Race 5 PRINTCRAFT R75 1400 METRES (1400 metres)

ARTAXERXES (L Hemi) – Trainer G Nicholson advised Stewards that the gelding underwent blood tests in the days following its performance in this race which did not reveal any abnormality. It is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

ZEDEEDUDADEEKO (C Studd) – Trainer J Phillips advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the recovery of the gelding and it is his intention to continue on with its current preparation.

Race 2 STE INDUSTRIAL ELECTRICAL 1200

FRANKLIN (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

FINVARA (T Thornton) – Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres to the inside of MONGOLIAN BEAUTY which lay in when making the bend as a result FINVARA was dictated in slightly crowding FERRARI which was steadied.

FERRARI (S Weatherley) – Steadied when crowded 900 metres. Improved into a marginal run approaching the 300 metres making brief contact with VAN DIAMOND.

NEW LAWS (R Elliot) – Shifted out abruptly passing the 350 metres when struck with the whip running wide on the track.

MONGOLIAN BEAUTY (M Cameron) – Was inclined to lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Race 3 TAB 501 CAMERON ROAD 1200

IRISH MISSILE (M Du Plessis) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start. When questioned regarding performance rider M Du Plessis could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare did not reveal any abnormality.

STEVIE'S SURPRISE (A Collett) – Was steadied passing the 1000 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of GOLDCHI which had a tendency to lay in and away from other runners. Had to shift ground outwards early in the final straight to obtain clear running.

EPIC TALE (M McNab) – Raced keenly passing the 700 metres shifting out inconveniencing THE BUMPER which was forced wider on the track.

SILVER CLOUD (J Riddell) – Raced in restricted room passing the 350 metres between MOUNT MIDORIYAMA which lay out and EPIC TALE which shifted in slightly when making the bend. As a result all three runners became briefly

unbalanced. SILVER CLOUD then lay in making contact with MOUNT MIDORIYAMA which was laying out on several occasions in the final straight.

MOUNT MIDORIYAMA (S Collett) – Lay out making contact with SILVER CLOUD near the 350 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced. Made contact with SILVER CLOUD on several occasions in the final straight when laying out under pressure. Lost the left front plate during the running.

THE BUMPER (H Marzuki) – Inconvenienced passing the 700 metres when being forced wider on the track.

Race 4 GARTSHORE 1600

GRANDISCOCCYMELUMS (B Morgenrood) – Slow to begin. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

KOOL CONNECTION (M McNab) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Lost the left hind plate during the running.

ARCTIC MISS (J Fawcett) – Lay out when linking on to the course proper approaching the 1400 metres crowding DIEHARD and ROCKING GOOD TIME. Briefly held up entering the final straight.

DIEHARD (M Cameron) – Crowded near 1400 metres. Raced keenly through the middle stages.

ROCKING GOOD TIME (V Colgan) – Crowded near the 1400 metres.

I'MANOOD LASS (H Marzuki) – Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 700 metres when racing in restricted room between KOOL CONNECTION (M McNab) and COUNTRY BUMPKIN (J Riddell). Footage of this incident proved inconclusive with riders M McNab and J Riddell advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Crowded when placed in restricted room having to be steadied near the 600 metres.

Race 5 FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE 1400

VERDANT (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly and then was crowded losing ground.

CASTLE BLACK (C Lammas) – Slow to begin.

MOET MOLLY (R Elliot) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start and was steadied.

BULLET MIST (S Spratt) – Hampered passing the 50 metres by VON ZIPP which ducked in abruptly.

VON ZIPP (J Riddell) – Ducked in abruptly passing the 50 metres making contact with BULLET MIST.

Race 6 BOSSON DEVELOPMENTS 1400

MODEL AYE (M Du Plessis) – Slow to begin.

EL DUQUE (H Marzuki) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

I'M BRONSON (O Bosson) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier. **O Bosson** admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(b)(ii) in that he used his whip excessively when riding I'M BRONSON prior to the 100 metres, with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$300.

RODMAR (T Thornton) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier.

ESPRIT DE CORPS (C Lammas) – Crowded shortly after leaving the barrier. Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

ACRYLIC (S Weatherley) – When questioned regarding performance rider S Weatherley was of the opinion that the gelding had failed to handle today's holding track conditions.

Race 7 STELLA ARTOIS 1200

CONRWIN (J Fawcett) – Underwent a veterinary examination on arrival at the barrier and was cleared fit to race. Began awkwardly losing ground.

MALFARIOUS (R Elliot) – Very slow to begin.

LADY PINOT (T Newman) – Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground.

SUMMER DALE (T Allan) – Began awkwardly before being corrected by its rider.

AZ GIVEN (S Weatherley) – Briefly held up entering the final straight and improved into a marginal run approaching the 300 metres.

T Allan (SUMMER DALE) – Issued with a warning for the manner in which he used his whip prior to the 100 metres.

A Sims (SALTED CARAMEL) - Issued with a warning for the manner in which she used her whip prior to the 100 metres.
