VINSANITY (S McKay) – Inclined to over-race when being restrained in the early stages, and raced three wide without cover throughout.

SOBRALIA (M Coleman) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

ABOVE ALL (J Fawcett) – Was inclined to lay in when struck with the whip in the final straight.

Race 2

THE OAKS STUD 1300

SAIGNON (R Elliot) – Slow to begin. Held up behind the weakening PORCELAIN PRINCESS rounding the turn from the 400 metres, and did not obtain clear running until passing the 250 metres.

TARDY CHARDY (C Lammas) – Raced three wide without cover.

WORLDCLASS (S Spratt) – Raced wide without cover.

ENJOY THE RIDE (A Collett) – Had to be checked to avoid the heels of the weakening TARDY CHARDY near the 400 metres.

KEEP UP (S Collett) – Held up near the 450 metres until near the 300 metres.

LILY GRECIA (D Johnson) – Rider was unable to offer any excuses for poor performance.

S Spratt – Spoken to regarding her whip use in the final straight.

V Colgan – Spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.

Race 3

THE CAMBRIDGE STUD 1200

FONTELINA (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

THE MITIGATOR (S McKay) – Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up.

VERBALIZER (T Harris) – Hampered when crowded at the start between OUR ROSE ROYAL and TODALOO which both jumped away awkwardly. Made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly. Shifted out 300 meters to obtain clear running.

THELMA (R Elliot) – Jumped in the air at the start hampering CAUGHT THE EYE. Made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly having to be checked when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of CAUGHT THE EYE.

POUR ME MORE (C Johnson) – Raced ungenerously when being restrained making the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly, and continued to race ungenerously for a distance.

OUR ROSE ROYAL (A Jones) – Made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly.

CAUGHT THE EYE (A Collett) –Hampered on jumping away. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of VERBALIZER which shifted out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres. Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. After undergoing a veterinary examination was confirmed to have bled and is stood down from training for 2 months and racing for 3 months. Will require a veterinary clearance prior to trialing or racing next.

T Harris – Was issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of CAUGHT THE EYE which had to be steadied.

C Lammas - Spoken to regarding his whip use in the final straight.

Race 4 | **MARKS EWEN & ASSOCIATES 1200**

STACCATO (R Elliot) – Jumped away awkwardly making contact with WIMBLEDON which was forced on to CITY BOY.

WIMBLEDON (S Collett) – Bumped start.

CITY BOY (A Collett) – Bumped start. Rider was of the opinion that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions which she described as being shifty.

TEMPLE TIGER (J Fawcett) – Jumped away awkwardly.

SHERPA (M Hills) – Raced three wide without cover.

SELLWOOD (H Marzuki) – Was inclined to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 5 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE**

BELLE DU NORD (L Allpress) – Slow to begin.

L Allpress – Issued with a warning for excessive use of the whip.

Race 6 | **TIVACI @ WAIKATO STUD 1000**

JET CHARGED (H Marzuki) – Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up losing ground.

CHESTER CARLSON (C Johnson) – Slow away.

LIVIN' ON A PRAYER (A Collett) – Slow away, then being further hampered when LADY SHABEEL shifted outwards.

MOSSOMAK (R Elliot) – Rider reported that the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises with co-trainer G Rogerson advising that he would be applying a tongue tie for the gelding's next start.

G Old – Mr G Old, trainer of DRAGON ROBE, was issued with a warning under Rule 650(1)(b) in that he failed to report by the required time that DRAGON ROBE had undergone knee surgery to remove bone chips subsequent to last racing.

Race 7 | **TELPERION SPRINT**

MEASURED TWICE (J Fawcett) – Knuckled shortly after leaving the barriers.

I GOT YOU (M Cameron) – Raced wide without cover.

NAVAL BRIGADE (J Riddell) – When questioned regarding performance J Riddell was unable to offer any excuses.
