged an objection against the winner SEASTAR (L Allpress) alleging interference in the home straight. After hearing evidence the JCA dismissed the protest.

SUFFICIENT FUNDS (T Miles) – Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

KEEP DANCING (S McKay) – Was not persevered with in the home straight when S McKay considered something amiss with the mare. A subsequent veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections undertook to monitor the progress of KEEP DANCING over coming days.

Race 5 HEATHER & SHIRLEY SUPPORTS THE R BLACK MEMORIAL 1400M

TARA TOA (L Hemi) – Bounded at the start losing ground.

MISS LIZZIE (M McNelis) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

PHILIPA CHARLOTTE (T Johnson) – Dictated wider on the track when DALS DELIGHT improved to its inside passing the 700 metres.

S McKay (TERRACOTTA WARRIOR) – Reported the gelding was unsuited to the going underfoot

Race 6 TARANAKI STEELFORMERS LTD 1400M

GLADSTONE BELLE (J Parkes) – Raced keenly in the early stages. Hampered rounding the turn when BATTLE CREEK shifted out.

BATABULLET (S MacNab) – Raced keenly when in restricted room passing the 1000 metres.

BATTLE CREEK (L Allpress) – Lay out rounding the turn and briefly made contact with GLADSTONE BELLE.

RED RASCAL (D Turner) – Lay out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 7 ENERGY CITY MOTORS HAWERA OPEN HANDICAP 2100M

HARE BAWL (D Bradley) – Slow away. D Bradley had no excuse for its disappointing run.

ARZAK (L Allpress) – Contacted when ITSALLABELT shifted outwards passing the 600 metres.

RICH HILL STUD TARANAKI BREEDERS STAKES 2100M

BIGREDMOON (A Chan) – Awkwardly away, was then ridden vigorously to lead.

HARD TO BE HUMBLE (M Tanaka) – Was obliged to run wide rounding the turn.
