Race 1	Mount Shop 1600
BOWIE (M Cameron) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.	
PACQUIAO (R Elliot) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.	

H Marzuki (ADMIRAL) – Reprimanded by Stewards after using his whip in an excessive manner and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.	
Race 2	Ssangyong 2100
<p>OLD COUNTESS (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>MUELED (L Satherley) – Slow to begin (5L).</p> <p>DORA MAAR (D Prastiyou) – Commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages and then crowded passing the 1850 metres to the inside of TAMA AKARANA which initially shifted in and away from GOD OF HERBS (L Innes) with TAMA AKARANA then being crowded and steadied when GOD OF HERBS shifted in further. L Innes was reprimanded by Stewards and advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground and further advised that a warning would be placed on his record.</p> <p>TAMA AKARANA (S McKay) – Crowded 1850 metres and steadied.</p> <p>BARB DWYER (H Marzuki) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p>	
Race 3	Fasttrack Insurance 2100
<p>SO TRUE (S Spratt) – Slow to begin (10L). The connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's barrier manners. Trainer K Fursdon advised that she would take further steps to try and improve the mare's barrier manners.</p> <p>EL LUCHADOR (T Harris) – Held up until passing the 400 metres.</p>	
Race 4	Wharfe Bros 1200
<p>CRAFTY JESS (H Marzuki) – Knuckled shortly after the start when contacted by MIGHTY ME. Became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 900 metres and shifted out when making the bend forcing FORTUNE PATCH wider on the track. Made contact with the hind quarters of FORTUNE PATCH passing the 600 metres with FORTUNE PATCH then shifting in slightly and becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>FORTUNE PATCH (S Weatherley) – Forced wide 900 metres.</p> <p>RESURRECT (M Cameron) – Got its head up in the early stages when being steadied making the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.</p> <p>IT'S A KINDA MAGIC (A Collett) – Steadied when in restricted room passing the 800 metres to the inside of SUMMER DALE (T Allan) which was taken in by LADY PINOT (C Lammas) which lay in. Riders T Allan and C Lammas were advised they must exercise greater care in a similar circumstance.</p> <p>MIGHTY ME (S Spratt) – Shifted in over the concluding stages making contact with IT'S A KINDA MAGIC.</p> <p>AZ GIVEN (T Harris) - When questioned regarding the performance T Harris advised that he had not received the best run after drawing wide and in his opinion had finished the race off well considering he was not in the best part of the track.</p>	
Race 5	Haunui Farm 1400
<p>LORD BUFFALO (A Collett) – Presented to race with incorrect gear. Trainer B Cook was reprimanded and advised that a warning would be placed on his record. Slow to begin. Briefly crowded passing the 150 metres to the inside of MASKOBI PEARL which shifted in under pressure.</p> <p>MR BIG (R Scott) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p>MASKOBI PEARL (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

CAMEO (H Marzuki) – Became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 700 metres.

TREADSTONE (T Harris) – Crowded when weakening passing the 300 metres to the outside of CAMEO which was forced out by LIZ'S GIFT (A Jones). **A Jones** was reprimanded by Stewards and advised that a warning would be placed on her record.

KAMIKAZE REBEL (C Lammas) – Over-raced in the early stages.

MAQUIS (M Du Plessis) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

CALL ME BOB (J Fawcett) – Lost the left front plate during the running.
