RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	LANDMARK VETS MDN HURDLE
THE ARABIAN DUKE (R Cole) - Rider R Cole was unable to claim down to his riding weight and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. R Cole was permitted to ride THE ARABIAN DUKE as there was no other suitable rider available.	

ALL ZEDIN DONE (S Karnicnik) – Put in a poor jump at the first fence. Steadied when awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 1000 metres. Jumped the last three fences poorly.

IZZANORANGE (C Studd) – Pulled up prior to jumping the last three fences. Rider C Studd advised Stewards that he felt the mare was lame. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be mildly lame in the right foreleg.

JEM RUNNER (W Gordon) – When questioned regarding performance rider W Gordon advised Stewards that the mare had jumped indifferently throughout, and in his opinion would derive benefit from today's performance.

HESALLJAZZ (J Seivwright) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1400 metres. Hit the last fence.

CRACKTHEGOODSTUFF (D Turner) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.

OUR DEBUTANTE (H McNeill) – Hit the fence near the 1900 metres landing awkwardly.

Race 2 | **TOTAL STORAGE OPEN HURDLE**

SINO HEIGHTS (C Studd) – Retired from the race after jumping the second fence. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality. When questioned rider C Studd advised the saddle had shifted forward when jumping the first fence on landing, and after jumping the second fence he restrained the gelding in an attempt to get SINO HEIGHTS to relax with the saddle shifting forward further, he then elected to retire SINO HEIGHTS from the race. C Studd's explanation was noted by Stewards.

WHO CAN TELL (S Karnicnik) – Hit the fence near the 1300 metres.

D'LLARO (W Gordon) – Was inclined to run down its fences.

FAST CATCH (A Kuru) – Inconvenienced when LAEKEEPER shifted out under pressure near the 300 metres.

LAEKEEPER (S Phelan) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.

Race 3 | **FLAIR AMATEUR RIDERS SERIES 1600**

INTO THE MYSTIC (L Calitz) – Began very awkwardly unbalancing rider L Calitz with INTO THE MYSTIC losing ground. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

CLAPATHUNDA (J McIlroy) – Began awkwardly. Commenced to race ungenerously passing the 1300 metres and was crowded when SAVASAVA (B Rogerson) shifted in. B Rogerson was advised to exercise greater care. **J McIlroy** was issued with a warning for using the whip in an unnecessary manner in the final straight.

SAVASAVA (B Rogerson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Lay in passing the 1300 metres crowding CLAPATHUNDA which commenced to race ungenerously when being restrained.

DUNGDADUNG (K Asano) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1500 metres.

OEEE (G Crowe) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

Race 4 | **TOTAL STORAGE MDN STEEPLECHASE**

ROOF OF RECKONING (H McNeill) – Slow to begin.

RUNNY HONEY (A Kuru) – Jumped the second fence awkwardly. Misjudged the fence near the 1300 metres landing awkwardly. Blundered on landing and fell after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres dislodging rider A Kuru with

the trailing WILBUR (D Turner) unable to avoid the fallen runner and being brought down as a result. Rider A Kuru and RUNNY HONEY were uninjured.

WILBUR (D Turner) – Brought down after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres fracturing its off front elbow and was humanely euthanased. Rider D Turner was stood down from his remaining ride in race 5. D Turner was transported to hospital for further observation. D Turner is now required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding next.

JUST GOT HOME (E Farr) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

WEST END (J Seivwright) – Made contact with the running rail near the 750 metres.

THAT'S HOW IT GOES (W Gordon) – Landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.

Race 5

LANDMARK VETS OPEN STEEPLECHASE

THE FOX – (H McNeill) – Rider D Turner was stood down and replaced by H McNeill after feeling unwell. Pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a minor laceration in the right nostril.

NELLS BELLE (E Farr) – Put in a poor jump at the third fence landing awkwardly. Landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 1200 metres. Pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a minor laceration on the fetlock and pastern of the right hind leg, and a swollen fetlock on the left foreleg. Trainer N O'Dowd was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

FAIR SCRIPT (S Phelan) – Jumped indifferently throughout, and was retired from the event prior to jumping the fence near the 1300 metres. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

BIG BROWNIE (S Karnicnik) – Dislodged rider S Karnicnik after jumping the fence near the 1750 metres. Rider S Karnicnik was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to be mildly lame in the left hind leg, with trainer Mrs A Browne being advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing next.

ISTIMAGIC (C Studd) – Dipped on landing after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres.

JUST ISHI (M Roustoby) – Pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

NGATIRA GOLD (A Kuru) – Hit the final fence.

MR KANTON (W Gordon) – Fell after jumping the final fence dislodging rider W Gordon, both horse and rider were uninjured.

THENAMESBOND (J Seivwright) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 6

PETER MARQUAND 60TH BIRTHDAY 1400

GANGSTERS LASS (S Collett) – Slow to begin. Lay in approaching the 100 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of I'M BRONSON.

BLACKJACK MAN (D Prastiyou) – Crowded leaving the barrier.

SMOOCHY (J Nason) – Crowded and hampered leaving the barrier losing ground. Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

SUGGESTIVE HEIGHTS (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

ELEGANT LAD (S McKay) – Raced in restricted room for a distance approaching the 900 metres to the inside of CLASSIC WARRIOR (J Riddell) which had commenced to over-race and improve to the inside of GUMBOOTS which was dictated in slightly by I'M BRONSON (B Jones). Riders B Jones was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

SHE'S FLOSSIE (A Jones) – Steadied when placed in restricted room entering the final straight.

Race 7

MORRINSVILLE RSA PLATE

DIAMOND HEIST (T Miles) – Slow to begin.

INCA WARRIOR (A Collett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWITCH PITCHER (S Collett) – Raced keenly in the early stages having to be firmly restrained off heels approaching the 1000 metres when ALL OF THE LIGHTS (J Nason) shifted in when not fully clear. J Nason was advised to exercise greater care.

FLYING NIENTES (J Fawcett) – Inconvenienced and forced wider passing the 350 metres by MISS CAMPBELL which shifted out abruptly when being struck with the whip.

SHAHANA (T Wenn) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 200 metres before being straightened by its rider. SHAHANA then continued to shift outwards inconveniencing PACOTAINE near the 100 metres, and again inconvenienced PACOTAINE when shifting back in near the 50 metres.

PACOTAINE (S McKay) – Inconvenienced near the 100 metres and 50 metres being held up over the concluding stages.

THREADTHENEEDLE (D Johnson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider D Johnson could not offer any tangible excuse for the mare's performance. A Post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.
